LOCATION: Three and one-half miles west of Ohioa and one-fourth north of state highway No. 74. Four miles east of federal highway 81 and one-fourth north of state highway No. 74.

Discount of 10% allowed on orders of \$5.00 or more.

Iris grow easier and multiply faster than any other perennial. Plant them in a sunny location that has good drainage. The bulb or rhizome should be planted just under the surface, not too deep. The roots should be spread out and the soil packed around them.

The best time to plant iris is in July and August, although they can be transplanted at any time of the year when the ground is not frozen.

All orders are accepted subject to the condition and availability of stock at shipping time or being sold out. Early orders will be appreciated.

We have lilacs, hemerocallis, pansies, poppies, rock garden plants, and other perennials for those within driving distance.
