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FOREWORD

According to the law, the national census of population and housing is conducted once every ten years by the Statistical Centre of Iran. So far, four population and housing censuses have been conducted in 1956, 1966, 1976 and 1986. The 1986 Census was the first under Islamic Republic of Iran, which was conducted in a desirable manner despite the imposed war, economic sanctions and shortages thereof.

In comparison with the previous censuses, the 1986 census has the added advantage of questions relating to fertility, mortality, nationality, and some other information.

UNESCO recommendations for employing International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED) were adopted for the first time in this census.

All courses and fields of study offered within the country as well as fields of study of students who had graduated abroad were arranged according to the above classification and suitable codes of ISCED were assigned to them. Simultaneously, the index of occupations and economic activities was updated with due consideration to occupational varieties, and appropriate codes were determined according to the International Standard Classification of Occupations (ISCO) and the International Standard Industrial Classification (ISIC).

The census operations were so extensive that the SCI had no other choice but to launch preparations for the census taking as early as late 1982. The first step in this series of activities was the identification of basic data requirements of state authoritative organizations, on the basis of which the preliminary census design was prepared and tested in 1984 in the urban and rural areas of three Shahrestans (sub-provinces) and a number of sample Eus with a variety of climatic conditions across the country. The results obtained from this pilot census were used in revising questionnaires, forms, and technical and executive instructions and in preparing the final census design.

Field operations for census enumeration were conducted by about 60000 staff members of various administrative levels simultaneously all over the country from 8 to 22 October 1986 using the de jure method for the settled population and de facto method for the unsettled population.

In order to evaluate the coverage and accuracy of the enumeration, the post enumeration survey was carried out immediately after the census enumeration.

Early after enumeration, the preliminary results including some important data were published on the basis of one percent sampling. The reports on the National Census of Population and Housing of October 1986 are richer than the previous ones in that they include additional information besides data presented in previous census reports. Therefore, the number of statistical tables and publications were increased : a report on the detailed census results as well as a village gazeteer were published for each and every Shahrestan (sub-province); a report on the detailed census results as well as a rural gazeteer were published for each and every Ustan (province); and a report on the detailed results, a rural gazeteer as well as a report on the final results were published for the total country. Another report was published on final census results representing data for each city separately. In addition to the above publications some of the socio-economic data are under investigation to be published in form of subject-matter reports in different fields such as migration, disabilities, housing, manpower, etc.

The present report contains 34 tables and a summary of findings. It should be noted that, in a number of tables, unsettled population characteristics are not provided separately. Therefore, in the tables where information on population settled in urban areas and settled in rural areas are given separately with no indication of unsettled population, the sum of figures will not add up to the total figure provided. Besides, discrepancies in totals are due to the rounding of figures.

SUMMARY FINDINGS

Iran is the western part of a vast plateau of the same name in the south-west Asia and extends between latitude $25^{\circ} 3'$ to $39^{\circ} 47'$ north of equator and longitude $44^{\circ} 5'$ to $63^{\circ} 18'$ east of Greenwich Meridian.

Iran is bounded on the north by the Soviet Union and the Caspian Sea, on the south by the Persian Gulf and Oman Sea, on the east by Afghanistan and Pakistan and on the west by Iraq and Turkey. Iran has an area of about 1630942.1 square Kilometers. In October 1986, administrative divisions of Iran consisted of 24 Ostan (provinces), 195 Shahrestans (sub-provinces), 500 Bakhshes (counties), 496 cities and 1581 Dehestans (rural districts). Number of Shahrestans, Bakhshes, cities and Dehestans of each Ostan are presented in table A.

POPULATION AND ITS DISTRIBUTION

According to October 1986 Census of Population and Housing, total population of the country was 49445010 persons. Tehran Ostan with 8712087 persons was the most populated and Ilam Ostan with 382091 persons was the least populated Ostan in the country.

Of the total population, 54.3 percent lived in urban areas and 45.2 percent in rural areas and the rest were unsettled. Among the Ostan's of the country, Tehran Ostan had the highest percentage of settled population in urban areas (86.5 percent), while Kohgiluyeh and Boyer Ahmad had the lowest (27.0 percent).



AGE AND SEX STRUCTURE

In October 1986, from the total population of 49445010 persons, 25280961 were male and 24164049 were female. Thus the sex ratio was 105. In other words, in the total country there were 105 males per 100 females. This ratio was 103 among infants under one year and 105 among the aged (65 years & over). The sex ratio in Ostan's ranged from 101 in Sistan and Baluchestan Ostan to 107 in Esfahan and Yazd Ostan's.

Of the total population 45.5 percent were under 15 years of age, 51.5 percent were between 15 to 64 years of age and 3.0 percent were 65 years of age and over while the age of less than 0.1 percent was not specified. Ratio of population 0 to 14 years of age to total population was higher in Kohgiluyeh and Boyer Ahmad Ostan (52 percent) and lower in Tehran Ostan (40.0 percent) than the other Ostan's.

