What's new about 'New Filters' beta?

New filter groups

- Contribution Quality Predictions (ORES)
- User Intent Predictions (ORES)
- Experience filters—Newcomers, Learners, Experienced
- Type of change filters—Page edits, Page creations, Logged actions, [Wikidata and Category existed already]
- Latest revision filters
- Watchlisted filters

And....

What's new about 'New Filters' beta?

Power Tools

- Highlighting—emphasize to make data more meaningful
- Save filter settings—create sets of filters for different purposes
- Save defaults—no longer need the Preferences page settings

All-new interface

- Easier
- More capabilities
- More control

ORES prediction performance varies from wiki to wiki. Two examples:

**Precision—
% true positives**

**% of target
captured**

English Wikipedia

May have problems	15%	82%
Likely have problems	46%	35%
Very likely have problems	93%	11%
Very likely good	99.6%	95%

Polish Wikipedia

May have problems	na	na
Likely have problems	80%	91%
Very likely have problems	99%	72%
Very likely good	96%	95%
