10. A Record of the Proceedings of the Society shall be kept by the Secretaries.

11. These Rules shall not be altered or amended except at a General Meeting of the Society, and after notice shall have been given at the next previous Meeting, stating the purport and intention of such alteration.

REGULATIONS FOR THE LIBRARY,

Adopted at the Annual Meeting, January, 1851.

1. The Library of the Kilkenny Archæological Society shall be divided into two classes, viz., 1st, Printed Books.—2ndly, Manuscripts, Prints, Drawings, Rubbings, &c.

2. All Books of the First Class shall be lent to Members under the Regulations following :----

3. No Member of the Society shall be entitled to borrow more than a single Work at any one time.

4. Each Work, so borrowed, may be retained for one Calendar Month; but the borrower may have it again for the same period, if no other Member shall have applied for the Work before the expiration of that term.

5. A Register shall be kept by the Secretaries, in which shall be entered the name of the Borrower, of the Work borrowed, and the dates when the said Work was borrowed and returned.

6. Any Member wishing to borrow a Work, shall enter his name in a book to be kept by the Secretaries for the purpose; and if more than one Member shall apply for the same book, the first applicant shall have the preference.

7. If any volume, so lent out of the Society's Library, be injured or defaced, by writing or otherwise, the Member to whom it shall have been lent at the time, shall pay the full value of the book as marked in the Society's Catalogue.

8. A fine of one shilling per week shall be paid by any Member retaining a book (except under the regulations of the 4th Rule) beyond one month.

9. The Second Class into which the Society's Library is divided, shall not be removed from the custody of the Secretaries; but Members shall have the right of access to it at the Society's apartments.
