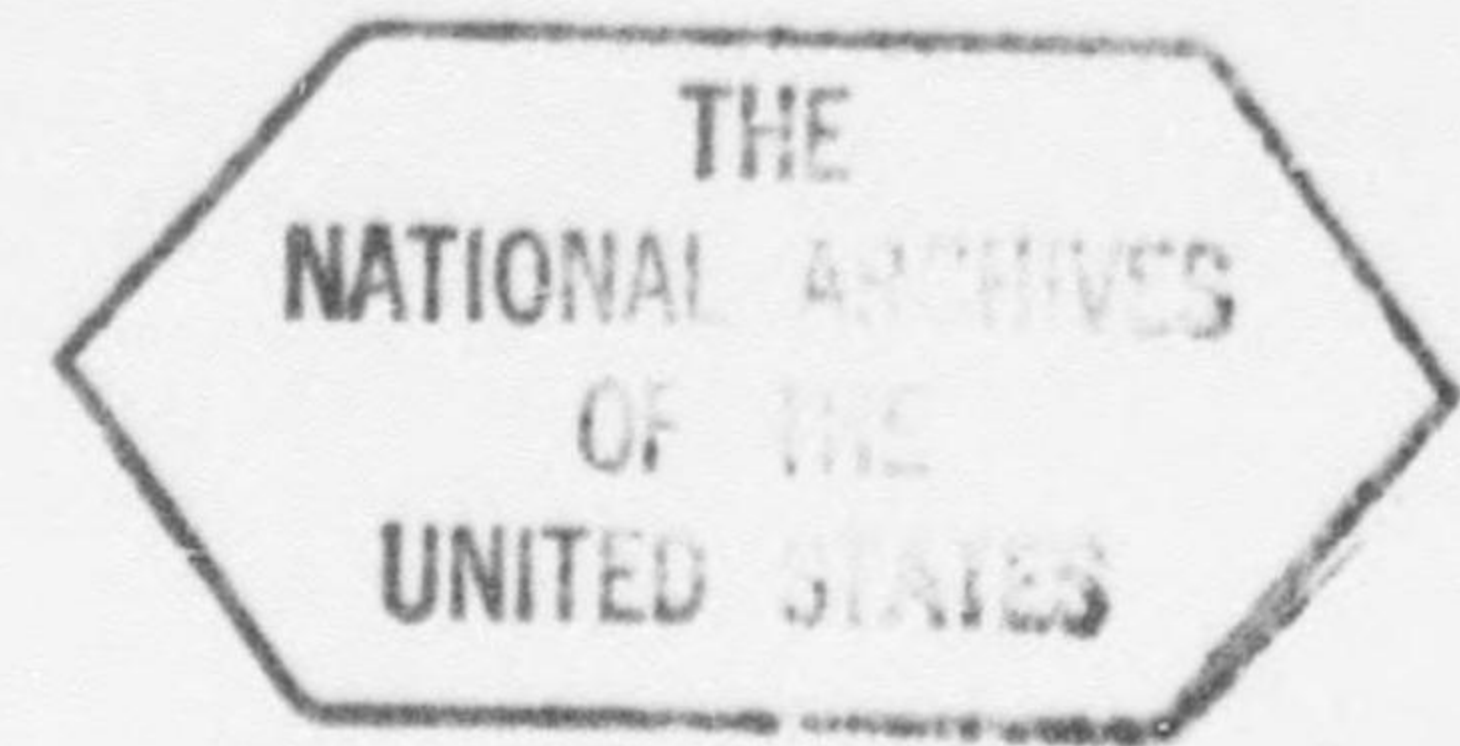

Reference paragraph 12, FEC Circular 26, 1948 and CINCFE message ZX 23990, 3 Oct 47. This message in four parts.

Part 1. In view of the acute shortage of billets in the Tokyo Metropolitan Area, the following controls on all intra-command TDY to Tokyo are established and are effective immediately:

a. Requests for periods of TDY which require use of bachelor billets under the control of Hq Comdt, GHQ, FEC, will be submitted by radio and addressed to CINCFE, Attention AG-MI, Tokyo, Japan.

b. Radios requesting TDY will be by major commands only and will be dispatched in sufficient time so as to reach this headquarters ten days prior to start of period for which TDY is requested.

c. Addressees will be notified of action taken on requests for TDY by radio. Orders placing personnel on TDY will cite authority. For FEAF and NAVFE personnel, this action will be confined to statement of availability of billets.



