He is described as a shrewd businessman and wealthy. Raigorodsky married Ethel Margarite McCaleb in 1924. They were divorced Fin December, 1944. Security investigation of his former wife indicates. Sshe was a Communist Party member in Austin, Texas, during 1943 and 1944 Ewhile attending the University of Texas, that she associated with Communists, contributed funds to the Communist Party and supported front groups. During interview on August 13, 1952, she admitted Exer CP activities, claiming they ceased in 1944 and claimed in contact with Nila Magidoff, subject of Espienage - R investigation, out the United States from 1941 to 1945. A check of the Bureau files indicates that the subject of the inquiry is undoubtedly Paul Mark Raigorodsky who was last reported residing in Dallas, Texas. Raigorodsky listed his residence the attention of the Bureau on August 22, 1940, in a complaint received at San Antonio that he, by profession a consulting ment to the Russian government and that an unidentified group of license granted July 2, 1941, to the Amtorg Trading Corporation to ship distillation equipment to Moscow to be exported by Raigorodsky.
