- Joint author of a report on revolutionary meeting held by Fidel CASTRO and others at the Hotel Plaza in Miami on 26 Nov. 1955. The report was published in Bolivia. Subj., a vehement opponent of Batista, is the secretary general of the "unified" Organizations of Raul C. DAJ. Unreportedly, he is foremost among supporters of Fidel CASTRO within that Orito group. At the aforementioned meeting in Miami, CASTRO spoke at the gathering.

Reported to be a bodyguard accompanying CASTRO to the U.S. In 1956 the Communist Party of Cuba proposed establishing a new organization called National Congress for Peace and Democracy. A petition endorsing the organization was signed by a list of individuals described as Communist sympathizers, including Luis CONTE Aguero.

Departed Mar 6 April for Miami. Escorted to airport by Argentine Amb but status was not that of political refugee being given safeconduct. In other words, he departed as ordinary Cuban citizen. Anticipated that subj will engage in much publicity. Line he will take is that Raul CASTRO and Che GUEVARA as well as Communists have hijacked Fidel CASTRO's revolution. He will stress his own close relationship w/CASTRO and CASTRO's earlier alleged strong anti-Communist attitudes.

Subj arrested at the airport in Quat City on 16 Jan on the basis of information that Subj is an agent of Fidel CASTRO in contact with enemies of the Govt of Quat. On 20 Jan deported to Salv. Subj, a soldier of fortune, has been involved in his rev. activities for a long time
