郵政事務年報

緒言

我國郵政，自開辦以迄本年度，已屆四十週年，在此擴充進展之過程中，多方規畫，健全機構，對於社會，多所服務，本年度內益加努力，以發揮其功能，而期於國計民生，有所裨益，茲將其重要事項，摘述如下：

(一) 改快邊區郵遞

我國幅員遼闊，東南各省，交通便利，郵政已有長足進展，西北各省，亦既利用各鐵路公路運輸郵件，惟西南各省，雖已就川、滇、黔、桂等處調查籌辦，增設局所，推廣郵路，其成效尚未大著，本年度開始後，乃自備汽車，先就重慶成都間往來行駛，運遞郵件，繼又就湖南貴州間開辦湘黔汽車專班，各省與川貴及由川貴轉遞各處之郵件，均因而加快到達，使邊區與腹地關係，益臻密切，以爲建設之助。

(二) 調整各處郵運 年來長江上游郵件，日益增多，惟川江水急灘險，郵運尙未甚暢，乃與各輪船公司重訂辦法，以資調整。此外無論國營或民營鐵路，亦分別洽商，改訂載運郵件辦法，其他各區各地郵運事項，均斟酌當地情形，逐漸改快，俾更便利。

(三) 促進內地商業

凡鐵路公路到達地方，其出產品物，可由火車汽車輪運，未通鐵路公路地方，則仍有賴於郵遞轉運，但因郵費昂貴，或因手續繁瑣，民衆未能儘量利用，乃按最近交

通情形及所付運費數目，改訂國內包裹郵費資例，並對於包裹之收寄、經轉、投遞手續，予以種種便利，使各地產物，如作為郵包交寄，得迅速轉運，不感受困難，則都市與內地之商務經濟，由郵政居間作介，得以互相調劑，直接可以促進商業，溝通金融，間接可以促進實業，增加出產。

(四) 鼓勵員工上進 郵局錄用員工，原係按照規定辦法招考，錄用之後，再行循資漸進，惟其中亦有於入局服務之後，仍努力研求學問，以企上進者，如能予以拔擢，使才智傑出之士，各展所長，各盡其力，於公務精善，既有相當裨益，且足以鼓勵員工，在公餘之暇，不致荒廢學業，益自奮勵，故又制定郵政人員甄拔試驗辦法，以資辦理。

此外如發行開辦四十週年紀念郵票及紀念郵票冊，建築各地郵局房屋，調整國際郵務，與夫可以便利民衆增加效率之事項，無不設計辦理，至本年度郵務經濟狀態，因種種努力之結果，較之上年度亦進步甚多。茲將本年度內郵政組織、業務、聯郵、財務、資產、設備、及員工各項詳情，分別敘述於後，並附圖表，以資參考。

第一章 組織

一 局所 本年度內，各地局所增加頗多，在繁盛地方，或添設郵局，或調整等級，鄉村地方，則多設代辦所與信櫃，以應需要。全年內一等郵局增加一處，二等郵局新開者二十五處，升降等級者三十一處，停辦者四處，三等郵局增加六十六處，郵亭增加二處，郵政代辦所增加一千五百八十四處。茲將截至二十六年六月底止，所有重要局所及次

甲 郵差郵路 截至本年度終，郵差幹路及支路，共爲四十三萬六千九百八十六公里，較上年度增加五萬零九百五十公里，蓋各區爲應公眾需要起見，將原有郵路，或加擴充，或予改組，其中以北平、湖北、廣東、安徽等區擴充最多。

乙 輪船及民船郵路 本年度水程郵路增加一千六百餘公里，以江蘇、廣東、浙江等區增加最多。

丙 鐵道郵路 本年度內，因粵漢路全線通車，增加三百三十九公里，山西郵區同蒲鐵路北段由原平展至陽明堡，陝西郵區隴海鐵路由西京展至張家崗，河南郵區道清鐵路由濬縣展至楚旺鎮，雲南郵區箇碧鐵路由新街展至石屏，共增加二百六十九公里，較之上年度共增六百零八公里。

丁 汽車郵路 截至本年度終，共長五萬四千四百六十九公里，除河北、山西、陝西、新疆四區並無增減外，其餘各區，均有增加，較上年度共增一萬一千零十五公里。

戊 航空郵路 本年度內中國航空公司之滬粵線在香港設站停落，歐亞航空公司之平粵線亦展至香港，西南航空公司除開辦由廣州經蒼梧(梧州)、桂林、柳州至邕寧(南寧)之廣邕線外，並將原有廣龍線展至河內，更名爲廣河線(西路)，復開辦由廣州經廣州灣、北海至河內線，名爲廣河線(南路)。截至本年度底，國內航空郵路已增至一萬八千公里，較上年度共增三千二百九十公里。

第二章 業務

一 函件統計 本年度內各類函件交寄總數，共八萬八千餘萬件，較上年

度增加五千七百萬件，約合百分之七。普通函件共計八萬三千餘萬件，約佔各類函件總數百分之九十四以上，平快函件增加之比率極大，約合百分之八十，但其總數仍不過五百萬件，掛號函件增加四百餘萬件，約增百分之十五，快遞掛號函件，自二十二年度起，迭見衰減，惟本年度內，因全國各地均可寄達，故交寄件數，突增至一千餘萬件。茲將收寄各類函件之統計數目，列表比較於後：

四 國際航空函件 我國寄往歐洲、非洲、亞洲南部、美洲、及澳大利亞之航空函件，分別利用河內至馬賽航空線(法國航空公司)、彭頓至阿姆斯特丹航空線(和蘭航空公司)、香港經檳榔嶼至倫敦航空線(英國皇家航空公司)、新嘉坡至澳大利亞航空線(坎塔斯航空公司)、及香港至舊金山航空線(汎美航空公司)寄遞。本年度內國內之滬粵航空線經停香港，平粵線展至香港，廣龍線展至河內，與國際航空線相連接，故往來國外

之航空函件，可全程由航空寄遞，例如：

(甲) 由滬粵或平港航空線運至香港，交由香港經檳榔嶼至倫敦航空線運至歐洲、非洲、及亞洲南部，或交由香港經檳榔嶼、新嘉坡至澳大利亞航空線運至澳大利亞，或交由香港至舊金山航空線運至斐律賓羣島、關島、夏威夷、南美及北美洲。

(乙) 由廣河航空線運至河內，再交河內至馬賽航空線運至歐洲、非洲、亞洲南部、及南美洲。

五 郵局送達訴訟文書 本年度開始時，與司法行政部訂定辦法，凡設有郵局地方，當地法院均得將訴訟文書交由郵局送達，全年度內經由郵局送達之訴訟文書，共有一萬五千餘件，以福建郵區為最多，江蘇、湖南、上海等區次之。

六 包裹 本年度包裹業務，異常發達，交寄件數，共達九百十餘萬件，較上年度增加二百餘萬件，約增百分之三十，重量自上年度之六千餘萬公斤增至九千餘萬公斤，約增百分之四十七。茲將過去四年度內收寄之普通、保價、與代收貨價包裹之件數、價值、重量各項數目，列表比較如左：

第六章 設備

一 概況 國內人工材料，價格低廉，是以有數種郵用物品，向係購用舶來品者，業已設計以上海自製之國貨代之，以節公帑。此項計畫已見諸實施者，計有各種權衡信件及笨重包裹之衡器，郵件自動蓋戳機及旋轉複印機等等，其價值均較進口貨為低。

公衆投寄郵件之信箱，經加改良，另製一種新式鐵質信箱，箱口等處構造，均經改善，俾投入之郵件，更為安全。此外又特製航空郵件專用信箱及信筒，裝設於收寄航空信件較多之各郵局或街道，民衆交寄，既多便利，郵局分揀手續，亦更簡捷。

郵用標準保險鐵櫃，原有甲乙丙三種，係視各郵局公款定額之多寡，分別核發應用。本年度內又添造裝有四輪脚之小號保險鐵櫃一種，定爲丁種標準鐵櫃，以備發給繁忙各局之售票員使用。

六運輸汽車汽船 本年度增購新汽車二百二十六輛，舊汽車作廢者二輛，截至本年度底止，各區共有汽車三百零四輛。共用汽油約十萬三千九百五十加侖，機器油約五千三百加侖，各車所行路程約一百三十七萬四千公里。郵局所有自置汽船之總數，與去年相同，仍爲十三艘，全年所行路程，約十三萬三千公里。

