4. Flight Operations: Flight operations continued at a reduced pace during the month of December due to inclement weather and the limited scope of Marine operations. The squadron flew 421 combat missions for 546.2 hours in support of III MAF and 7th Air Force. Pilots averaged 20 sorties and 24.5 hours while the NFO's averaged 26 sorties and 33.5 hours. Total ordnance expended for the month of December was 584 tons.
