



# Why no money from WMF to LGBT+?

## ¿Por qué no hay dinero de WMF para causas LGBT+?

- WMF designed to support geographical communities
- LGBT+ people are high risk of harassment
- Presumption that geographic communities can advocate for LGBT+ in their side projects
- Wikimedia LGBT+ has not asked directly enough
- WMF está diseñada para apoyar a las comunidades geográficas
- Las personas LGBT+ corren un alto riesgo de acoso
- Presunción de que las comunidades geográficas pueden abogar por la comunidad LGBT+ en sus proyectos
- Wikimedia LGBT+ no se ha comunicado lo suficiente de manera directa





# Bootstrapping the board

## *Comenzar por el consejo directivo*

- Trustees elected by current members, for a 2-year term, renewable on re-election
- Initial board of 3 elected members (for 2 years) and up to 4 members of current Governance Committee (for 1 year)
- Trustees are leadership team, speaking for UG, overseeing any funds and staff, and are legally responsible
- Trustees engage with WMF and Movement for support of members
- Trustees select Chair, Vice Chair +...
- Un consejo directivo elegido por les miembros actuales, por un período de 2 años, renovable bajo reelección
- Una junta inicial de 3 miembros electes (por 2 años) y hasta 4 miembros del Comité de Gobernanza actual (por 1 año)

- El consejo se involucra con la WMF y el Movimiento para apoyar a les miembros

## Beneficios de membresía

The WMLGBT+ User Group needs to register members who can:

1. *Vote* in elections of trustees and proposals put to a membership vote.
2. Provide a *community voice* to hold the trustees to account and help prioritize improvement.
3. Propose *member resolutions* to the board of trustees.
4. *Run for election* to the board.
5. Access user group *reports* and take part in membership *surveys*.

# Membership policies

## Políticas de membresía

- Membership registration supports *anonymous* members if requested
- Members can be removed if *inactive*
- *Entryism*, where lobby groups might register many names to manipulate votes, is a recognized risk

# Where should we incorporate?

## ¿Dónde incorporamos?

-  Belgium has a concept of “International non-profit organisation” (*association internationale sans but lucratif*), that is largely tax exempt and does not require local domicile. This is the structure used by Wikimedia Europe
-  Geneva has a non-profit structure that includes tax exemption, but requires that a trustee be resident in Switzerland. This is the structure used by *Les sans pagEs*.
-  Bélgica tiene un concepto de “Organización internacional sin fines de lucro” (*association internationale sans but lucratif*) que está en gran parte exenta de impuestos y no requiere domicilio local. Esta es la estructura utilizada por Wikimedia Europa.
-  Ginebra tiene una estructura sin fines de lucro que incluye exención de impuestos, pero requiere que uno miembro del consejo directivo sea residente en Suiza. Esta es la estructura utilizada por *Les sans pagEs*.

# WCNA en 2021

- Over 200 people attended
  - About 65 speakers
  - Two types of sessions:
    - Tracks – broadcasts – with English–Spanish interpretation
    - Workshops – smaller meetings, with no interpretation
  - Many speakers gave lightning talks
