## INTRODUCTION

The growing political and economic importance of Africa in the international scene has increasingly stimulated American interest during the postwar years. As American scholars have become conscious of the relative meagerness of American writing on Africa and of the need of access to international literature related thereto, an interested American public has begun to express an intensified desire for current information on the now better known but still obscure continent. Simultaneously, or consequently, American libraries have become aware of their lack of knowledge about African studies and sources of information on Africa current in other parts of the world.

In 1952 the Library of Congress decided to participate in the effort toward a remedy and prepared a bibliographical study, Introduction to Africa (published by the University Press of Washington, Washington, D. C.). Shortly afterwards it issued as a working paper the first draft of Continuing Sources for Research on Africa, a survey of organizations that publish regularly on African questions and of periodicals devoted in whole or consistent part to discussion of Africa. Information on sources proved as scarce as information on Africa itself, and it became apparent that the preparation of a useful study depended to an appreciable degree on advice from leading institutions abroad. The generous assistance received from Mr. H. V. L. Swanzy, editor of the Royal African Society journal, African Affairs, from M. Georges Grandidier, permanent secretary of the Academy of Colonial Sciences in Paris, and from Mrs. B. E. Wyatt of the International African Institute in London, helped in achieving reasonably satisfactory coverage.

The working paper was still a tentative study requiring revisions, confirmations and additions, and was issued in the expressed hope that individual and insti-



tutional specialists in the field might offer further advice and information. It has taken over a year and a half to receive reactions from various countries on two continents, but the need for such a survey has been emphasized by all, and satisfactory responses have permitted a considerable expansion of the study. To all who have offered suggestions and assistance I express my appreciation, in particular to M. G. Salvy, Secretary General, Centre des Hautes Etudes d'Administration Musulmane, Université de Paris; Dr. Leonel Pedro Banha da Silva, Agente Geral do Ultramar, Lisbon, Portugal; Dr. Théodore Monod, Director, L'Institut Français de l'Afrique Noire, Dakar, French West Africa; Mr. M. D. W. Jeffreys, Joint-Editor of African Studies, Department of Bantu Studies, University of the Witwatersrand, Johannesburg, South Africa; Sr. Antonio Esquível, President of the Sociedade de Estudos de Moçambique, Lourenço Marques, Moçambique; Prof. Guy Malengreau, Director of Zaire, Catholic University of Louvain, Belgium.

The arrangement of this survey is by area, in accordance with the seat of the institution or place of publication of the journal. Its aim is to record sources that serve the purposes of research and scholarship and to indicate periodical publications offering information to the general reader and to such specialized interests as missionary, business and educational groups. Since institutions are sources of information beyond their publications, the entries are made where possible under the name of the organization; independently published journals or series are listed by title. Learned institutions, government offices issuing information bulletins, trade journals, magazines and pamphlet series appear in alphabetical order in each section devoted to a single area. A complete index of titles of publications leads to the sponsoring institution, the area, or both.

In spite of revisions and because of additions, many entries had to be included for which no copy was available for examination, and the descriptions found in ref-



erence sources or given in communications from abroad have, in a few cases, provided only author and title. This has made consistency in form and scope of annotation impossible. As far as possible, notes have been provided where the name of the institution or title of the publication is not self-explanatory. Several entries are marked with an asterisk, to indicate the failure of efforts made to complete the insufficient data. Accessible material was selected for inclusion on a quality standard in terms of the audience and interests mentioned above; for works not available for examination, the type indicated by the name or the frequency of references found elsewhere had to be taken as working criteria. Several sections are introduced by notes referring to national bibliographical sources for official and unofficial publications, or sometimes, to the lack of such sources. In accordance with the availability or the lack of a well-organized bibliographic control of public documents, government publications have been included on a highly selective or a broader basis.

In the compilation of this list, besides the Library of Congress collection, directories of institutions and periodicals, the press, and many reference works of all types have been consulted, and much information has been gleaned from comment, bibliographies or footnotes, even from advertisements in specialized journals. The rapid expansion of African studies and interest abroad as well as in America leads to a particular profusion in the appearance of new institutions and periodicals and to the disappearance and reorganization of others, so that this survey will already require supplementary data when it first reaches the user. But if this publication proves useful as a basic instrument in a field where efforts are being made to recover lost time, it will give satisfaction to the Library of Congress, to me, and to Miss Helen F. Conover of the staff of the Library, who was responsible for the compilation of the working paper as well as for this survey.

The CCTA is composed of official delegates of the participating Governments, who meet twice a year in a European capital; their decisions are binding on the Governments if no objections are raised within two months after the meeting. As of Jan. 1954 the CCTA has not yet issued publications of its own. Serials are being published by two of three inter-African information bureaux on particular subjects now established under the Commission: Bureau Permanent Inter africain de la Tsé-Tsé (no. 12) and Inter-African Information Bureau for Soil Conservation (no. 4). The third is concerned with epizootic diseases afflicting the livestock industry, located in a research institute at Muguga, near Nairobi. Other institutes being established include an inter-African labor institute at Banako in the French Sudan and the Inter-African Pedological Service, at Yangambi in the Belgian Congo.

They include annual reports of the various executive departments and many monographs of scientific research published from time to time in series of bulletins, memoirs, or papers of Agricultural Departments, Geological Surveys, Medical Departments, and so forth. No attempt is made here to indicate this kind of annual and irregular material, or the general news journals of information which are published in most of the colonies by the Government Public Relations Department, e. g. : Gold Coast Bulletin

There is no systematic record of official publications of the French overseas territories comparable to the Monthly List issued by the British Colonial Office. Annual reports and monographic papers are often noted in the Bulletin bibliographique of the Ministère de la France d'Outre-Mer, and the more significant documents are listed in national Bibliographie de la France, notably in its Supplément F, Publications officielles. At the end of this chapter there is given a selective list of the more general official periodicals of the individual French possessions, arranged alphabetically by area.
