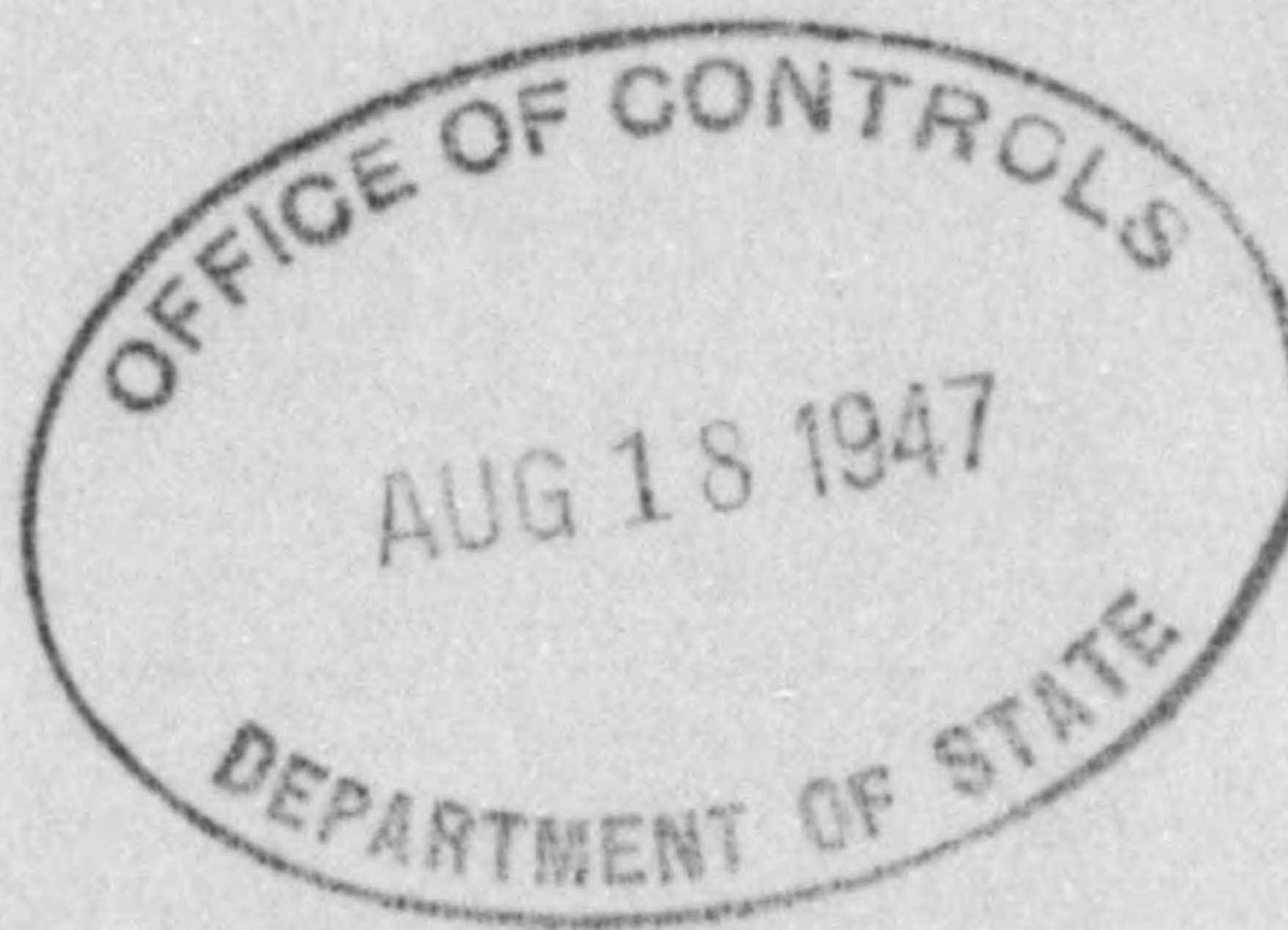

DATE: August 18, 1947

In response to Mrs. Blake's request that the Board Members redraft a paragraph concerning the delegation of the authority of the head of an agency to allow him to rid himself of some of the detail work, but at the same time retaining in the head of the agency the ultimate responsibility for the safeguarding of classified information, Colonel Blakeney phoned this morning to propose the following paragraph:

"The head of an agency may delegate <sup>performance of</sup> any or all of the functions charged to him herein, but the ultimate responsibility for the safeguarding of classified information within the agency remains with and rests upon the head of the agency."

Paragraph 2 as presently written would then become paragraph 3.
