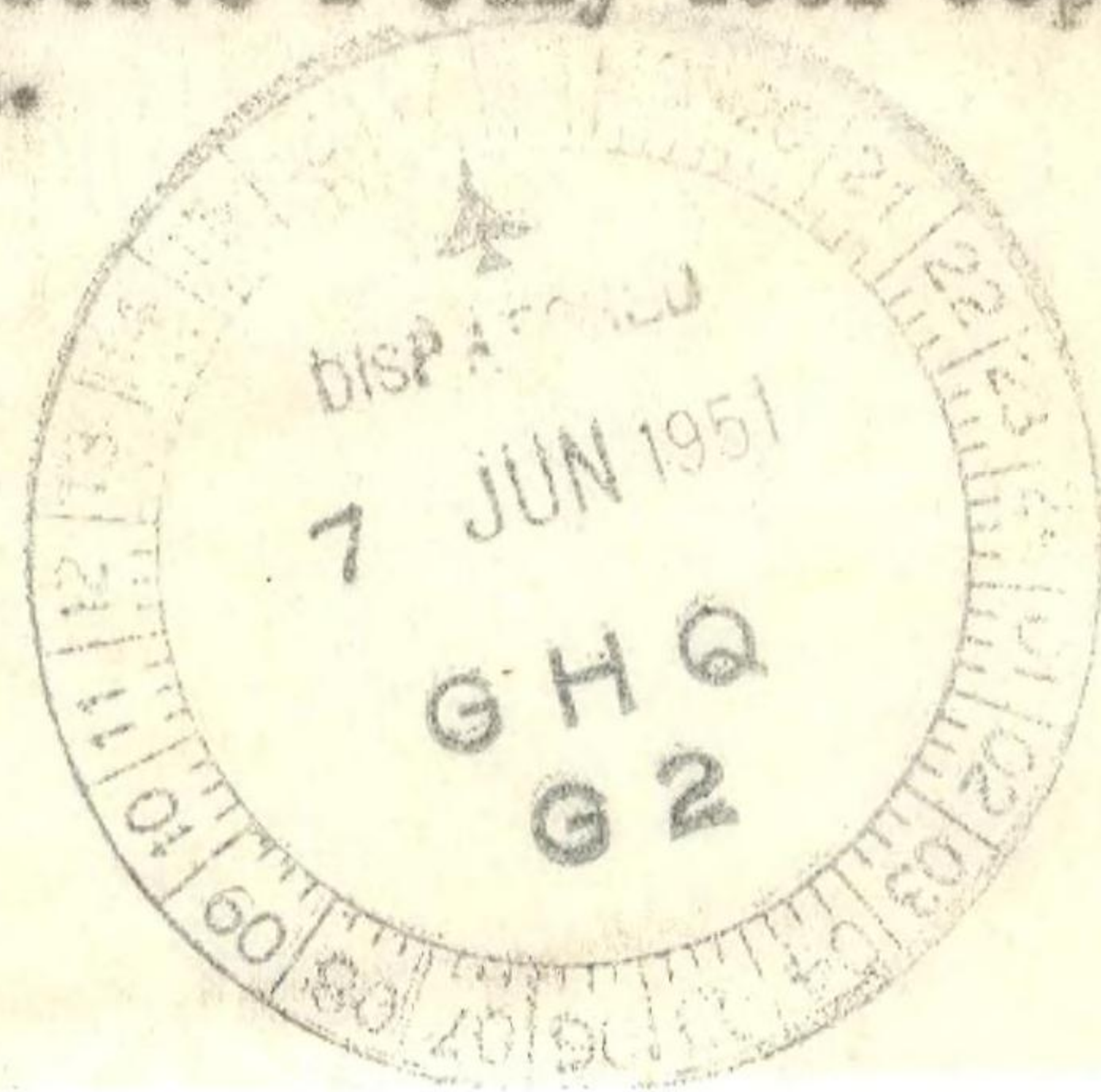
1. Reference is made to letter, your Headquarters file G2 CIC 312.128, Subject: Microfilm Specialists, dated 27 December 1950 (Incl 1) and to letter, Department of the Army File AGAO-S 313.3 (17 Nov 50)G2-M, Subject: Central Counter Intelligence Corps File, dated 21 November 1950 (Incl 2).

2. Emergency requirements which had been imposed on major sub-divisions of this section since the beginning of the hostilities in Korea have decreased to the point where it is now possible to start the microfilming project. Consequently, screening of 441st Counter Intelligence Corps Detachment case files was begun on 28 May 1951 and the actual microfilming will begin upon receipt of an approved project number from the Adjutant General. This has been requested in a separate communication to your headquarters.

3. At the present time three officers and four enlisted persons are working on the project. Two of the officers have been trained at the CIC Center to handle the technical aspects of the operation. It will require a total of fifteen persons for the project in order that activities may be conducted on a twenty-four hour basis. Allocation of four (4) additional CIC Center trained camera operators from the Zone of Interior would facilitate operations. Any assistance which can be rendered as well as any recommendations or suggestions from your headquarters will be deeply appreciated.

4. Summaries of Information covering non-sensitive activities will be filmed to include 30 June 1951. Effective 1 July 1951 copies of current summaries will be forwarded to you.