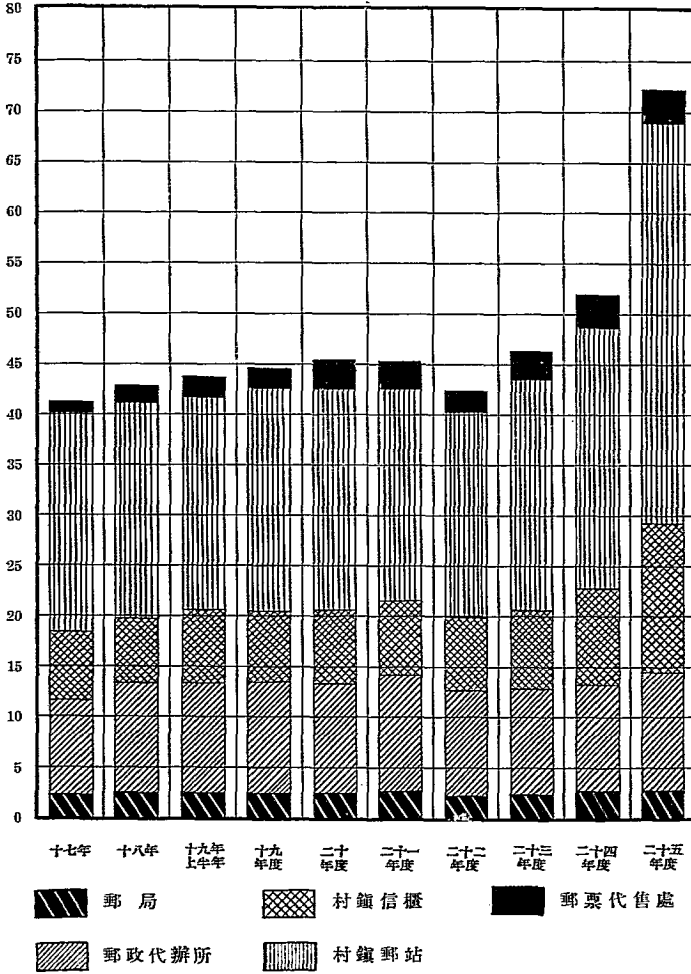

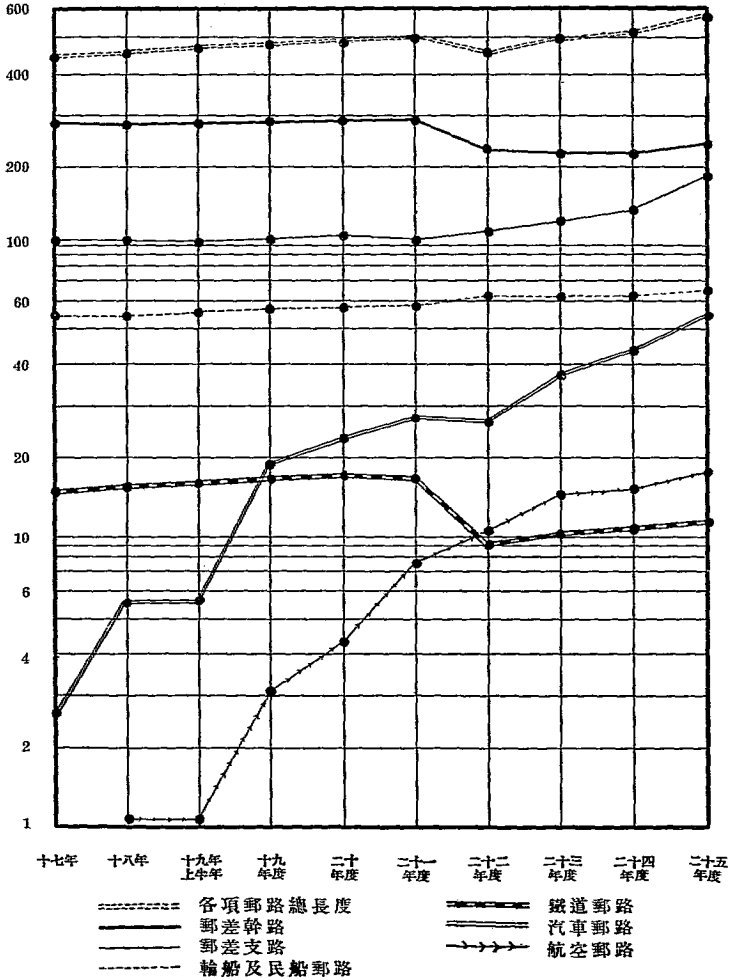

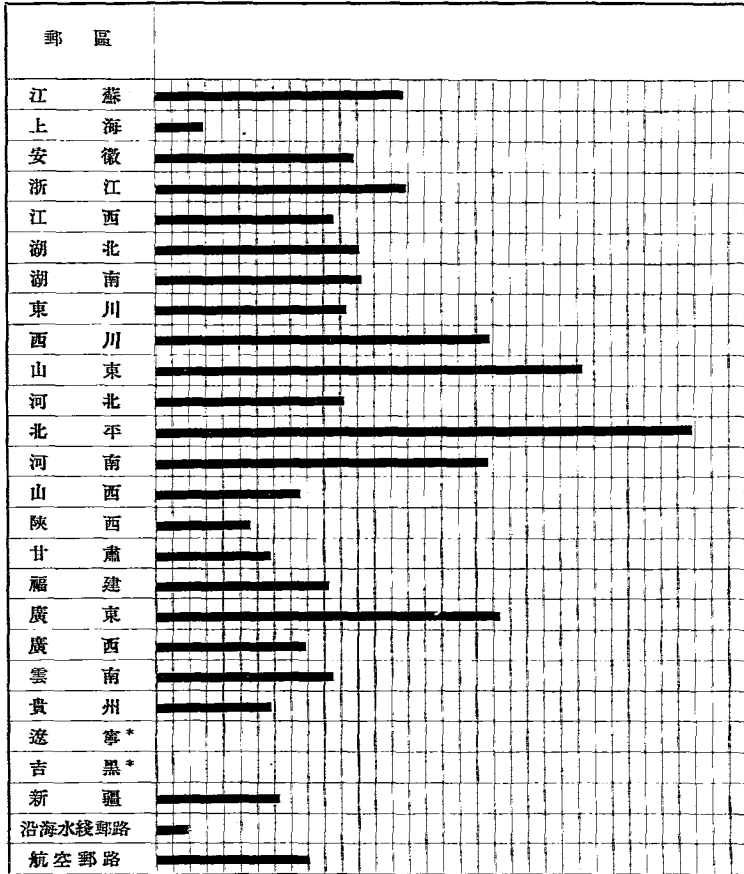

(截至中華民國二十六年六月底止)

