## Women moving education since XIX century

-Historically there were more women teachers than men and that difference is maintained to this day.

-In Argentina in the late nineteenth century, women could start studying teaching with the creation and expansion of what we know here as "Normal School".

-Although their participation as workers was based on the idea that compared maternal attitude with good teaching, this allowed many middle-class women to have access to tertiary studies and to the work culture.





In Argentine history, the first women who received some kind of social recognition were those who were linked to education activities during the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries.

- Olga Cossetini, was an Argentine teacher, educator, and pedagogue. She spent her career transforming traditional schooling.
- 2. <u>Alicia Moreau de Justo</u>, Argentine politician and feminist activist. She studied in the Normal School N°1.
- 3. <u>Julieta Lanteri</u>, Italian Argentine physician leading freethinker, and activist for women's rights in Argentina as well as for social reform generally.

-WMAR Education Program started working in the educational field since 2014.


-We have developed 4 projects for differents educative levels: Secondary school, University and non-formal education.
