

MEMORANDUM FOR: Parliamentary and Political Division,
Government Section

SUBJECT : The Economic Stabilization Board Establishment Bill

1. Objection is made to subject bill for failure to include a Personnel Bureau in the Economic Stabilization Board Proper and Personnel Divisions in the Price Board and in the Economic Investigation Board. Such omission will, in the opinion of this Division, defeat an occupation objective by impairing the program and controls of the National Personnel Authority. For essential operation and controls the National Personnel Authority must function through a personnel unit at the highest operating echelon within each agency.

2. Objection is also made to Article 38 which may lead to the mistaken assumption that budgetary appropriations are the only limitations on allowances and travelling expenses. It is recommended that such article be revised to read as follows:

Article 38

Allowances and travelling expenses shall be paid to Advisors and Counsellors in accordance with law.