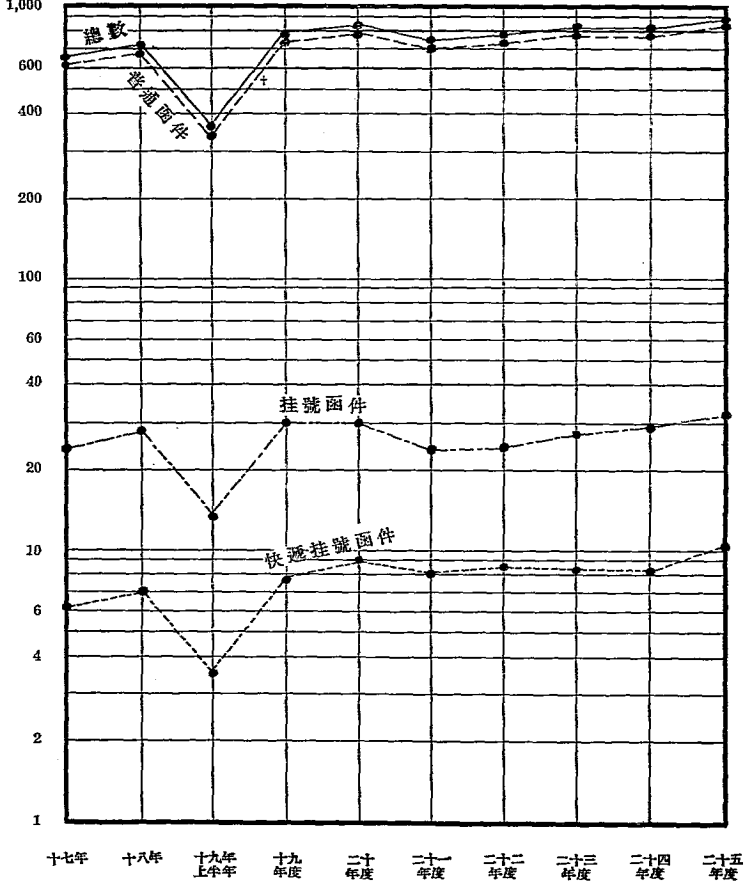

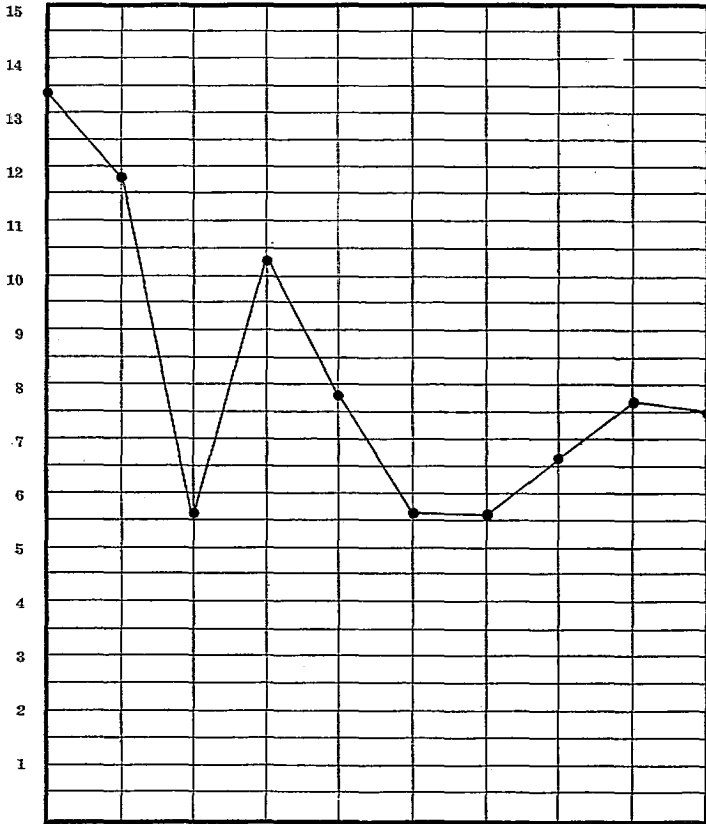

收寄保價信函及箱匣按年比較圖

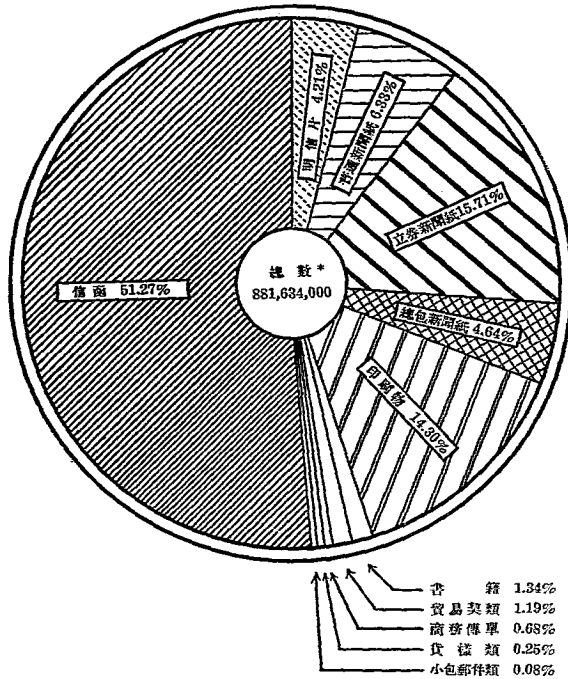

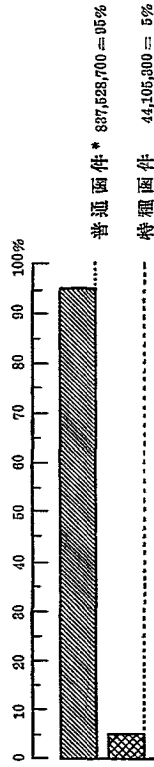

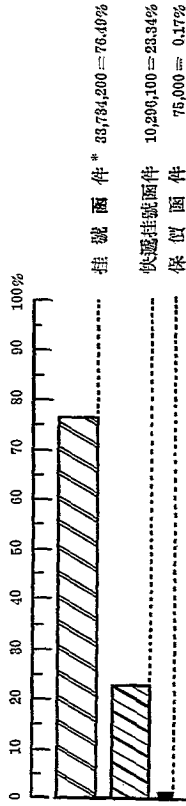

(中華民國二十五年七月至二十六年六月)



