For credit references, if you do not have a credit account, you may use a school to which you have paid tuition, any store, gasoline stations, motor car dealer, auto repair shop, hotel, life insurance company, landlord, doctor, lawyer, dentist, clubs, or organizations where dues are paid, or any other business establishment to which you have paid in cash for services or goods and where there is a record of your dealings. If all these possibilities fail, use a person who has loaned you money or would loan you money should the need arise.