MARITAL STATUS

In October 1986, of total population 10 years of age and over, 56.2 percent of males and 66.2 percent of females had been married at least once. The proportion of never married male and female population 10 years of age & over was 41.6 percent and 32.0 percent respectively. This proportion was 41.5 percent for men and 30.9 percent for women in urban areas and 41.8 percent for men and 33.4 percent for women in rural areas.

The comparison of the proportion of never-married population 10 years of age and over among Ostan's shows that Ilam Ostan with 45.7 percent had the highest proportion of never-married males, and Gilan Ostan with 36.5 percent had the highest proportion of never-married females while Sistan and Baluchestan Ostan with 37.8 percent of never-married males and Yazd Ostan with 26.6 percent of never-married females had the lowest proportion of never-married population.

Migration

In October 1986 Census of Population and Housing, of the total settled population, 77.7 percent lived in their birth place. A comparison of the place of birth with the place of enumeration shows that of the total settled population, 7.8 percent have migrated from villages to cities, 7.5 percent from city to city, 3.1 percent from village to village and 1.5 percent from city to Village. The highest proportion of people who were living in their birth place was 91.2 percent and belonged to Chaharmahal and Bakhtiyari Ostan while the lowest was 61.1 percent in Tehran Ostan.

ACQUAINTANCE WITH FARSI LANGUAGE

According to the results of 1986 Census of Population and Housing, 82.7 percent of the population could speak Farsi. This proportion in urban and rural areas was 90.9 percent and 73.1 percent respectively. The proportion of persons who could not speak Farsi was 14.3 percent in the total country, 7.3 percent in urban areas and 22.7 percent in rural areas.

Ostan's of Kerman and Semnan, with 99.2 percent each, had the highest proportion of population who could speak Farsi while the lowest proportion was 39.1 percent in West Azarbayjan.

LITERACY

According to 1986 Census of Population and Housing, of the total population 6 years of age and over of 38708879 persons, 61.8 percent were literate. The literacy rate was 83.9 percent for age-group 6 to 14 years and 52.2 percent for age group 15 years of age and over. Among school-age population (6 to 14 years), the literacy rate was 93.0 percent in urban areas and 75.3 percent in rural areas.

The highest percentage of literate population 6 years of age and over was 78.2 percent in Tehran Ostan and the lowest was 36.0 percent in Sistan and Baluchestan Ostan.

EDUCATION

In October 1986, of population 6 to 24 years of age, 52.5 percent were attending school. This proportion was 59.8 percent in urban areas and 44.7 percent in rural areas.

Of the total population of the country, 18.7 percent of children, 70.8 percent of young adults and 21.5 percent of adults were engaged in study. This proportion was not even for different adult age groups and ranged from 37.1 percent for adults 15 to 18 years of age to 8.3 percent among adults 19 to 24 years of age.

A comparison between Ostans with regard to the proportion of persons attending school among children 6 to 10 years of age shows that the corresponding proportion in Yazd Ostan (93.4 percent) was higher and in Sistan and Baluchestan (47.2 percent) was lower than other Ostans.

EMPLOYMENT AND MAJOR OCCUPATION GROUPS

According to the 1986 Census of Population and Housing, of 32874293 population 10 years of age and over of the country, 11001535 were employed. Of the employed population 10 years of age and over, 33.1 percent were production and transportation workers, 29.5 percent were agricultural, animal husbandry and forestry workers, fishermen and hunters, 9.6 percent were scientific, technical, professional and related workers and 6.9 percent were trade and sales workers.

Workers not classified, not specified and not reported by occupation, account for 13.1 percent of employed population 10 years of age and over, while three major groups of managerial, clerical and service workers account for less than 8 percent of employed population.

The proportion of employed population to population 10 years of age and over was 33.5 percent (32.6 percent in urban areas and 34.6 percent in rural areas). Gilan Ostan with 41.8 percent had the highest proportion of the employed population 10 years of age and over while Khuzestan Ostan with 27.9 percent had the lowest.

MAJOR INDUSTRY GROUPS

According to the Census of Population and Housing conducted in October 1986, of employed population 10 years of age and over 29.0 percent were engaged in agriculture, animal husbandry, forestry, hunting and fishing, 27.7 percent in community, social and personal services, 8.0 percent in wholesale and retail trade, restaurants and hotels, 11.0 percent in construction and the remaining were in other major economic activity groups. These proportions in urban areas were 5.2 , 38.9 , 12.5 , 11.9 percent and in rural areas were 56.6 , 14.6 , 2.7 and 9.9 percent respectively.

Percentage distribution of employed population 10 years of age and over by major industry groups shows that the largest number of employed population in urban areas are engaged in community, social and personal services while in rural areas the agriculture, animal husbandry, hunting, forestry and fishing account for the most of the population employed.

Gilan Ostan with 51.2 percent and Tehran Ostan with 4.8 percent had the highest and lowest percentage of employment in major industry group of agriculture, animal husbandry, hunting, forestry and fishing among Ostans of the country respectively.

Khuzestan Ostan with 46.2 percent had the highest proportion of public sector wage and salary earners for employed population 10 years of age and over while Kordestan Ostan with 19.9 percent had the lowest.