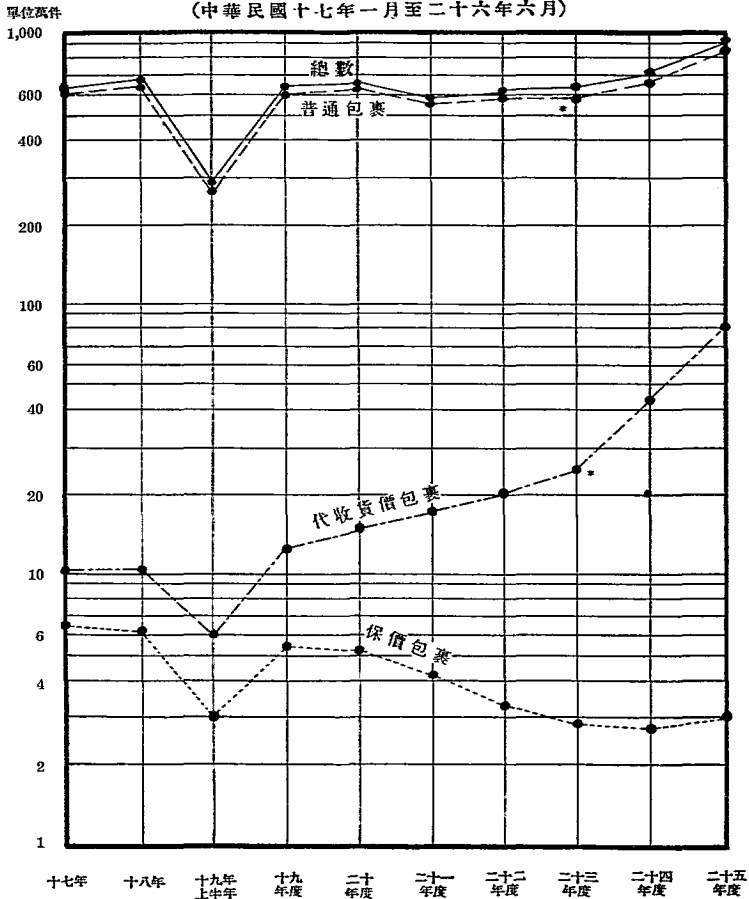

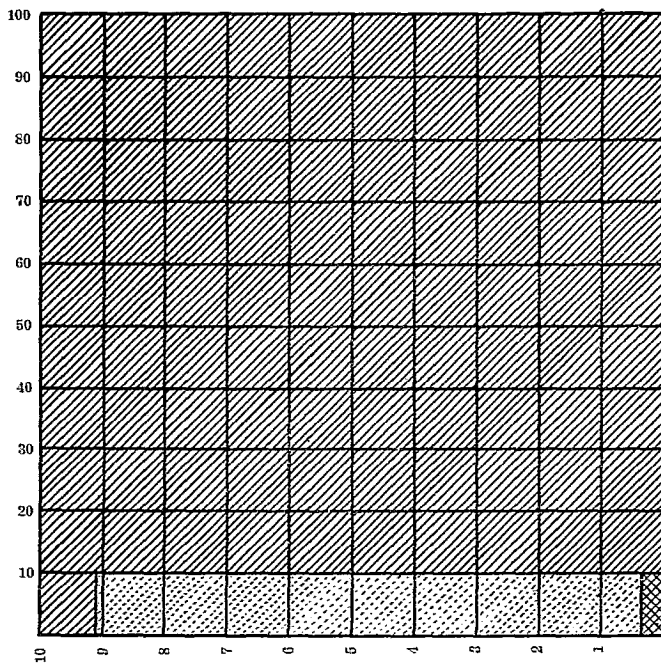

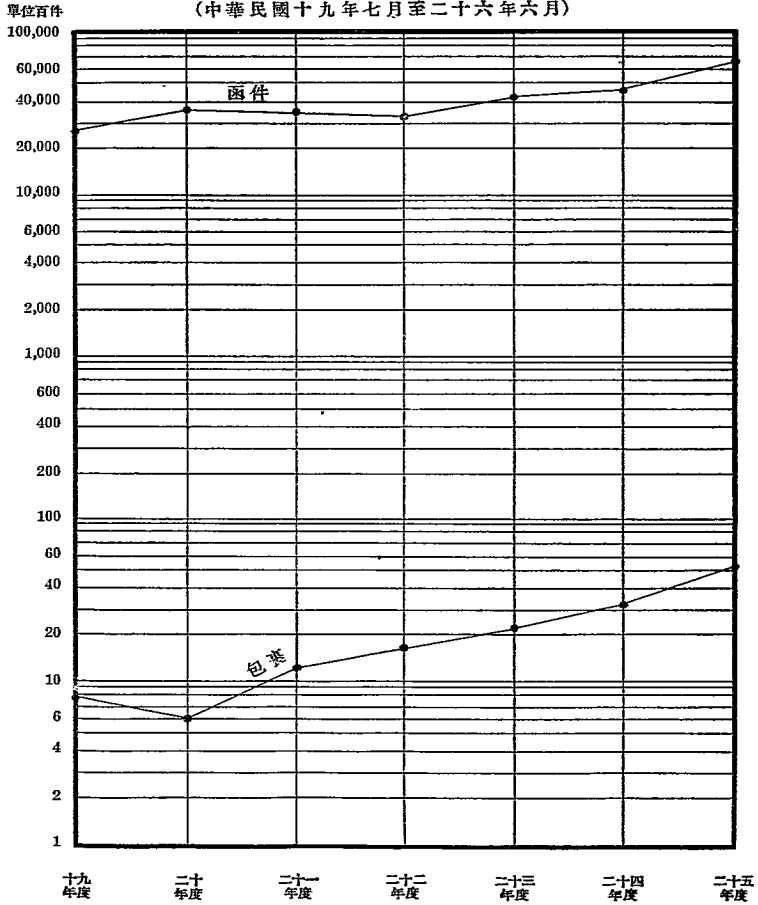

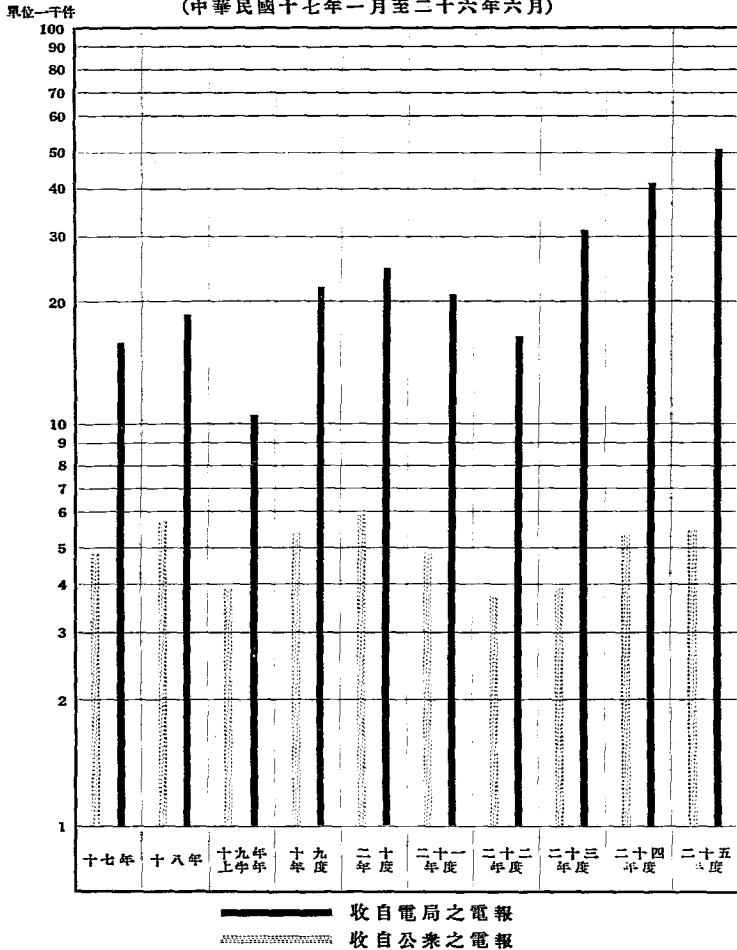
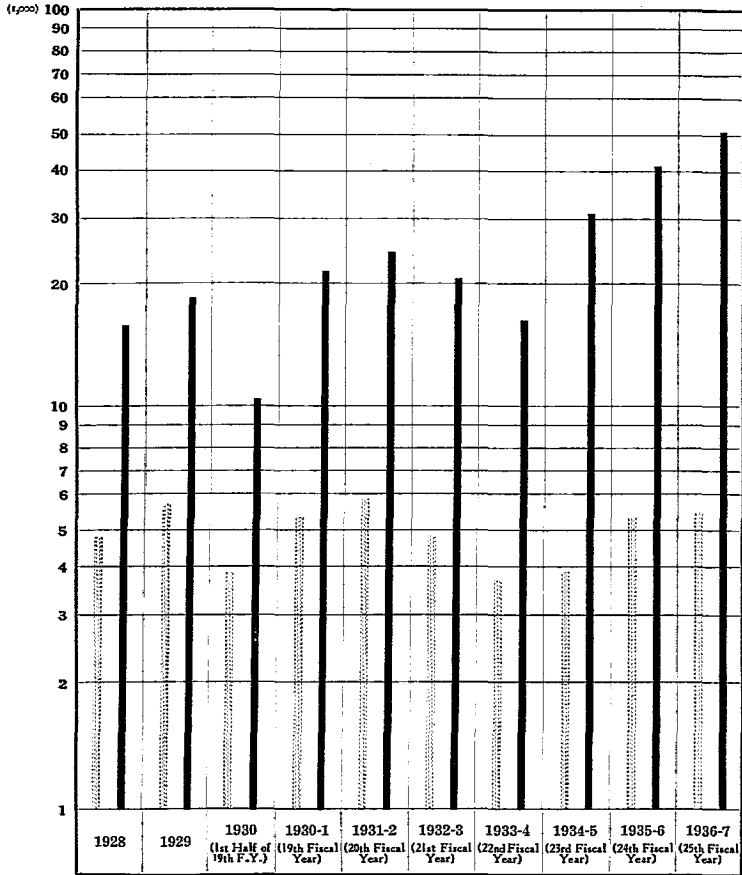

