

of Northern Ireland will be prepared to consider the expediency, having regard to the condition of the Fines and Fees Fund, of allowing an increment not exceeding $7\frac{1}{2}$ per cent. on the original salary, subject to such conditions as may be prescribed. An annual increment of $1\frac{1}{2}$ per cent. on original salary during the succeeding 5 years and an annual increment of 1 per cent. on original salary during each of the following 30 years may likewise be granted, if approved by the Governor of Northern Ireland. Provided that no increase of salary shall be given after 40 years' service.

An allowance of 10/- for each 100 licences issued during the quarter ended 31st March in each year may be paid to Petty Sessions Clerks to recoup them for expenses incurred in connection with the annual issue of Dog Licences.

The word "district" in this Order shall include any two or more districts served by one and the same person as Clerk under an Order made in pursuance of the Petty Sessions Clerk (Ireland) Act, 1858, or the Petty Sessions Fees and Administration Act (Northern Ireland), 1923.
