Stops will be made enroute at Bridgeport, New Haven, New London, Westerly and Providence. The complete schedule will be found in table 1 on page 4 of this folder.

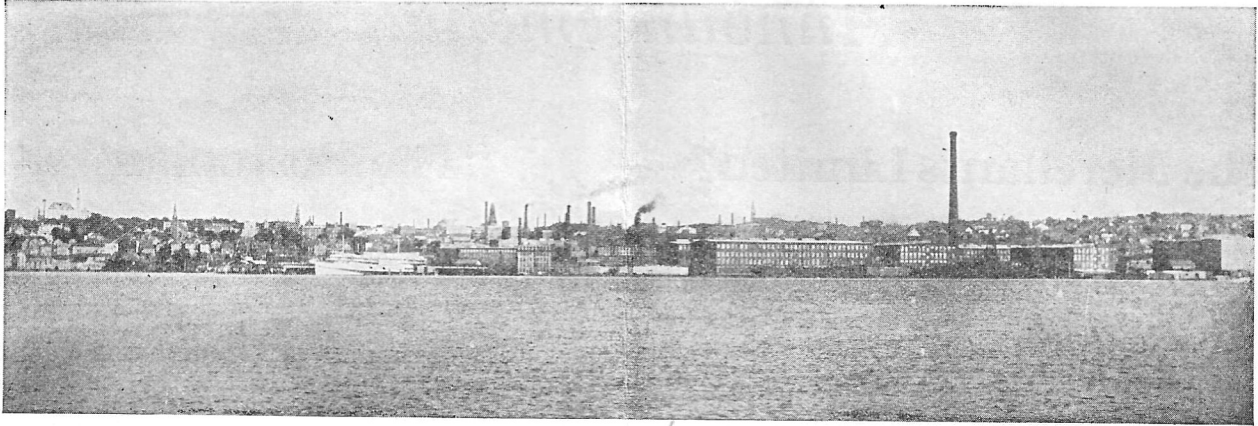

The City of Fall River

THE City of Fall River is the third largest in southern Massachusetts. It has a population of 130,886. The assessed valuation of the city is \$188,086,150.

Fall River is the largest textile manufacturing centre in America if not the world. It has 111 cotton mills, housing 4,000,000 spindles, which represent investments of \$100,000,000, gives employment to about 36,000 operatives and distributes nearly \$300,000 in wages weekly. There has been no general strike in the textile industry in Fall River for over twenty years. There are nearly two hundred incorporated industries located in this city including print works, bleacheries, a hat factory and shipbuilding works.

It has fine roads in every direction and is the centre of a circle of twenty miles radius within which live 600,000 persons. This makes it particularly desirable as a centre of distribution.

It is located on Narragansett Bay at the mouth of the Taunton River. This harbor has a natural twenty-five foot chanel and anchorage but eighteen miles from the Atlantic Ocean.

Fall River is among the first twenty American ports in foreign imports and is exceeded only by New York, Baltimore and Philadelphia on the Atlantic Coast in intercoastal trade through the Panama Canal. It has excellent steamship, freight, and passenger service

and possesses twenty-seven wharves. The city is the eastern terminal of the Fall River Line to New York. It is served by the New York, New Haven & Hartford Railroad with excellent fast train service to all important railway centres.

The largest fuel oil refinery in New England now a million barrels a month plant is located here. The first unit of an electric super-power plant, which will ultimately produce 275,000 horse power, is being erected on the banks of the Taunton River.

Fall River is beautifully situated on high land about 300 feet above sea level and stretches along a steep hillside for a distance of about 11 miles with a width of about 7 1-3 miles. Situated between the Watuppa Lakes and the bay, the climate is ideal. The winters are mild and summer heat moderated by breezes from bay and lakes. There are 11,000 dwellings, 148 public and office buildings, over 160 miles of accepted streets and 39 miles of railway tracks within the city limits.

There are 16 banks whose annual clearings amount to more than \$125,000,000. The city is well provided with modern hospitals as well as 86 schools, including Textile, vocational, parochial and continuation schools, 72 churches, 12 theatres and 6 hotels. Fall River has an active Chamber of Commerce, a Merchants' Association, Cotton Manufacturers' Association and Rotary, Kiwanis and Lions' Clubs.

