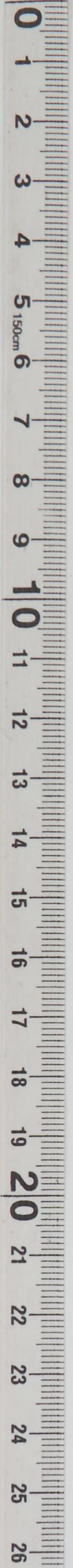

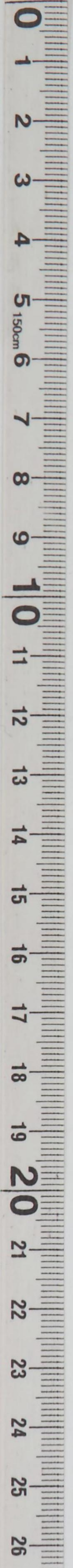

1. By C/N (1) Med Sect to QM, subj "Cleaning and Preserving Materials" dated 31 Jan 49, Med non-concurred in proposed QM radio to DA and suggested certain changes in proposed radio (see C/N for details).
2. C/N 2, QM thru Med to G-4 advised that proposed message had been amended as outlined in Med C/N (1).
3. C/N 3, Med Sect to G-4, concurred in rad as amended.
4. Background:
  - a. The supply of cleaning and preserving materials to medical installations was formerly a medical responsibility and the allowances therefore were prescribed by Medical Supply Catalog MED-3. The responsibility of supply of these items was subsequently transferred to QM. However, at the time of transfer, TA 10-100 which authorized the issue of specific quantities of cleaning and preserving materials to various activities did not provide an allowance for medical installations.
  - b. Cincfe msg ZX 35623, dtd 17 Jan 48, requested authority to continue issuing cleaning and preserving materials under the provisions of MED-3 pending change to TA 10-100. D/A msg WCL 40715 dtd 26 Mar 48 advised in part that pending publication of change to TA 10-100 which would embody allowances for cleaning and preserving materials required by hospital units, that authority was granted to reqn expendable supplies as follows: In accordance with allowances in TM 10-100 where such allowances were adequate and in accordance with MED-3 where minimum allowances in TA 10-100 were inadequate, further advises that combined allowances of TA 10-100 and MED-3 would not be authorized.
  - c. Review of TA 10-100 dtd 24 Jul 48, received in GHQ Dec 48, reveals that C&P materials for hospital units were not incorporated in the new TA 10-100. For example, such items as soap, ordinary issue; brooms, corn; and brooms, rattan, push; etc.
5. Therefore this rad, as prepared by QM, advises DA that new TA 10-100, 24 Jul 48, did not contain allowances of expendable C&P materials for hospital units and requests advice if DA contemplates current action to include allowances of C&P materials issued to Med installations in a supplement to TA 10-100, further that it is assumed here that issues to Med installations in the interim should be

continued as outlined in <sup>D/A</sup> msg cited in par 4 b above.

6. In view of the QM recommendations and Med concurrence and the fact that TA 10-100, 24 Jul 48, does not contain allowances of expendable C&P materials, it is felt that QM proposed radio is appropriate and therefore this C/N to AG requests signature and dispatch.

Hq FEAF ltr, file AG 4114.4 SUP-4-Q, subject, "Increased Allowances for Cleaning and Preserving Materials" dated 19 Jan 49 advises Cincfe that an Air Force Board of Officers was appointed in the Rycom area to determine the adequacy of cleaning and preserving allowances. FEAF recommends that T/A 10-100 be amended to increase certain QM items of cleaning and preserving materials, and further recommends that consideration be given to establish "dues out" when expendable supplies are not furnished on dates requested.

2. In this connection, "dues out" are never established for expendable supplies when requisitioned for a specific period. Also an analysis of the FEAF letter and board proceedings indicates:

a. The AF has recommended that changes be made to the SB 38-4 (Replacement Factors) instead of the T/A 10-100 (Allowances) as they state.

b. Replacement Factors are determined by OQMG based on past issue experience. (Materials Consumed Report)

c. Replacement factors (SB 38-4) are only used by the QM Depot for requisitioning on the Z/I. Allowances for using organizations are taken from T/A 10-100.

d. Issues of items in question to the AF Base Supply Officer should be in accordance with T/A 10-100.

e. The AF Board proceedings and recommendations indicate a difference in AF and Depot use of basic requisitioning data.

3. This ind requests CG Rycom to submit comments and issues of janitorial supplies to Air Force units for Oct, Nov, and Dec 1948 to Cincfe. This info is desired in order to check issues on a per individual basis.
