## INTRODUCTION.

---

In the historical address given on the occasion of the 250th anniversary of the settlement of Dedham, Mr. Worthington said: "The exact number of men raised for the service (Revolutionary) has never been stated but the published list—Haven's Centennial Address—must fall short of the real number."

Previous to the publication of the *Massachusetts Soldiers and Sailors of the Revolution*, such a list could not have been made. Miss Martha C. Crane interested herself in this matter and has compiled from the published volumes the names of the soldiers credited to Dedham. To Miss Crane's list have been added the names of the soldiers found in the records of the several parishes of the town; also the names of those not otherwise recorded who were paid for services by the town of Dedham from 1775 to 1783.

This list gives the names of six hundred and seventy-eight soldiers. A census of the town taken by Samuel Dexter in 1765 gave Dedham a population of 1,919, and at the close of the Revolutionary War the number of inhabitants was not much greater.