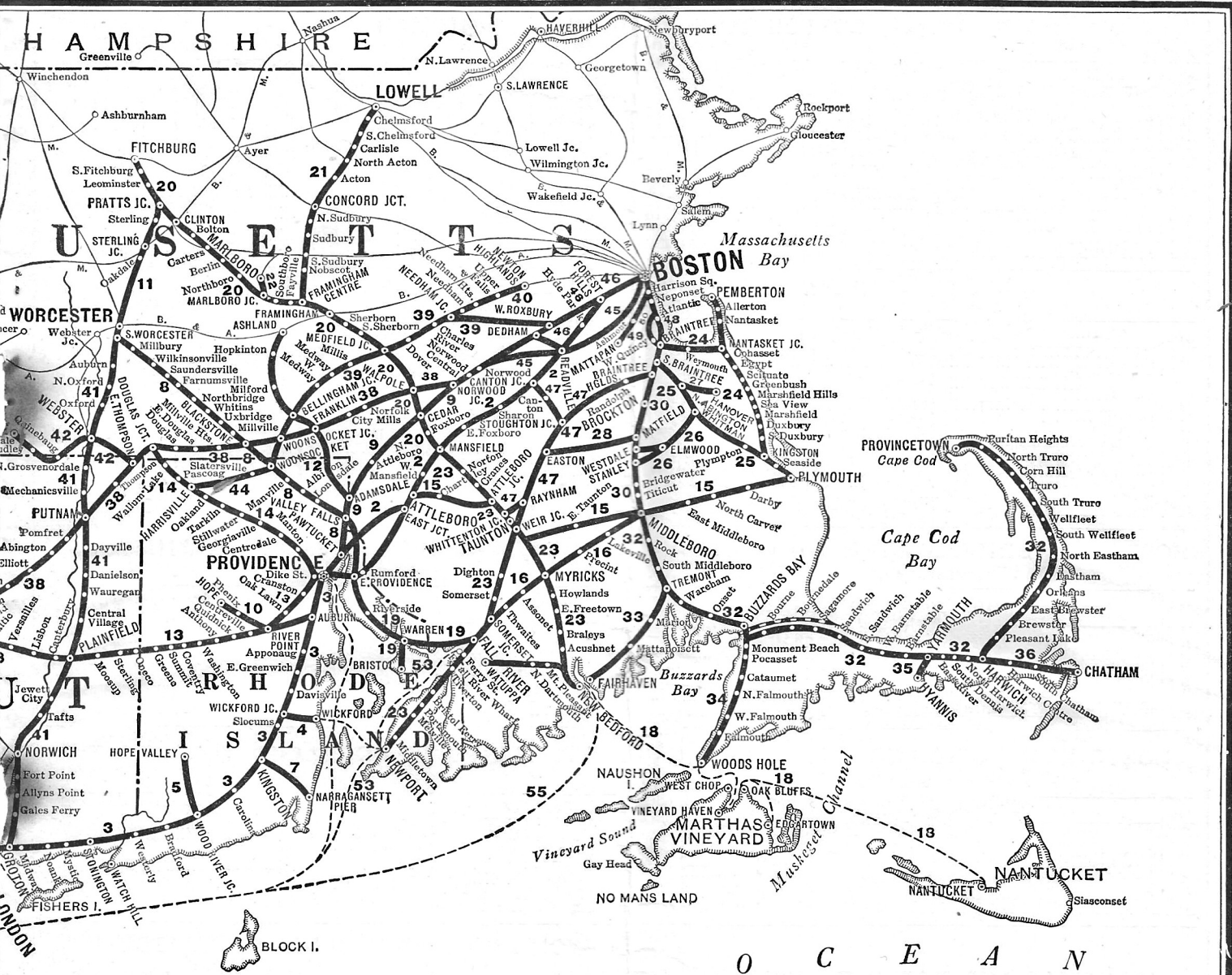

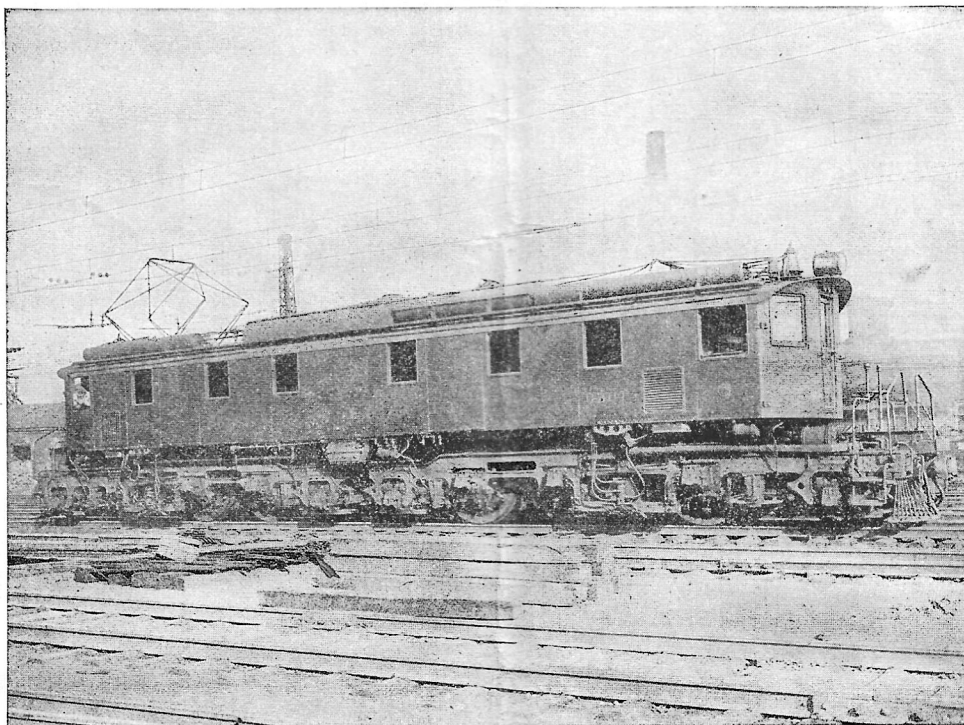

THE electrified territory of the N. Y., N. H. & H. R. R. is now one hundred per cent electrically operated except for trains from other sections which are handled by steam engines and pass over short sections of the electrified territory. This has been made possible thru the recent receipt from the builders of 12 new electric passenger locomotives, which are the largest single phase passenger locomotives yet constructed.

Electric operation covers all passenger and freight service between New Haven and New York and includes service to Grand Central Terminal and to the Pennsylvania Station via Hell Gate Bridge and the New York Connecting Railway.

Electric passenger locomotives and multiple unit cars are handling an average of 1,544 trains, making 97,166 miles per week; while electric freight locomotives are hauling 237 