SUBJECT: Request for Extension of Visitors Visa

1. In February 1949, prior to the Chinese Communist entry into Shanghai, China, I sent my wife, Mrs. Helen Katemopoulos, and daughter, Marina Katemopoulos, to the United States for one year on a visitor's visa status. To date my family has received two extensions bringing their allowed stay in the United States to November, 1950.

2. When the previous extension was granted, my wife and child were told by the Immigration Authorities that it would positively be the last extension granted them, after which time they would either have to leave the country or be deported to Greece, as they are Greek citizens. Deportation to Greece of my family would be very unpleasant and a great hardship as they neither speak the Greek language, nor have acquaintances there and therefore they would be total strangers.

3. After the Communists entered in May, 1949, I made every effort to leave Shanghai, to enter Japan. Delay in obtaining entry permit and transportation made my departure possible only by April 17, 1950; arriving in Yokohama, Japan, on May 11, 1950.

4. I am employed by The Department of the Army as Sanitary Engineer of Kinki Civil Affairs Region, GHQ, SCAP, at present with an equivalent grading of GS-12. I desire to bring my family to Japan but under prevailing conditions, I am told that it is not possible.
