SUBJECT: Custody of Reparations Installations

THRU: Chief, Foreign Affairs Section
Wakayama Prefectural Government

TO: Finance Bureau, Wakayama Branch
Fuso Metal Industries, Ltd., Wakayama City

1. All signs posted at reparations installations will be immediately removed which:

- a. Indicate that such installations are under the protection of GHQ, SCAP.
- b. Make any reference to custody by Occupation Force units.
- c. State or imply that restrictions entry will be approved or enforced by Occupation Force personnel.

2. Restriction on entry into reparations installations by means of passes signed by Occupation personnel will be continued.

3. Signs and entry restrictions directed by appropriate Japanese custodial authorities in order to comply with custody requirements may be continued providing specific reference to the Occupation Forces is neither included nor implied.

4. Japanese agencies are still responsible for custody of reparations installations and custody will continue in accordance with the provisions of directives and memorandums previously issued.
