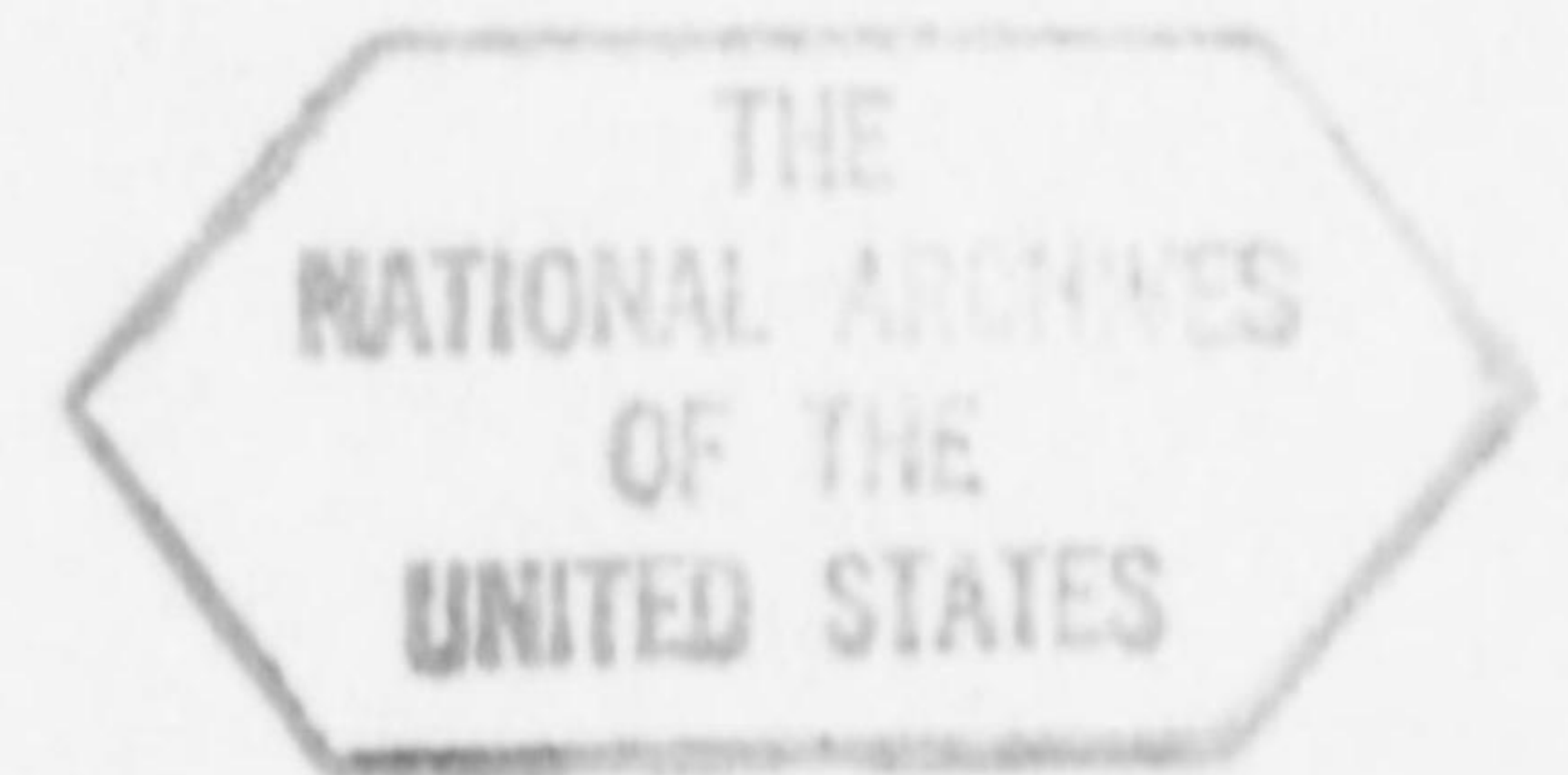

SUBJECT: Legal Holiday - - Memorial Day

TO: See Distribution

1. Memorial Day, 30 May 1951, being a legal holiday, Chiefs of Civil Affairs Regions are authorized to suspend operations except for retention on duty of usual holiday details.
2. Senior advisers of NPR Regions will retain on duty sufficient U. S. Army personnel to provide adequate assistance to NPR personnel.
3. Department of the Army civilian employees will be required to work 32 hours the week of 27 May - 2 June 1951. Absence in excess of that prescribed above, for recreational purposes, will be charged to the civilian employee as annual leave.
