MEMORANDUM TO: IMPERIAL JAPANESE GOVERNMENT  
THROUGH: Central Liaison Office, Tokyo  
SUBJECT: Pensions and Benefits

1. References are the following memoranda:

a. Memorandum from the Imperial Japanese Government, CLO No. 3924 (EF), 9 August 1946, Subject: Pensions and Benefits for Former Members of Certain Dissolved Companies.

b. Memorandum to the Imperial Japanese Government from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, AG260 (24 Nov 45) ESS/FI SCAPIN 338, subject: Pensions and Benefits.

2. Those dissolved organizations referred to in reference 1 a may be exempted from the provisions of paragraph 1 b of reference 1 b, providing that:

a. No pensions, benefits, or other emoluments shall be paid to any persons who at any time between 7 July 1937 and 2 September 1945 held an executive or policy-making position such as those of director, managing director, manager, governor, vice-governor, chairman, councillor, president, vice-president, advisor, auditor, partner, managing partner, and including all positions of equivalent or superior importance in any of these organizations; and,

b. Pensions and retirement allowances shall not exceed those customarily given by the organizations concerned prior to 1945.

3. All payments made under the provisions of this memorandum shall be reported to General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers.