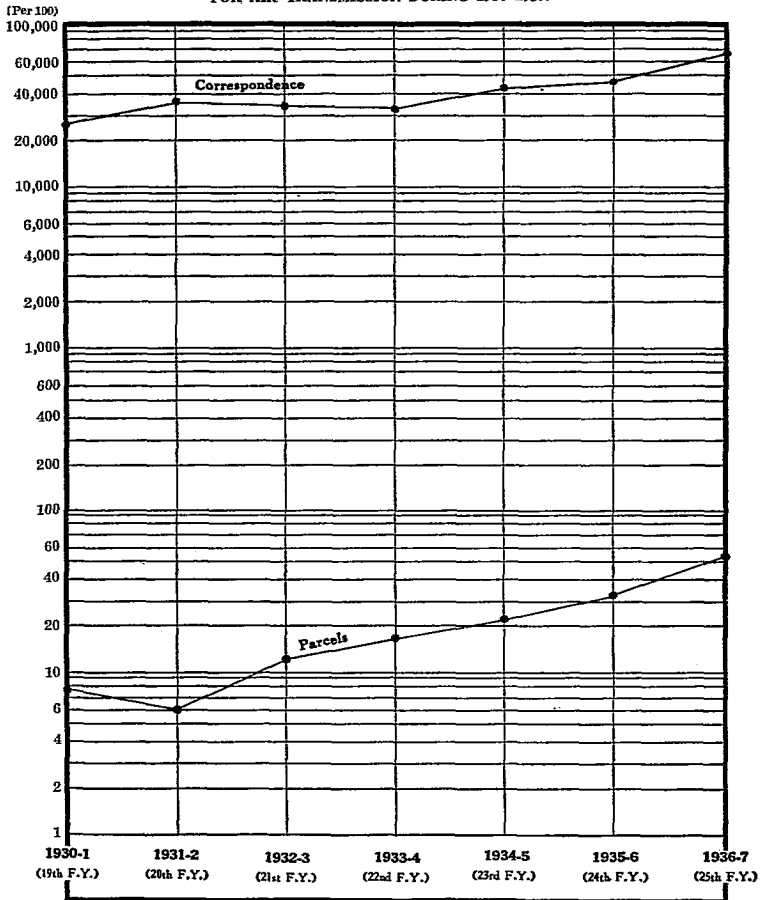

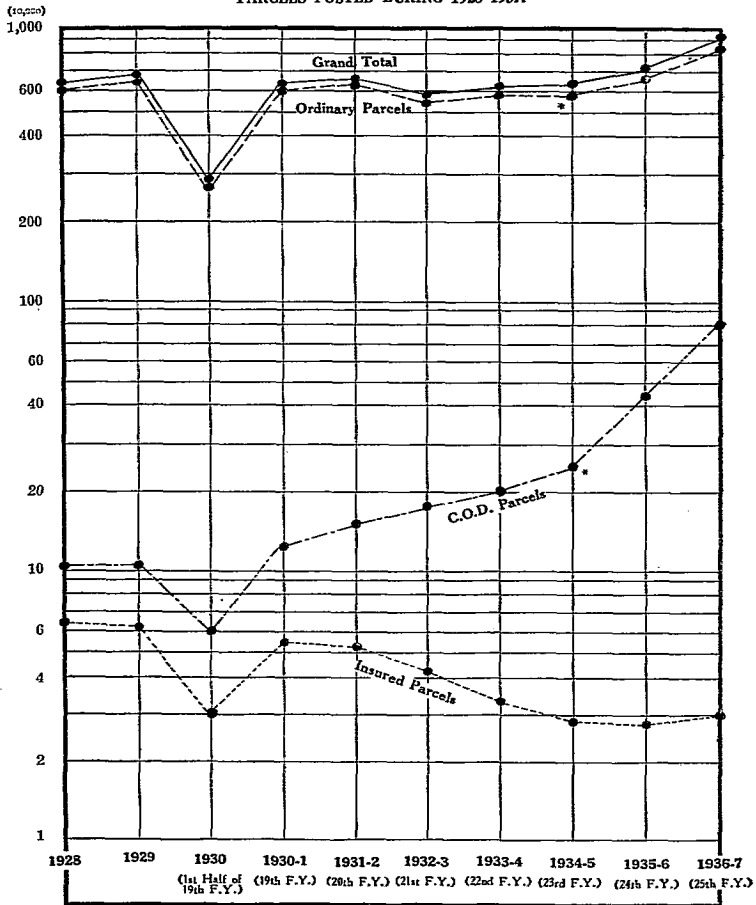
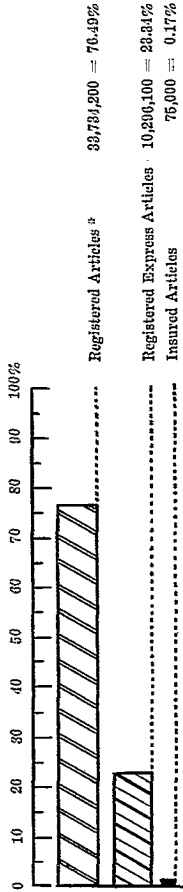
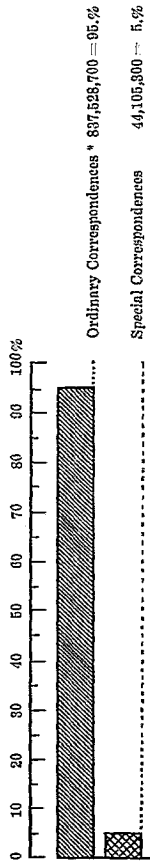

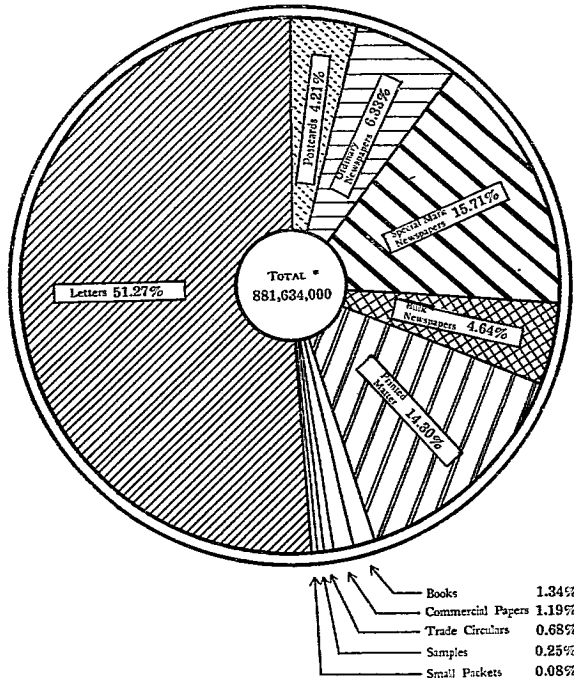

POSTED DURING 1928-1937.

