MEMORANDUM FOR: General Ennis

SUBJECT: Kungang Political Academy Bombing and Leaflet Drop

1. The Kungang Political Academy (BT 5270) is the highest ranking political training school in North Korea. Its graduates were trained and dispatched to South Korea to organize Labor Party cells for subversive activity and to control guerrilla operations. The existence of the school was uncovered by POL-EC Group, Estimates Branch in its mission of studying, analyzing and evaluating agent reports. By matching the information received from agent reports with aerial photography the Target Information Unit of POL-EC Group pin-pointed the location of the school (Tab 1). Complete information was then submitted to Director of Targets, DI, FEAF.

2. Along with the background information furnished to FEAF (Tab 2), POL-EC recommended that a propaganda leaflet be dropped in conjunction with the bombing. Subject matter for such a leaflet was prepared by POL-EC and submitted to FEAF. The target and leaflet information both met with favor at FEAF. The target was passed on to Fifth Air Force for bombing and the suggested leaflet was forwarded to Psywar, EUSAK. In order to complete preparation of the leaflet, the date of the attack was delayed one week.

3. The academy was attacked 25 Oct by three fighter-bomber wings, using napalm and HE. BDA showed 90% hits on the target area. For maximum effect, the raid was timed according to reported class-room schedules. The leaflet, copy attached as Tab 3, was dropped in the evening, immediately after the attack.

