SUBJECT: Equipment and Use of Transient Quarters

Transient quarters are maintained at several depots and camps of the Alaska Road Commission, equipped with beds and bedding. These are intended only for the use of official visitors and for employees in travel status who are not assigned to duty at that point. Regularly assigned employees, as well as freight truck drivers on regular runs, should not be housed in such transient quarters.

Employees other than official visitors and transient employees will not be quartered in transient quarters. They are required to furnish and care for their own bedding. No employee, regardless of title or position, is entitled to government-owned bedding or use of transient quarters except when actually in a transient status.

The determination as to whether an employee is in a transient status shall be made by District Engineers, but in no case shall this status be granted to any employee whose permanent or temporary duty station is at the point in question, or who travels regularly between his station and that point.