2x-47409 Subj is Redesignation and Recomputation of Category Statements Officers and Warrant Officers, serving Category IV and Category V for Indefinite Period. This message in 4 parts.

Part I. DEPTAR msg DL 39928 dated 2 Nov 51 quoted for info and nec action: "MYMSG DL 32920, 12 Jul 51 ref SR 135-215-5 as amended.

1. Prior to 1 Jan 52 Cat and expiration date for all offs and WO serving Cat IV will be redesignated and recomputed as fol:

a. New designation will be Cat IV-17 expiring 17 months from date of entry on AD, for those offs and WO who served on AD in any br of armed forces for 12 months or more between 7 Dec 41 and 2 Sep 45 both dates inclusive and who (1) were ordered into active mil svc from the inactive or vol res or (2) were members of inactive or vol res and were asg involuntarily to organized res units after 25 Jun 50 and subsequently ordered to AD with those units.

b. For all other Cat IV offs and WO new designation will be Cat IV-24 which will expire 24 months from the date of entry on AD.

2. Comd auth to approve appl for new Cat may waive max age in grade limitations prescribed by Para 4 BSR 135-215-5 as amended subj to the fol:

a. An off or WO who cannot complete new Cat prior to attaining max age for his grade and who is serving in Cat I, II, III, or IV, or those offs who have been placed in Cat V by reason of having been over max age in grade may apply for new Cat I, II, or III provided he can complete

new Cat prior to the last day of month in which he reaches age 60.

b. When new Cat I, II or III is aprvd for a Cat IV off an order will be issued as prescribed in Para 5 Sec 2 Cir 51 DA 51 and 2 copies of orders fwd T.G Attn AGPI-0.

c. Appl disapproved by approving auth will be fwd T.G Attn AGG (Br concerned) for disposition (reassg or rel from AD).

3. a. Any off who has been placed in Cat V as result of declining to apply for new Cat or as result of an indiv directive from DA may apply for new Cat II or III.

b. Cat expiration date of Cat V offs who are eligible under auth contained Para 2 or Sub Para a above to apply for new Cat and who do not apply will be recomputed so as to expire 12 months from date of expiration of Cat in which they were serving at time they were placed in Cat V. Such offs will be rel from AD upon expiration of 12 months svc in Cat V.

c. Those Cat V offs who are ineligible to apply for new Cat (those within 1 year of reaching age 60) will be rel from AD on last day of month in which they reach age 60. Cat expiration date will be changed accordingly.

d. Hereafter in those cases where an off is placed in Cat V pursuant GO 48 DA 7 Jul 51 as result of declining to apply for new Cat the new Cat V will expire and off will be separated 12 months after date he is placed in Cat V.

4. For each actions outlined in Paras 1, 2, and 3 above appropriate entries will be made in Items 11 and 22 AD AGO 66 and on unit MR indicating new cat and expiration date. Rept of change AD AGO 66 A will be submitted with least practicable delay.

5. Cited msg. Provisions Para 1 above do not apply to offs already serving Cat IV-17 or Cat IV-24 nor do they apply to offs ordered AD under auth Off Pers Act of 47 (Bul 18 AD 47)."

Part II. DEPTAR msg DA 32920 dated 12 Jul 51 notal prescribes that those off ordered into active mil svc on or after 9 Jul 51 from inactive or vol res who served on AD for period of 12 months or more in any br of armed forces between 7 Dec 41 and 2 Sep 45 inclusive will be placed in Cat IV-17 expiring 17 months after date of rept. All others will be placed in Cat IV-24 expiring 24 months after date of rpt

*ZX 46391* Part I. Para 1. Maj comd will take nec action to effect rel from AD of offs (including WO) who were ordered into active mil svc under auth contained Sec 21 Universal Mil Tng and Svc Act as amended from the inact or vol res (including those inact and vol res off who were involuntarily asg to res units after 25 Jun 50 and subsequently ordered into active mil svc with such units) and who served on AD in any br of the Armed Forces for 12 months or more between 7 Dec 41 and 2 Sep 45 both dates inclusive. Eligible offs will be released not later than the date that they complete 17 months active svc performed after 25 Jun 50 unless such indiv have heretofore vol or hereafter vol in writing to remain on AD for longer period as prescribed in para 4 below or unless they are retained on AD by the SA as provided in para 3 below.

