LYNCH LAW.—The following excellent article on the subject of Lynch Law, is from the S. F. Chronicle. The necessity which has driven the people of this State to the exercise of summary vengeance in so many instances of late, cannot but be deplored by every good citizen; nevertheless, we believe that the frequent outrages which are daily committed, almost with impunity, should be prevented, if possible, at any and all hazards.

Lynch law seems once more coming into vogue. If it ever could be justified, it probably was so in the case of Griffiths, at Sonora, and but little so in that of Brown, at Los Angeles. In each case a most horrible murder had been committed. Brown and Alvord had both been tried, found guilty upon undoubted evidence, and condemned to die. Why the Supreme Court interfered in favor of Brown, and not also the same leniency to Alvord, we do not understand. If it was because one was an American and the other not, the act was unworthy, and the people naturally resent it. Such partiality is unjustifiable.

The people of Los Angeles have suffered for years the horrible influence and fiendish acts of a set of desperadoes, who have set all law at defiance. The miscreants who have made themselves execrable in the northern part of the State that they could no longer even with all our loose way of treating murders, remain here, have been in the habit of migrating to the southern part of the State, where the purity of population and comparative weakness of the public authorities have given them a safer field for the perpetration of crime. When, therefore, the people and courts had succeeded in detecting and dooming to merited punishment some of the most deserving chastisement, it was not very becoming to attempt interfering.

The event is such as might have been anticipated. The Court has succeeded in forcing the people to rebel, and overruling the authority of the law.