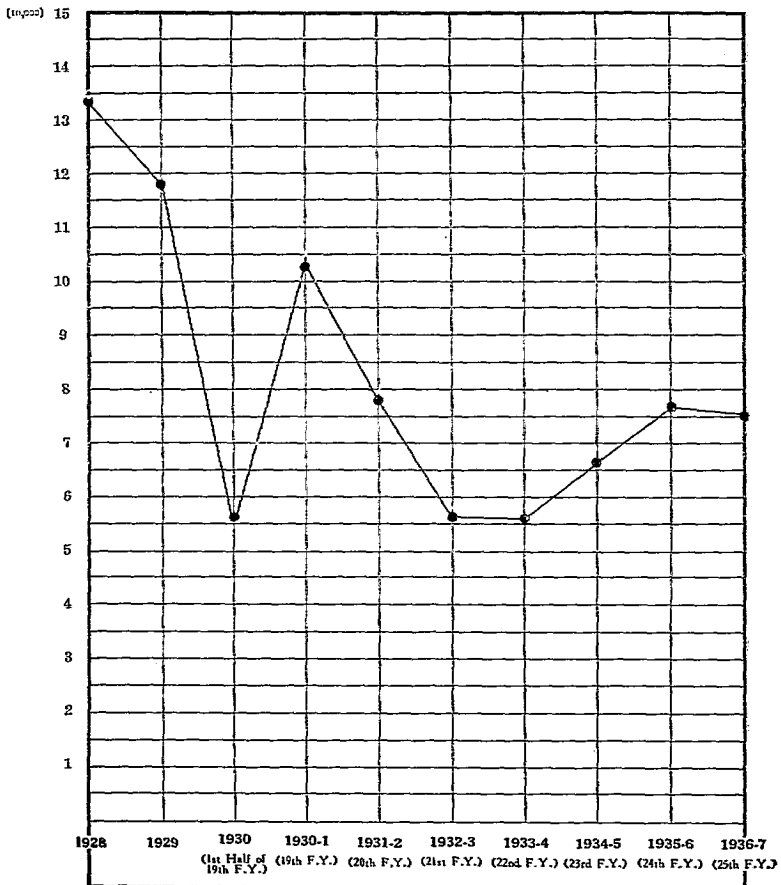
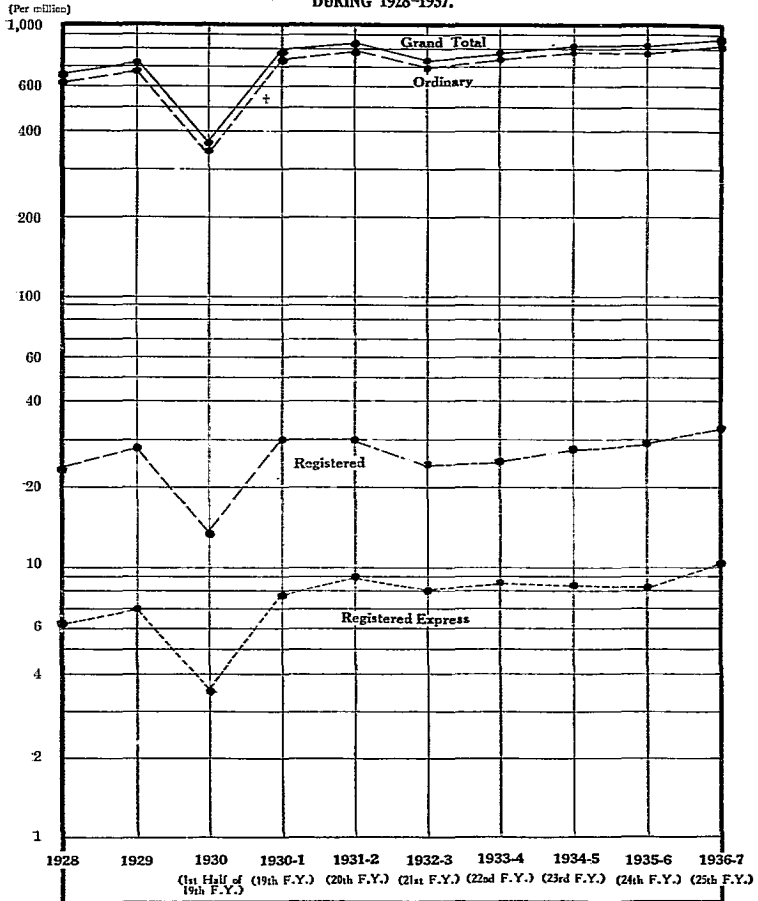
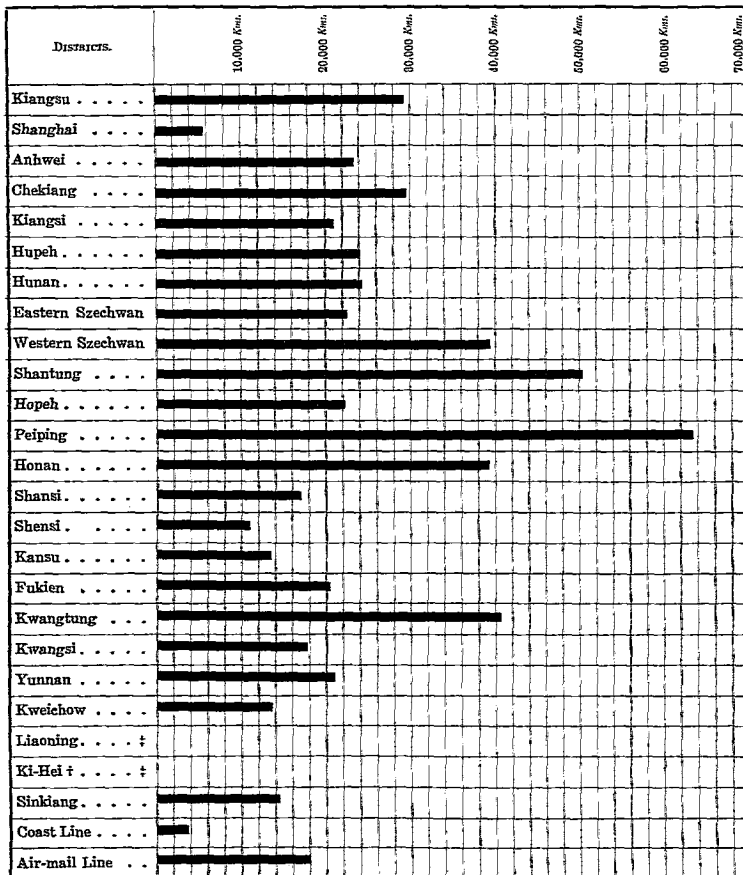


DIAGRAM No. 4 SHOWING THE NUMBER OF CORRESPONDENCES POSTED DURING 1928-1937.

(Per 1,000 kilometres.)

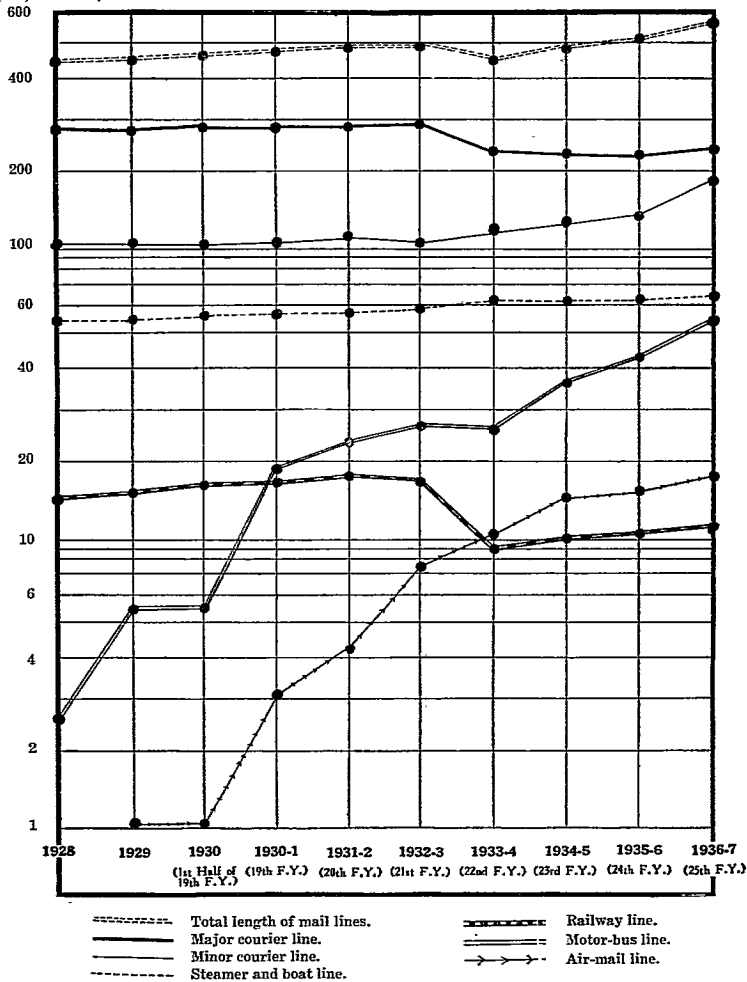
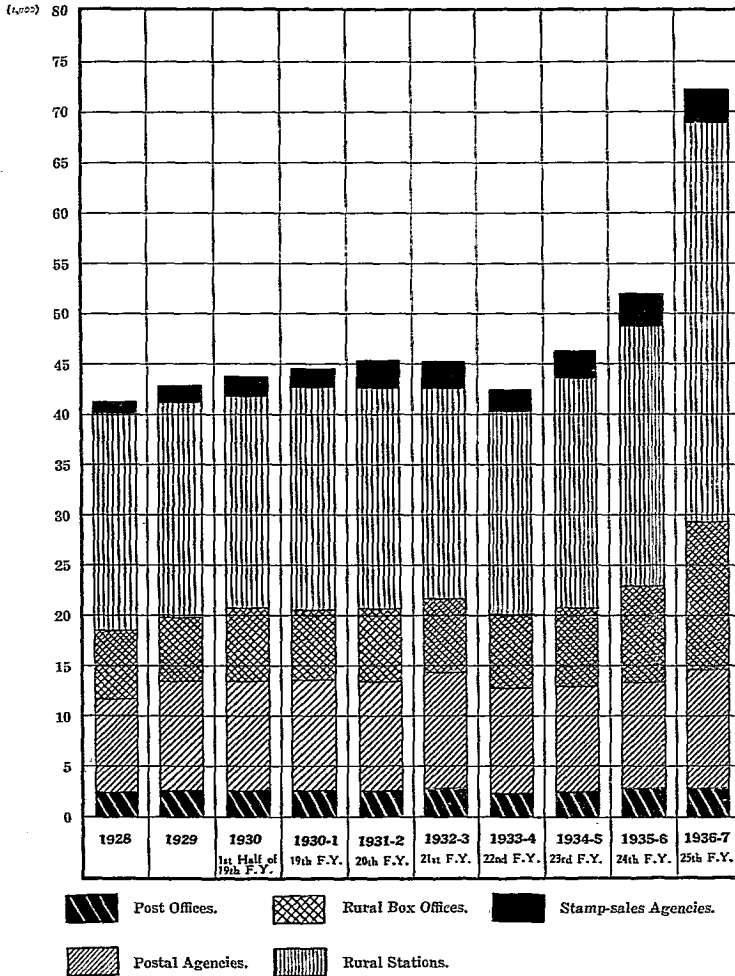

VII.—STAFF.

