
Sundanese Language recorded in many writing systems



"Ih atuh keun baé nu nyebut kitu-kitu baé mah, da moal matak bohak," jawab indungna.

- Old Sundanese (stone) ca. 14 AD
- Old Sundanese (copper plate) ca. 15 AD
- Western Old Quadratic Javanese (palm leaves) ca. 13-15 AD
- Old Sundanese (palm leaves) ca. 14-17 AD
- Sunda-Javanese (paper) ca. 17-19 AD
- Sunda-Arabic (paper) ca. 17-20 AD
- Latin (paper) ca. 18 AD now




Speech level in Sundanese

- No such levels recorded on inscriptions & old manuscripts
- Enter rapidly circa 15-16th century
- Sundanese nobles imitated the use of a variety of rough (ngoko) and polite (kromo) likes Javanese Mataram nobles called the "undak-usuk basa".
- It was known 6 levels of Sundanese language:
 - basa kasar (rough),
 - 2. sedeng(medium),
 - 3. lemes (polite),
 - 4. lemes pisan (very polite),
 - 5. kasar pisan (very rough), and
 - 6. basa panengah (intermediate).




Speech level in Sundanese

Congress of Sundanese Language (1988) – "Tatakrama Basa":


- 1. basa hormat (respectful)
