

- Myanmar Nationals Bangladesh - there are serious protection and potential human rights concerns surrounding the census. Only lifesaving humanitarian assistance is allowed to be provided to Rohingya who are not officially documented as refugees; they are not allowed to work and not entitled to shelter or food assistance. Sexual and gender trafficking violence, exploitation alongside serious mental health issues serious causes of concern. In Thailand and Malaysia lack
