SITUATION

- An earthquake of magnitude 6.1 M at a depth of 13 km hit north-eastern Iran on 5 April at 6.09 UTC. The epicentre was located approx. 63 km north-northwest of Torbat-e Jam city (Torbat-e Jam county, Khorasan province). USGS PAGER indicates shaking up to "Strong" for 7 000 people and up to "Moderate" for 120 000 people.
- According to local media, as of 6 April at 7.00 UTC, one person died, at least 34 were injured and hundreds of houses were damaged in Khorasan province.