trains, making 23,652 miles each week. Electric locomotives can make a greater number of trips per day than the steam units on account of more rapid handling at turning points and this, together with the recent receipt of new electric locomotive equipment, makes possible the release of a substantial number of heavy steam engines for use on other parts of the System, thus materially improving the service in general.

Sixty-four passenger locomotives, 37 freight locomotives, 16 switching locomotives, 35 multiple unit motor cars, and 65 multiple unit trailer cars comprise the New Haven's electric fleet which carries the heaviest main line traffic of any electrified railroad of its length in the world.

Complete electric operation of the electrified territory has been the goal toward which the New Haven has been working since 1906. This goal has now been achieved.

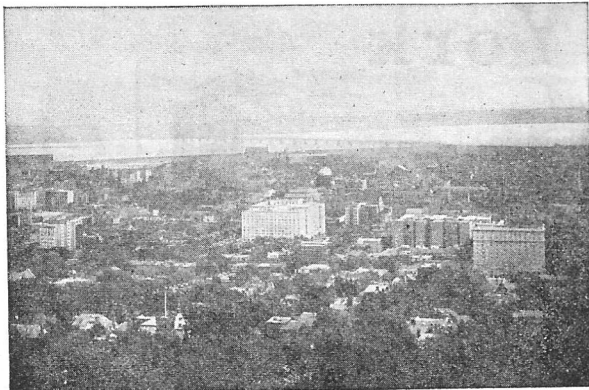
