I have been designated Chief Defense Counsel for Rear Admiral Matsumoto in connection with the charge and specifications which are being lodged against him as a war criminal. Lieutenants Waters and Tavoulareas have been designated as assistant Defense Counsels.

In interviewing Admiral Matsumoto, he showed me a letter from you regarding the additional representation on his behalf by Major General Odagaki and Mr. Shinji Somiya. Admiral Matsumoto has requested that such additional representation be furnished to him.

Accordingly, I have instituted a formal request through military channels for the transfer and transportation of General Odagaki and Mr. Somiya to Manila.

This letter is intended to inform you of Admiral Matsumoto's desire and of the action taken here.

It is not expected that the trial of Admiral Matsumoto will take place before 15 July 1946.

It will be appreciated if you will acknowledge the receipt of this letter.