At the end of the fiscal year under review, the Postal staff consisted of 21 Commissioners (of whom 13 are foreigners), 43 Deputy Commissioners (including 13 foreigners), 4,982 Yu-wu-yüan (including 8 foreigners), 4,981 Yu-wu-tso, 8,096 Postmen (7,244 Ordinary and 852 Rural), 5,522 Couriers, 4,342 miscellaneous employéés (223 Laodahs, Sailors, etc., 1,350 T'ingch'ai, and 2,769 Coolies, etc.), and 12,448 Agents in various Districts.

Besides, there are 1 Chief Mi-shu, 4 Mi-shu, 1 Service Building Surveyor (foreigner), and 9 Copyists in the Directorate and 1 Mechanical Supervisor in the Peiping District Head Office.

The number of Yu-wu-yüan appointed during the year was 247, and the number of employéés of and above the rank of Yu-wu-yüan withdrawn from the Service was 105.

3.—*Bags*.—The contracts for the supply of various categories of canvas bags required for the year were awarded by tenders to Messrs. Wah Cheng Factory, Lee Hang Chong, and Aloud Spinning and Weaving Mill. The bags are all made of native canvas. The total number of bags issued during the year was 225,109.

4.—*Uniforms*.—The total number of uniforms of all kinds issued during the year was 11,622 suits, 1,173 blouses, 4,119 waistcoats, 158 overalls, and 1,568 overcoats. In addition to these, there were 2,002½ yards of white duck, 76,733½ yards of green jeans, 14,190½ yards of green heavy drill, 537½ yards of blue serge, and 232½ yards of cheviot issued to Districts for making uniforms, etc., themselves.

5.—*Printing*.—The total number of impressions of postcards, letter-cards, forms, and publications from the S.D. printing machines during the fiscal year was 6,549,600. The forms printed by outside firms were 177,050,446 in sheets and 4,193,741 in books.

6.—*Motor-truck and -launch Transport*.—226 new trucks were added to the fleet during the year. Only two trucks were discarded. The number of trucks in commission in the Service at the end of the fiscal year was 304. The total quantity of gasoline consumed was 103,950 gallons, and of lubricating oils about 5,300 gallons. The total distance covered by all vehicles was approximately 1,374,000 kilometres.

the expenditure on postal supplies. As a result, scales for weighing letters and cumbersome parcels, automatic cancelling machines, as well as rotary mimeographs, etc., can now be obtained in Shanghai at prices much lower than those of imported articles.

A new type of iron wall letter-box has been adopted in the Service and, through the improved making of the slit, the safety of the mails dropped into the box by the public is more secured. Special air-mail letter-boxes and pillar-boxes have been made and installed at Offices and locations where large quantities of air-mail articles are posted.

In addition to the three standard types of safes—Model A, B, and C—in the Service that are supplied to Offices according to the stocks of official funds and stamps kept, a small movable safe provided with four leg wheels has been standardised as model D, and is issued to stamp-sellers of busy Offices with large stocks of stamps.

Chekiang District.—The Ningsien First Class Office building is under construction.

Kiangsu District.—Work commenced for the extension of the Tungshan First Class Office building.

Anhui District.—The Wuhu First Class Office building is under construction.

2.—*Land.*—Land purchased by the Service or allotted to the Post Office by official institutions are as follows :—

Eastern Szechwan District.—The Yuyang Hsien Government allotted two plots of official land to Post Office in August, 1936, and the Yingshan, Sze., Hsien Government allotted an official site in February, 1937.

Western Szechwan District.—Official sites were procured at Chühsien in March, 1937, and at Mowhsien in June, 1937.

Hunan District.—Three plots of land were purchased: one at Hengyang in December, 1936; one at Changsha Motor-bus West Station in March, 1937; and one at Changteh Motor-bus South Station in May, 1937.

Kwangtung District.—The land adjoining the Canton Head Office building was purchased in February, 1937, and another site at Tungshanshu, Canton, purchased in January, 1937.

Hupeh District.—A site with buildings consisting of office rooms and four-storey godowns adjoining the Hankow Head Office building was purchased in March, 1937. An official site was allotted to the Post Office by the Anlu Hsien Government in January, 1937.

Yunnan District.—The Yüankiang Hsien Government and local officials allotted to Post Office a site with a building in January, 1937. The Mohei Chamber of Commerce allotted an official site in May, 1937. An official site with building was procured at Mitu in June, 1937.

Shensi District.—Official sites were procured at Shunhwa, Ichwan, and Sünyi, She, in June, 1937.

Anhui District.—The land and building adjoining the Hwaining Head Office was purchased in April, 1937.

7.—*Telegrams partially transmitted by Post.*—Increases are recorded in the number of telegrams accepted direct from the public as well as in the number of those received from Telegraph Offices for onward transmission and/or delivery. The figures for the last four fiscal years are given below:—

8.—*Post Office handling Telegraph and Telephone Business.*—An arrangement has been concluded between the Telegraph and Postal Administrations, whereby all Telegraph Offices with small business may ask the local Post Office to handle the Telegraph and Telephone business on their behalf. The work is either entrusted to the Postal staff or attended to by Telegraph employes detached to the Post Office. This arrangement has been put into operation since June, 1937, and there were, at that time, more than 530 Post Offices handling Telegraph and Telephone business concurrently.

9.—*Sale of Revenue Stamps.*—A total of more than 382 million revenue stamps valued at \$8,520,964.84 was sold by Postal establishments throughout the country. Shanghai, Kwangtung, Kiangsu, etc., are among the Districts having the largest sales.

III.—UNION.

1.—*Relations with Foreign Administrations.*—During the fiscal year under review, our relations with various foreign Postal Administrations continued to be friendly and cordial.

2.—*Postal Agreements.*—An agreement for the exchange of postal parcels between the Postal Administration of China and of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics was concluded, with effect from the 15th February 1937 in the U.S.S.R. and from the 1st March 1937 in China.

4.—*International Air-mails.*—Air-mails from China for countries in Europe, Africa, South Asia, America, and Australia are forwarded by different air lines, such as Hanoi-Marseilles line of the Air France, Bandoeng-Amsterdam line of K.L.M., Hongkong-Penang-London line of the Imperial Airways, Singapore-Australia line of the Qantas Airways, and Hongkong-San Francisco line of the Pan American Airways. Since the extension of certain domestic air-mail lines to Hongkong and Hanoi during the fiscal year, viz.: Shanghai-Canton line passes Hongkong, Peiping-Canton line extends to Hongkong, and Canton-Lungchow line extends to Hanoi, air-mails to and from abroad may now be forwarded by air all the way per the following air-mail services :—

- (i.) Per Shanghai-Hongkong-Canton or Peiping-Canton-Hongkong air lines to Hongkong, and thence (a) per Hongkong-Penang-London air line to Europe, Africa, and Southern Asia, or (b) per Hongkong-Penang-Singapore-Australia air lines to Australia, or (c) per Hongkong-San Francisco air line to *Philippine Islands, Guam, Hawaii, or North and South America.*
- (ii.) Per Canton-Hanoi air line to Hanoi, and thence per Hanoi-Marseilles air line to Europe, Africa, South Asia, and South America.

