1. Ref C/S query, dated 14 Nov 49: "What authority exists for one of FEC Major Commands to communicate direct with agencies outside the FEC, i.e., RYCOM with D/A or PE".

2. a. Direct communication between major FEC commands and agencies outside the FEC is authorized in the following regulations:

(1) Special Regulations 730-5-1, AFR 67-22, 15 July 49

(2) Operations Instructions No. 6, GHQ FEC, 1 Sep 49.

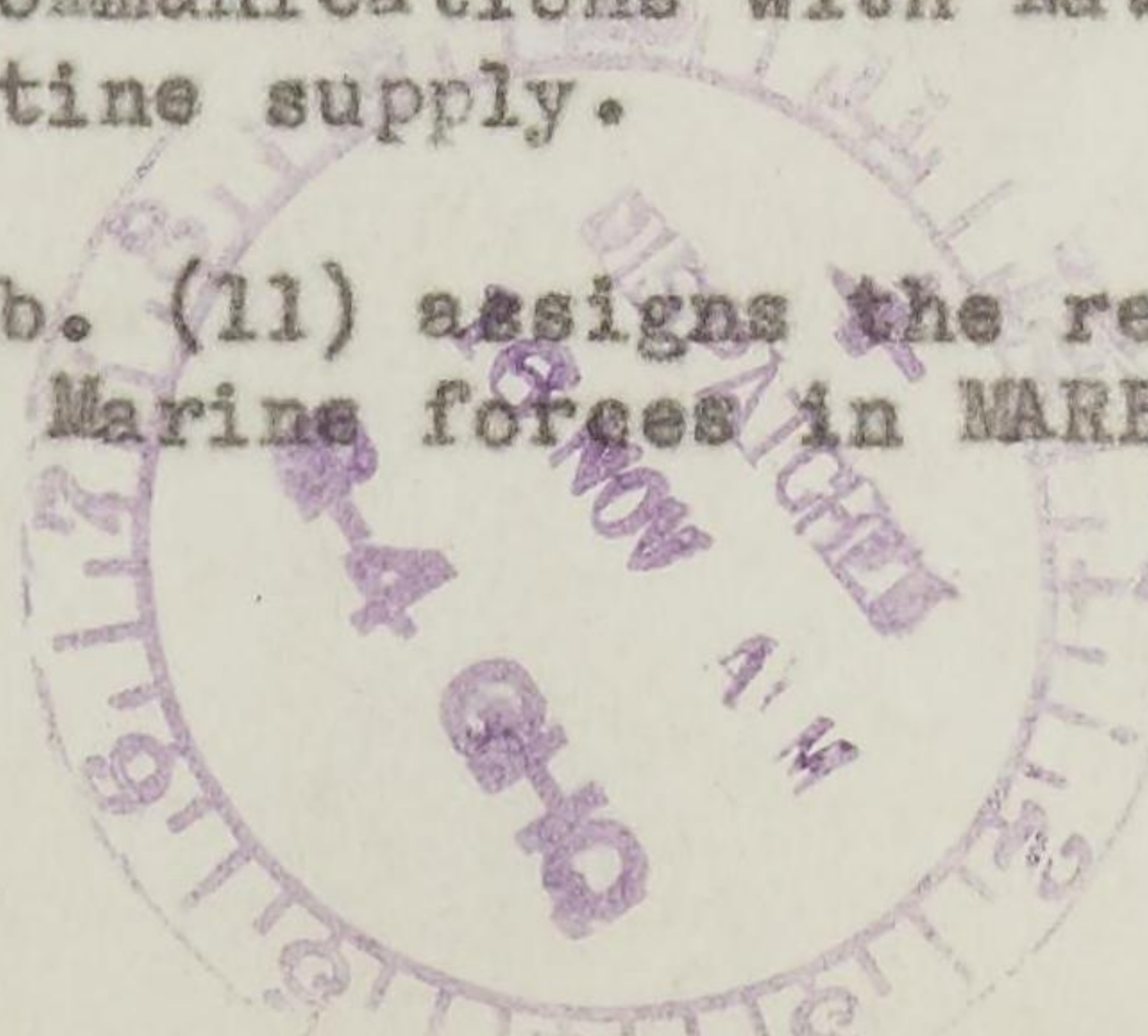
b. In addition, direct communication may be authorized by CINCFE in special instances.

3. Special Regulations 730-5-1 (AFR 67-22) 15 July 49 contains the following broad authority. Direct communication, on technical matters concerning oversea supply, between Air and Army Departments or their subordinate agencies and commanders of Army and Air Force components of oversea commands (FEAF) or oversea requisitioning agencies (RYCOM, MARBO, PHILCOM (AF), and Eighth Army) is authorized and directed. Direct communication may include recommendations for changes in supply policy or related matters outside the authority granted the oversea commander, subject only to a restriction that, where appropriate, such recommendations will be endorsed by the unified oversea commander. Direct communication is authorized, however, without restrictions, on purely routine supply matters such as shipping schedules, supply availability, and other technical matters concerning army or air supplies.

4. Operations Instructions No. 6, GHQ FEC, 1 Sep 49, by inference, authorizes certain major commands or separate components to communicate directly with agencies outside FEC. Included in the category are:

a. Paragraph 3. h. Annex Number 3, Logistics states that levels of supply for Navy and Marine Corps forces assigned to FEC will be prescribed by COMNAVFE in accordance with Department of Navy supply procedures. This policy recognizes CINCFE's operational responsibility, under J CofS directives, to evaluate the logistical requirements of COMNAVFE, while leaving to them the privilege of direct communications with Navy Department on technical matters pertaining to routine supply.

b. Paragraph 2.b. (11) assigns the responsibility for logistic support of U. S. Navy and Marine forces in MARBO to CINCPAC, thus necessitating direct communication.

c. Paragraph 2.b. (12) assigns the responsibility for certain Army and Air Force construction and real estate activities in FEC, except in Japan, to the Division Engineer, Western Ocean Division. While the necessary direct communication in this instance is not specifically from a major command, such command is directly affected.

5. "When specifically granted by CINCFE" is in addition to above policies. A recent example was CINCFE's authorization to RYCOM to purchase bleacher seats for a recreation ground. The authority contained a statement that direct communication with the San Francisco Port was authorized.

6. Other authorized direct communications include Naval units subject to the provisions of a Joint Logistics Agreement and special units functioning under J CofS Directives such as those designated to perform activities incident to Atomic warfare.
