MEMORANDUM FOR: JAPANESE GOVERNMENT

SUBJECT: Authority to Negotiate and Sign Financial and Trade
Agreements

1. The Japanese Government is hereby authorized to enter into negotiations, on its own behalf, with other countries, with a view toward concluding financial and trade agreements or arrangements, trade plans and memoranda, side letters and other documents in implementation thereof.

2. The Japanese Government is hereby authorized to sign and to exchange with the representatives of the governments concerned, documents resulting from negotiations as authorized, to be effective upon the coming into force of the treaty of peace between the Allied Powers, or any of them, and Japan.