5.—*Delivery of Judicial Writs by Post Office.*—At the beginning of the fiscal year, a procedure for the delivery of judicial writs by the Post Office was introduced. It provides that all judicial institutions may entrust lawsuit documents to the Post Office for delivery. Throughout the fiscal year under review, more than 15,000 judicial writs were delivered by the Post Office. In the order of number of articles handled, Fukien District stood first and Kiangsu, Hunan, and Shanghai second, third, and fourth, respectively.

6.—*Parcels.*—The parcel trade continued to make progress. A total of 9.1 million parcels was posted, showing an advance of 2 million parcels, or 30%. The weight of parcels rose from 60 million kilos for the previous year to 90 million kilos, representing an increase of 47%. The following table shows the number of ordinary, insured, and C.O.D. parcels dealt with during the last four years, as well as their weight and value.

Canton-Lungchow line has been extended to Hanoi and is called Canton-Hanoi line (west route). In addition, the Corporation operates a new line between the same termini (Canton-Hanoi line, south route) but routing *via* Kwangchowwan and Pakhoi.

II.—BUSINESS.

1.—Statistics.—The total of correspondence posted by the public was more than 880 million articles, showing an increase of 57 million articles, or 7%, over the figures for the previous fiscal year. Of the total, 94% were ordinary correspondence, amounting to 830 million articles. There were about 5 million articles of “ordinary express,” showing an increase of 80% as compared with the previous year’s figures. Registered articles showed an increase of 4 million articles, or approximately 15%. Registered express articles rose to 10 millions; the increase is attributed to the extension of this service to all parts of the country. 2.—Town Post System.—The total number of correspondence posted for local delivery amounted to over 80 million articles. Shanghai contributed more than 40 million articles, or about 50% of the total. Comparative figures for the last four years are given below:—

3.—Domestic Air-mails.—The number of all categories of air-mail articles rose from 4.67 millions for the preceding year to 6.56 millions for the period under review. “*Par Avion*” letters and postcards amounted to 6.36 millions, newspapers over 90,000, and other articles over 100,000. (a) *Courier Lines.*—The total length of major and minor courier lines at the end of the fiscal year was 436,986 kilometres, showing an increase of 50,950 kilometres. This is due to the reorganisation and extensions made to the existing lines in order to cope with the increased public requirements. The Districts of Peiping, Hupeh, Kwangtung, and Anhwei made the largest extensions.

(b) *Steamer and Boat Lines.*—These lines showed an increase of 1,600 kilometres, mostly contributed by the Kiangsu, Kwangtung, and Chekiang Districts.

(c) *Railway Lines.*—Railway lines over which mails are carried were lengthened by 608 kilometres made up as follows:—

Inauguration of through traffic service on the Canton-
Hankow Railway 339 kilometres.
Extensions made on the Tung-pu, Lung-hai, Tao-ching,
and Ku-pi Railways 269 kilometres.

(d) *Motor-bus Lines.*—The total length of these lines at the end of the fiscal year was 54,469 kilometres, showing an increase of 11,015 kilometres as compared with the previous year. Except Hopeh, Shansi, Shensi, and Sinkiang Districts where no change took place, all other Districts contributed more or less to the increase.

(e) *Air-mail Lines.*—The domestic air-mail lines were increased by 3,290 kilometres, now registering a total length of 18,000 kilometres. The changes taking place during the fiscal year are as follows:—

C.N.A.C.: The Shanghai-Canton line made a stop at Hongkong.
Eurasia: The Peiping-Canton line extended to Hongkong.
S.W.A.C.: A new Canton-Yunling (Nanning) line was inaugurated with Tsangwu (Wuchow), Kweilin, Liuchow as ports of call. The

I.—ORGANISATION.

1.—Establishments.—The number of Postal establishments has been considerably increased during the fiscal year under review: in cities and towns new Post Offices were opened or office status adjusted, and in rural districts additional Agencies or Box Offices were installed. The number of First Class Offices was augmented by one. 25 Second Class Offices were opened and 4 closed, while 31 changed their status. Third Class Offices were increased by 66; Kiosks, 2; and Agencies, 1,584. The total number of major and minor establishments functioning at the end of June, 1937, is shown in the following comparative tables:—

* Since February, 1937, Town Box Offices have been replaced by Agencies or Stamp-sales Agencies. This conversion started in the previous fiscal year and was carried out gradually.

2.—Mail Lines.—All mail lines have shown increases as illustrated in the following comparative table:—

- (3.) *Promotion of Inland Trade.*—While the products of places along railways or highways may be transported to other regions by trains and busses, those produced at non-steam-served places have mainly to rely on the parcel post for transmission. In order that it may be fully utilised, a thorough survey of the parcel post system was made in the light of the present modes of transport, as well as the freight the Post Office has to defray, resulting in a pertinent revision of the rates of parcel postage and the simplification of the posting formalities. Our motto is: whatever is sent by parcel post must be transmitted and delivered with all possible expedition, and under no circumstances should the public be inconvenienced. In this way, the Post Office may bring about the much needed commercial and financial intercourse between the urban and rural districts, thereby contributing to the promotion of commerce and industry with resultant improvements in the Nation's financial structure, as well as an increase in our native products.
- (4.) *Advancement of Specially Qualified Postal Employés.*—All classes of Postal employés are, as a rule, appointed to the Service through competitive examination, and, after their appointment, they are given promotions according to the scale of advancement for their respective classes. Cases are, however, not lacking, where Postal employés, after joining the Service, still keep up, or further, their studies in the hope of advancement into the higher classes. A set of regulations, governing the "Advancement Tests for Postal Employés," has, therefore, been promulgated, whereby employés who have distinguished themselves by conspicuous ability and intelligence may advance into the higher ranks. Thus not only may talented employés be enabled to make profitable use of their special qualifications, thereby promoting the efficiency of the Service, but other members of the staff may also be encouraged to utilise their leisure hours for pursuing studies.

Other events that are worthy of mention include the issue of a set of special stamps and stamp-booklets in commemoration of the Fortieth Anniversary of the foundation of the Postal Service, construction of Post Office buildings in different parts of the country, and improvement of mail services with foreign countries. In short, whatever is conducive to the giving of greater facilities to the public as well as to the promotion of Service efficiency has always been carefully planned and duly executed.

As regards Service finances, great improvement was also recorded in the year, thanks to the strenuous efforts that have been made in the various directions.

Detailed particulars showing I. Organisation, II. Business, III. Union, IV. Finance, V. Properties, VI. Equipment, and VII. Staff are given below. Statistical tables and diagrams are also appended for reference.

REPORT ON THE POST OFFICE

For the Twenty-fifth Fiscal Year, C.H.M.K.

(1st July 1936 - 30th June 1937.)

GENERAL.

THE fiscal year under review witnessed the Fortieth Anniversary of the formal creation of the National Post. During the preceding four decades, strenuous efforts had been made to strengthen the postal machinery and improve its operations in such a way as to afford greater facilities to the general public. Such efforts were continued, and even redoubled, in the year covered by this Report, resulting in a further extension of all postal activities in the interests of both the country and people. The following is a *résumé* of the more important work done during the year:—

- (1.) *Acceleration of Postal Communications in the Frontier Provinces.*—While, in the past, no efforts have been spared in extending postal activities in the South-western provinces of Szechwan, Yunnan, Kweichow, and Kwangsi, the postal progress in those parts of the country is, nevertheless, not so remarkable as in the South-east, where modern communication facilities have enabled the postal enterprise to advance with big strides. Nor is it comparable to the achievements made in the North-west, where railways and highways have also been utilised for the carriage of mails. Remedial measures were therefore taken early in the year, and motor-truck services run by newly purchased trucks were inaugurated between Chungking and Chengtu and, then again, between places in Hunan and Kweichow. Not only has the transmission of mails to, from, and *via* Szechwan and Kweichow been thus much accelerated, but relations between the frontier and other provinces have also been made much closer, thereby contributing greatly to the progress of reconstruction work in China.
- (2.) *Betterment of Transport Facilities for Carriage of Mails.*—In view of the continued increase in the volume of mails on the Upper Yangtze, and the difficulties of transportation encountered owing to rapids and other handicaps, new and better arrangements were made with the various shipping companies so as to improve matters. The procedures governing the conveyance of mails by all Government and private railways in Districts were improved, whilst all other mail connexions were accelerated according to local conditions, thus affording greater convenience to the public.
