

Europe | Heatwave

- The map represents maximum values of temperature at 2 meters above the ground from 24 to 30 June, as recorded by meteorological observational platforms during the latest unusually early heatwave.
- This heatwave was due to the prevailing high pressure weather system mainly responsible for pulling hot air northward from Africa.

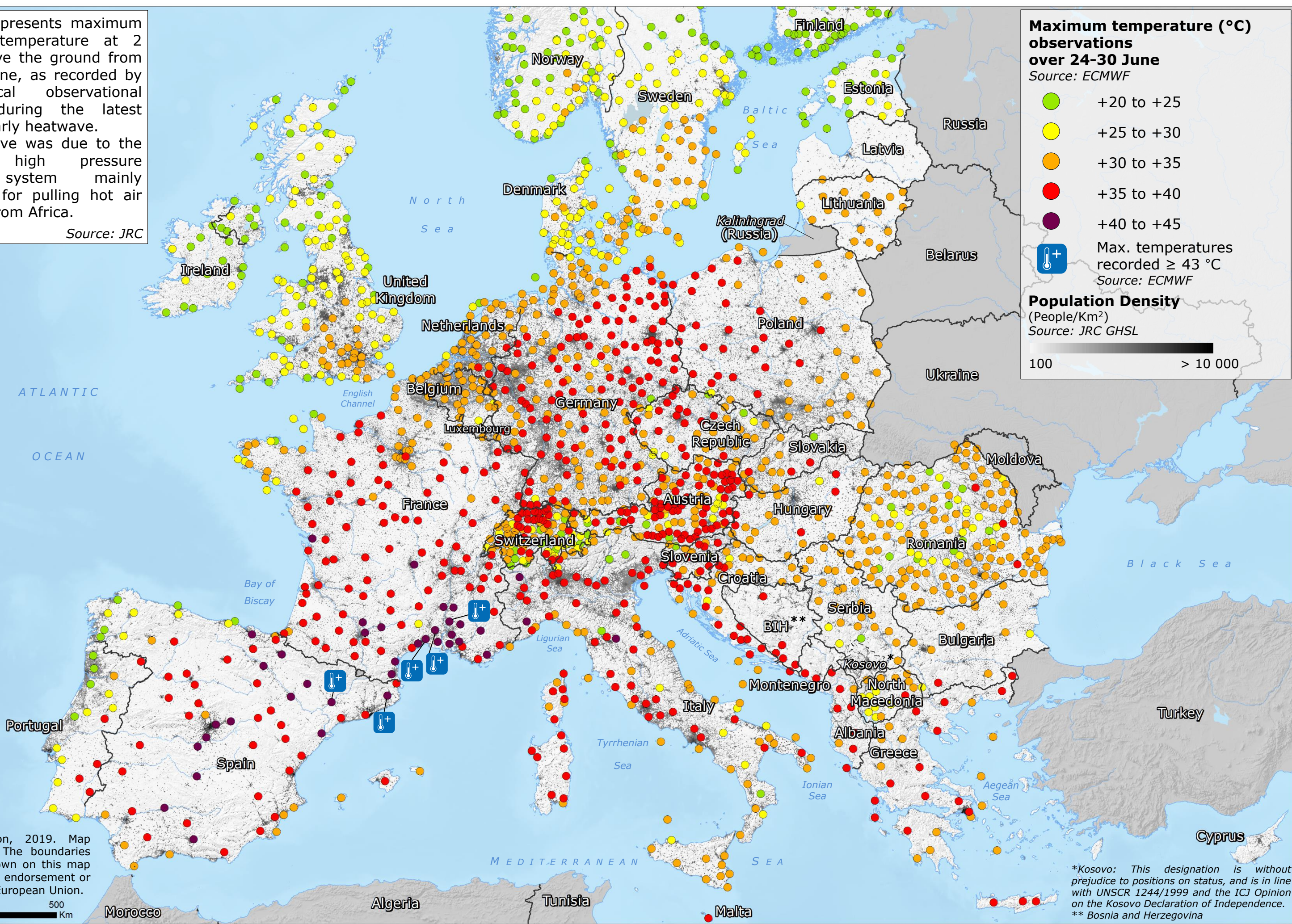
