SUMMARY OF CONTENTS

Names of Philippine Officials and Mayors
(Doc 2793)

The War Crimes Office requested this translation of two lists of names from a 1943 Japanese intelligence report. The first list gives 15 names of provincial officials of the Philippine Commonwealth Government. These men are apparently guerrillas rather than Japanese puppets, since the original document says they were appointed by Colonel KANGLEON, head of the 92d Guerrilla Division in Leyte and southern Samar. The second list names 47 mayors in the Leyte area. With this group, there is no indication as to whether they represent the guerrillas or the Japanese.
