

Earthquake

- · KOFI caused heavy rains and floods in Fiji on 25-28 February. As of late on 2 March (media) there were still 800 evacuees housed in relief centres in Viti Levu.
- Later, on 1 March, KOFI passed around 80 km west of Tongatapu (Tonga's main island), as a Tropical Storm, causing heavy rains, some coastal flooding and evacuations in Tongatapu (local media).

- On 2 March, at 09.37 UTC an earthquake of 6.2 M (depth: 72 km) struck off the coast of northern Nicaragua, just south of the Gulf of Fonseca. It was felt in Nicaragua, Honduras and El Salvador.
- · USGS-PAGER: shaking up to "Strong" for approx. 28 000 people.
- As of 3 March morning, no reports of personal or material damage.
