Part I. Para 1. Information contained herein pertaining to GARIOA Project 412 based on the following:

- a. GARIOA P-412 funding ceiling is \$3,297,796 (ref 1).
- b. Current headquarters plan is that all SCAP employees, with exception of those transferring to State or desired by State thru 17 May (ref 4), will have received RIF letters on or before 31 March 1952, with sufficient SCAP personnel being available thru 30 April for phaseout of SCAP activities.
- c. Estimated terminal leave savings on personnel to be transferred to State and on personnel for whom reassignments are expected within the FEC have been taken into account.
- d. Estimates include provision through 30 April for the personnel referred to in reference 5 since, under current planning, these personnel are included in phaseout group referred to in sub para b above (approximate cost per pay period of this group, including current terminal leave accumulations, \$7,305).

2. Total estimated requirement for P-412 (salaries, terminal leave, travel time), including funds for personnel referred to in para 2 mymsg CX-65331 thru 17 May, is \$3,220,740. This will result in a balance of \$77,056 available for transfer to State from P-412. These estimates

apply to either para 3 A or 3 B of message DA 903531.

PART II. Para 1. Total estimated local requirements for P-415 (Japan) and P-432 are \$35,000 and \$175,000 respectively. Request authority to transfer funds between these two administrative projects as required.

2. See CINCFE message C-65052, 10 March ref P-452.

3. Review of USCAR funds is currently being covered by series of messages between DEPTAR, CINCFE and DEPGOVUSCAR.

PART III. Ref par 5, DA 904420. Continuing review of GARIOA fund requirements will be made in order to report any revisions prior to 1 June 1952.