EMPLOYMENT STATUS

According to October 1986 Census of Population and Housing, of population 10 years of age and over 64.5 percent were employers, own-account workers, private sector wage and salary earners and unpaid family workers while 31.4 percent were public sector wage and salary earners. The remaining 4.1 percent had not reported their employment status. Corresponding proportions were 51.5 percent, 43.6 percent and 4.9 percent in urban areas and 79.6 percent, 17.2 and 3.2 percent in rural areas respectively.

Among the Ostans of the country, Khuzestan Ostan with 46.2 percent had the highest proportion of public sector wage and salary earners for employed population 10 years of age and over while Kordestan Ostan with 19.9 percent had the lowest.

HOUSEHOLDS' DISTRIBUTION

In October 1986 the number of regular households totalled 9672477 of which 5527475 were settled in urban areas and 4099470 in rural areas while 45532 were unsettled. The mean number of household members was 5.1 persons. The corresponding mean was 4.8 for urban households, 5.4 for rural households and 5.5 for unsettled households.

The comparison of mean number of household members among Ostan shows that Semnan Ostan with 4.5 persons per household had the lowest while Khuzestan Ostan with 6.0 persons per household had the highest mean.

HOUSEHOLD FACILITIES

In October 1986 there were 9626945 regular settled households of which 83.7 percent used electricity, 73.7 percent piped water and 43.6 percent bathrooms in their dwellings. These proportions were 97.4 percent, 90.3 percent, 63.2 percent in urban areas and 65.1 percent, 51.5 percent and 17.2 percent in rural areas respectively.

The proportion of regular settled households supplied with electricity and piped water in Tehran Ostan were (97.6 percent and 92.5 percent respectively) higher than other Ostan while in Sistan and Baluchestan Ostan were (51.8 percent and 44.4 percent respectively) lower than other Ostan.

Gas was the most common fuel used for cooking by 5527475 regular settled households in urban areas (84.4 percent) and 4099470 regular settled households in rural areas (42.4 percent).

In total country, the main fuel used for heating by 82.0 percent of urban households and 61.0 percent of rural households was kerosene. Gas was more commonly used for cooking by regular households in rural areas of Bushehr Ostan (82.3 percent) and less commonly used in rural areas of Kordestan Ostan (11.2 percent) than other Ostan.

TYPE OF TENURE OF DWELLING UNIT

According to the 1986 Census of Population and Housing, 70.8 percent of regular settled households of the country owned their land and building, 6.4 percent were owners of the building of their dwelling units only and 12.0 percent had rented their dwelling units. A comparison of different Ostan's of the country shows that the highest proportion of leaseholder households to total households belonged to Bakhtaran Ostan (24.8 percent) while the lowest proportion belonged to Chaharmahal and Bakhtiari Ostan (6.8 percent).

NUMBER OF ROOMS IN REGULAR DWELLING UNITS

In October 1986, 7.7 percent of dwelling units in the total country had one room, 24.9 percent had three rooms and 11.0 percent had six rooms and more. These proportions were 4.4 percent, 24.0 percent and 13.2 percent in urban areas and 26.0 percent and 8.1 percent in rural areas respectively.

PRINCIPAL CONSTRUCTION MATERIAL USED IN DWELLING UNITS

According to the results of 1986 Census of Population and Housing, 3.3 percent of dwelling units were made of steel beam skeleton or reinforced concrete, 43.0 percent of brick and iron or stone and iron, and 28.8 percent of adobe and wood or adobe and mud. Most of the regular dwelling units in urban areas were made of brick and iron or stone and iron (63.8 percent) and in rural areas of adobe and wood (36.3 percent).

DWELLING UNITS, BY THE YEAR CONSTRUCTION WAS COMPLETED

According to the results of 1986 Census of Population and Housing, the construction of 6.2 percent of dwelling units was completed in 1956-1965, 19.6 percent in 1966-1975, 55.4 percent in 1976-1985 and 2.6 percent in 1986 as of the 1986 census enumeration date.

The greatest number of dwelling units completed in the period 1976-1985 were built during 1976-1977 both in urban and rural areas accounting for 24.4 percent and 26.5 percent of units respectively.

Dwelling units completed during 1980 till October 1986 are not evenly scattered in different Ostan's. The proportion of such units to total dwelling units range from a minimum of 25.0 percent in Tehran Ostan to a maximum of 55.8 percent in Ilam Ostan,

ESTABLISHMENTS

According to the 1986 Census, 1939672 establishments were listed for the total country, of which 68.6 percent were in urban areas and 31.4 percent in rural areas. Percentage distribution of establishments by maximum number of employees during the 12 months preceding the 1986 census shows that 6.8 percent had no employee, 82.7 percent had 1-9 employees, 2.9 percent had 10-49 employees, 0.7 percent had 50 employees and more while the maximum number of employees of 6.9 percent of establishments were not specified. The classification of establishments by major industry groups indicates that the activities of most of the establishments were wholesale and retail trade, restaurants and hotels both in urban and rural areas with 47.8 percent and 30.5 percent respectively.