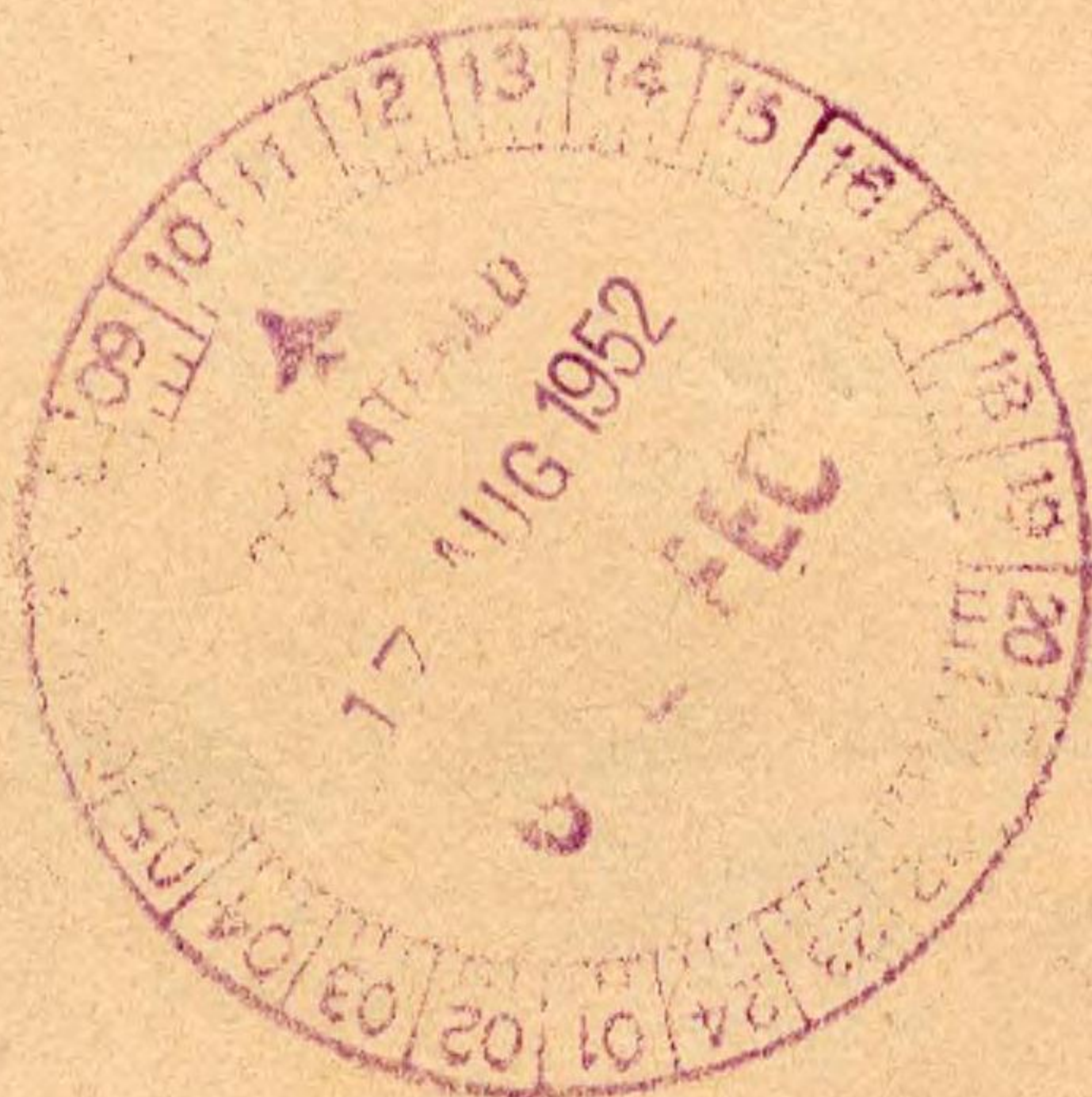
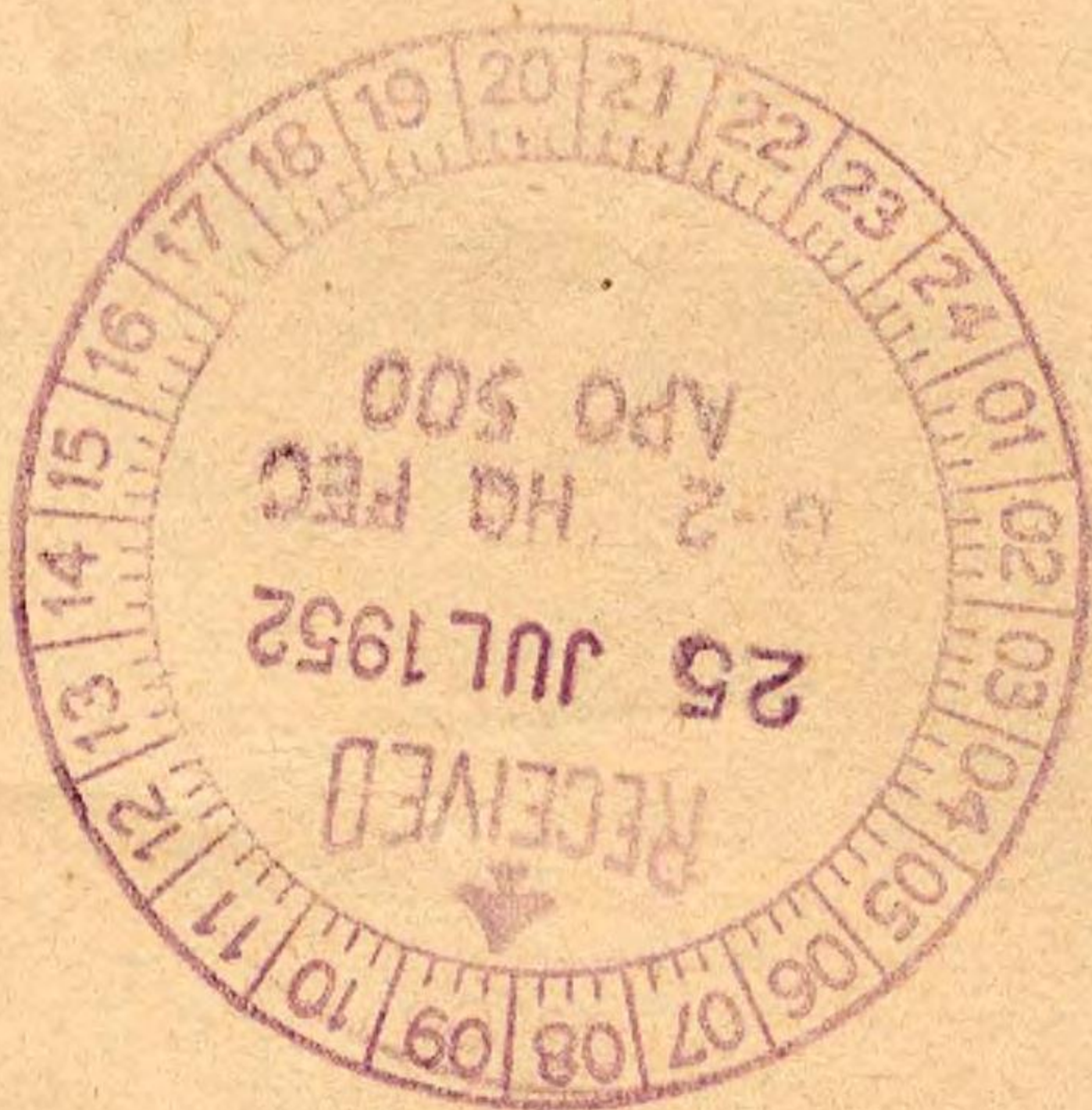

