

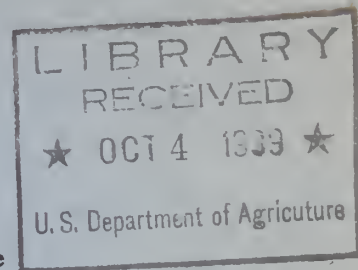

An action program designed to  
bring about basic adjustments in  
the use and treatment of the land.

Defensive action against land decline is essentially a matter of good land use.

Against a broad background of state and federal effort to relieve social and economic pressures which cause land abuse, the Soil Conservation Service is helping farmers to make constructive changes in the physical treatment of their land.

These changes involve the adoption of conservation farming practices, the retirement of submarginal lands from uneconomic production to constructive use, the development of farm woodlands as an economic asset and a conservation measure, the installation of water facilities to promote sounder and more productive use of the land in semi-arid sections, and the use of land treatment measures that help in controlling and preventing floods.

The objective is always one of establishing the kind of land use that will conserve the soil resource and provide a more rewarding life on the land.

The following maps show the localities in which one or more phases of this broad land-use program are now being carried forward.

# SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICTS

Under authority of state law, farmers in a number of states have formed local organizations for community action to conserve soil resources and promote better land use. These organizations, known as soil conservation districts, are social mechanisms through which the people on the land can join in a concerted program of Land use adjustment.

The Soil Conservation Service projects its work onto the land largely through the instrumentality of these independent local organizations, by assisting the districts in the development and execution of plans for needed land use reforms.

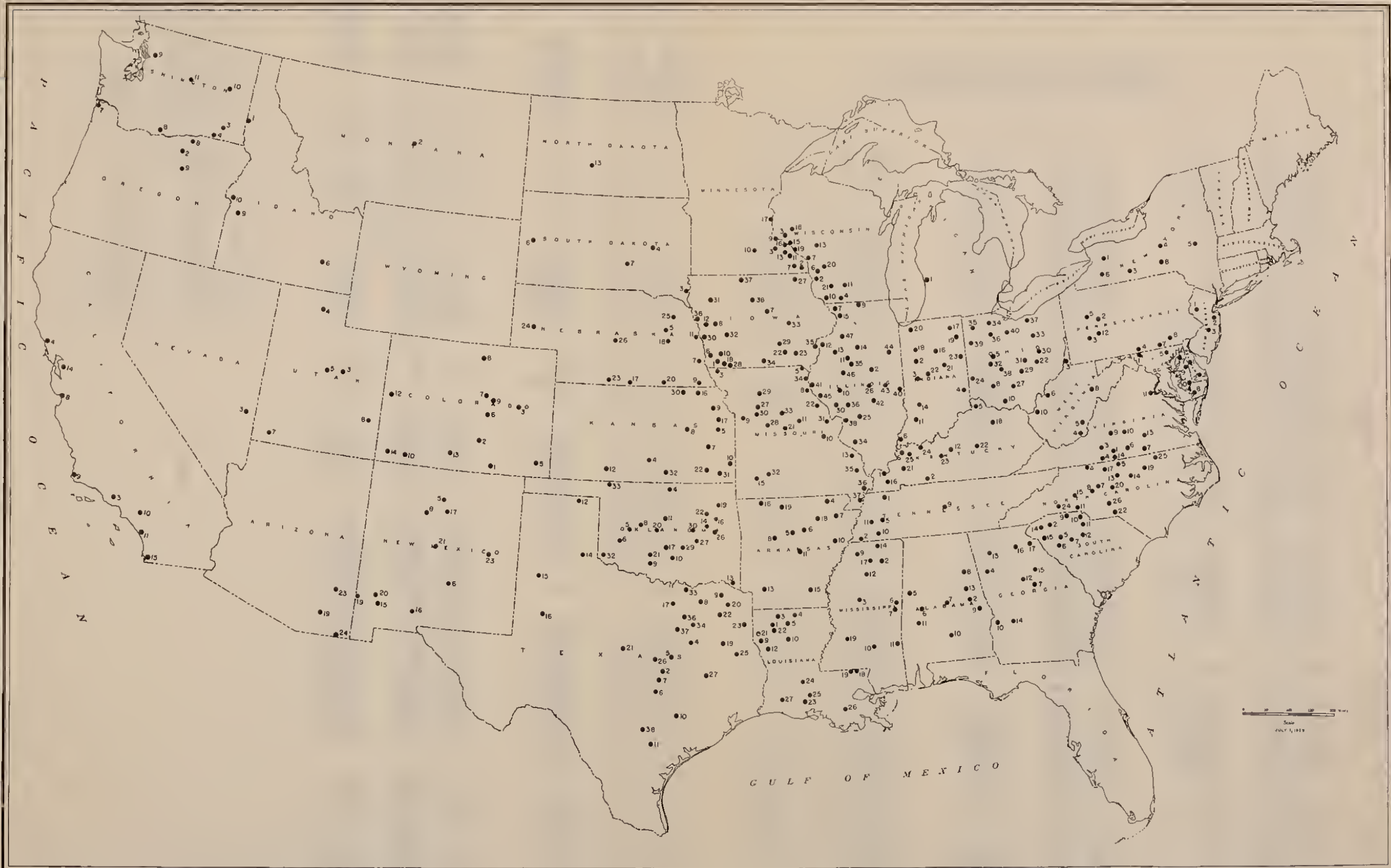
## DEMONSTRATION PROJECTS

Large-scale demonstration projects, averaging about 25,000 acres in size, are operated by the Service as a means of spreading conservation practices among land users. On each project, farmers are invited to cooperate with the Service in formulating and carrying out a complete program of soil conservation. Such a program involves treatment of the farm as a whole with such measures as may be adaptable to each component parcel of land.

Judicious purchases of sub-marginal land not only relieve distressed people but make possible the rearrangement of ownership patterns, enlargement of operating units, and similar social and economic adjustments necessary to conservation and wise use of the land. Worn land taken out of uneconomic cultivation is developed for community pasture, recreation, or other beneficial use.
