3. The jeep was kept overtime because the driver was unable to notify me when the time came to return to the motor pool. I had previously instructed him to let me know when it was time to go, and he tried to give me this information, but the message was not relayed to me. Just as soon as I found out that the driver had to leave, I immediately and without further delay returned with the jeep to the motor pool. Upon arrival at my billet, the driver told me that he was 15 minutes late, and I am unable to understand why the D. R. specifies 1 hour.
4. In the future, I will take pains to see that all regulations relating to the use of taxi jeeps are strictly complied with.