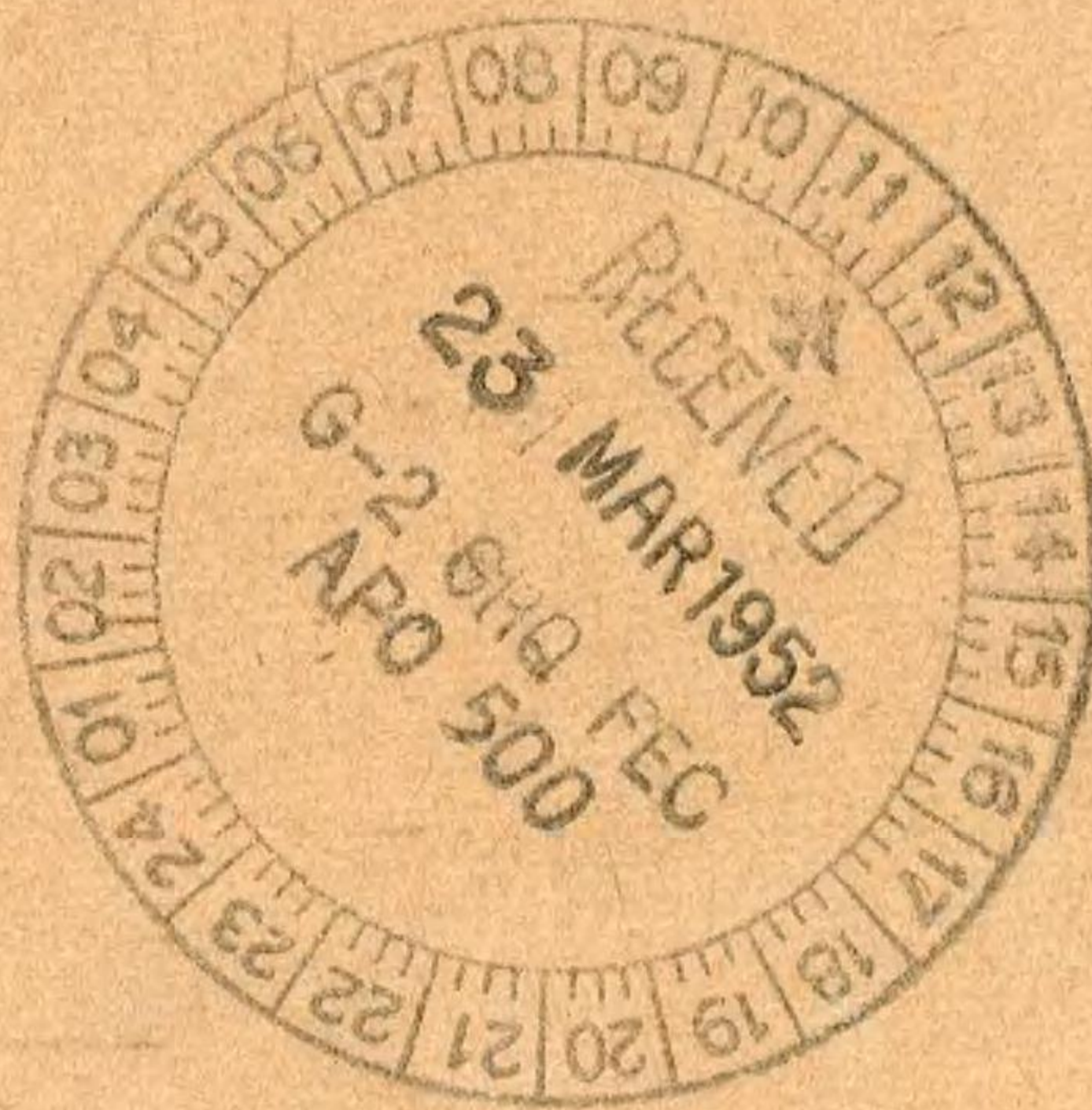
