NOTICE TO PURCHASERS.

I do strictly a WHOLESALE business, and give ALL MY ATTENTION to my wholesale customers.

My railroad facilities are good, and I can obtain the lowest freight rates possible. I ship via M. K. & T. R. Railroad, Junction City (branch of the M. K. & T., Kansas City, Ft. Scott & Gulf Railway, Kansas City & Pacific Railroad, and all their branches and connections. Also by the Adams and Pacific Express Companies.

Terms and Condition.

TERMS OF PAYMENT.—Cash or satisfactory security before shipment of stock. All orders to be sent by express. C. O. D. must be accompanied by ONE-HALF THE AMOUNT IN CASH.

CONDITION OF SALE—1. When stock is to be boxed or bailed I charge cost of material only.

2. I deliver all goods free of drayage to rail road or express offices, after which my responsibility ceases.

3. At these prices selection of varieties must be left with me, but I will always give purchaser his choice, so far as consistent with our stock. 5 at 10 rates, 50 at 100 rates and 500 at 1000 rates.

4. I prefer parties ordering should indicate the route by which they wish stock sent. In the absence of particular directions, I forward to the best of my judgment; but in no case will I assume any responsibility after consignment to purchaser, unless for my own mistakes. When losses occur from detention en route, claims should be made on the carriers immediately.

5. All claims for shortage, etc., to receive attention, must be made within five days from receipt of goods.

SHIPPING—We usually commence shipping in the fall about the 5th of October.

TO OUR PATRONS,

We desire it to be distinctly understood that we have no connection whatever with any other Nursery or employ TRAVELING AGENTS, and that our RESPONSIBILITY for any business transaction extends only to persons PURCHASING DIRECT FROM THE NURSERY. Dealers purchasing from us sell upon their own responsibility. We likewise disclaim any liability for results arising from defective planting or at improper seasons, or from subsequent faulty treatment and cultivation, and are not in any respect responsible for any loss or damage arising from any failure thereof. While we exercise the greatest care to have all our trees and plants true to name, well grown, and packed in the best possible manner, and hold ourselves in readiness, on proper proof, to replace all trees or plants that may accidentally prove untrue to label, free of charge, or refund the amount paid therefor, it is mutually understood and agreed to between the purchaser and ourselves that our guarantee of genuineness shall in no case make us liable for any sum greater than originally received for said trees or plants that prove untrue. Our reputation for upright dealing, and the uniform high standard of quality of our products, the result of a twenty years' business career, is our only guarantee to our customers.
