Steamer Charles D. Lane, on her return from Nomo, was libelled at the Seattle the other day for \$51,000 by 102 of the passengers on her last trip.

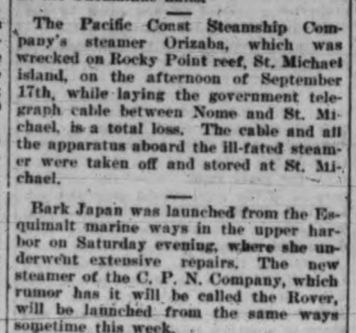
