- 1. Reference is made to Memorandum for the Japanese Government, AG 676.3 (14 Jul 47)005, SCAPIN 1744, 14 July 1947, subject: Control of Radio Communications, as amended.
- 2. Inclosure 1 is a combined list of all permanent Japanese fixed and land radio stations. Temporary authorizations in general are excluded from this list, however, a few which affect permanent service requirements are added.
