b. Memorandum from the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, file AG 014.33 (20 Sep 46)GC, (SCAPIN-1221), dated 20 September 1946, subject as above.

- c. Memorandum from the Central Limison Office, Number 4929 (RF), dated 25 September 1946, subject as above,
- 2. Authority is granted to repatriate the individuals as requested in memorandum reference paragraph 1 c above in accordance with instructions contained in referenced paragraphs 2 a and 1 b above.
- 3. The Keyaki departing Uraga on or about 15 October 1946 for Guam is designated to repatriate those persons authorized by reference 1 b above and by provisions of this memorandum to the Bonin Islands.
- 4. The Imperial Japanese Government will, in regard to those persons listed in reference 1 c above:
 - a. Notify them of this authorization to be repatriated.
- b. Insure their arrival at the Uraga Reception Center prior to 15 October 1946 and their outloading on shipping as designated herein.
