EMBASSY OF THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC
WASHINGTON, D. C. (S)

A confidential informant, who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised on July 24, 1969, that I. Irving Davidson, registered agent for the Nicaraguan Government and the Israeli Military Industry, made it known to [Mario Rodriguez, First Secretary, Embassy of the Dominican Republic,] that Colonel Mariano Paget, formerly head of the Cuban Government "Bureau for the Repression of Communist Activities" under the Fulgencio Batista regime, was in Washington, D. C. Davidson expressed the thought that it would be a good idea if Paget had a talk with the Dominican Ambassador, Luis Thomen, before Paget leaves Washington, D.C., for New York on July 25, 1969. (S)

The informant later advised that an appointment had been arranged for Paget to see [Ambassador Thomen] at 8:00 p.m. July 24, 1969. The informant, however, was unable to determine the reason for this meeting and was not able to advise the reason for Paget's expected trip to New York. (S)