Para 2. Because of local conditions it may be nec to stagger rel of offs eligible for rel in any one month. Accordingly maj comds are auth to effect rel of an eligible off at any time during last 60 days of his 17 months svc. In determining the sequence for rel a maj factor to be considered will be the maint of unit effectiveness. However insofar as practicable consideration will also be given to length of WW II svc, combat svc in Korea and dependency or hardship.

Para 3. Indiv who are eligible for separation in accordance with provs this directive will not be retained on AD involuntarily beyond the completion of 17 months active svc. No exceptions by reason of critical specialty or duty asg will be made by fld comd and rqsts for such exceptions will not be submitted to DA. The SA will designate a few critical specl who will be released ASAP but not later than upon completion of 24 months svc. The DA will notify such offs indiv of their retention on AD beyond 17 months.

Para 4. Appl for rel from AD need not be submitted. All eligible offs will be separated unless they have heretofore extended or hereafter extend their pd of active svc voluntarily. They may apply for new Cat I, II, or III or may extend their pd of svc for any pd up to a total 24 months on curr tour AD at any time prior to separation except that offs stationed overseas will not be permitted to apply after departure from the oversea comd.

Para 5. Appl for Cat I, II or III will be processed in accordance with SR 135-215-5 as amended (see Sec 2 Cir 51 DA 9 Jul 51 and Sec 3 Cir 82 DA 1 Oct 51). Cat I appl will not be approved if new expiration date would be earlier than the applicants curr cat expiration date.

Para 6. Offs who voluntarily extend their pd of svc for any pd up to a total 24 months on curr tour of AD will be placed in Cat IV - 17 and will be required to execute fol statement: "I (name, grade, SN), a member of the ORC having been advised of my eligibility for rel from active mil svc upon completion of 17 months active svc under the provs of Sec 21, Universal Mil Tng and Svc Act, as amended, hereby waive such right and voluntarily consent to remain on AD until (date), at which time I will have completed (number of months not to exceed 24) months active svc on curr tour. I understand that by signing this statement I render myself liable for world-wide asg, if otherwise qualified." The original statement will be filed in the off fld mil 201 file and one signed copy will be fwd TAG attn AGPI-O. Cat expiration date will be changed to reflect extension and changes will be recorded as required by Para 6c, SR 135-215-5 as changed. The order required by Para 5 Sec 2 Cir 51 DA 9 Jul 51 will not be issued for offs who do not extend beyond a total of 24 months on curr tour. Two copies of orders will be fwd TAG attn AGPI-O for all other offs.

Para 7. Pers separated under provs of this directive will be rel fr AD in accordance with the provs of SR 135-175-5 as amended (see DA 32122 dtd 11 Oct 51) orders will include the fol auth for rel: Sec 515 (d) offs pers Act of 47 (Bul 18 WD 47) and DA msg DA 37870, 27 Oct 51.

Para 8. This directive does not apply to:

- a. Offs ordered to AD as members of ORC or NGUS units (except as indicated in Para 1 above) or as mobilization designees, regardless of pres asg.
- b. Inact and vol res offs who had less than 1 year active svc between 7 Dec 41 and 2 Sep 45 both dates inclusive.
- c. Pers who vol for and were ordered into active mil svc under auth contained in Offs Pers Act of 47.
- d. Offs ordered into active mil svc involuntarily but who now are serving voluntarily in Cat I, II, III or V.

Para 9. Offs specified in Para 8a and b above will be required to serve the 24 month pd of active svc auth by law.

Para 10. In the event that admin difficulty should arise in determining res status from which offs were ordered into active mil svc, maj comd are auth to rest nec info from maj comd which issued AD orders. CINCFE will be info adee on such requests.

Para 11. Separate instr being issued governing recomputation cat expiration dates for all offs serving in Cat IV who were ordered into active mil svc prior 9 Jul 51.
