

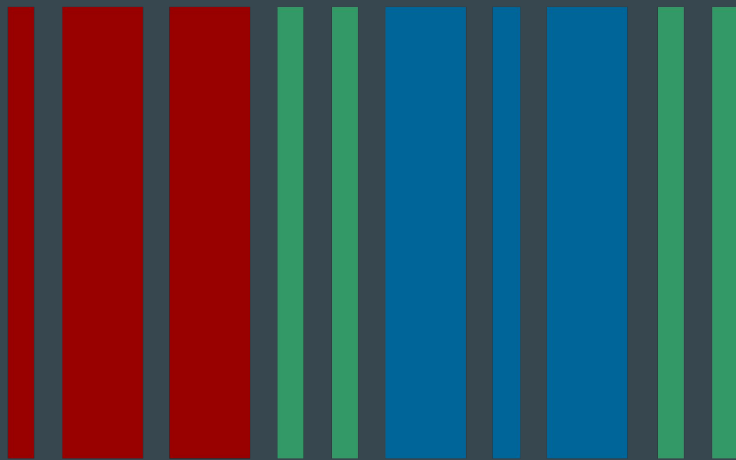

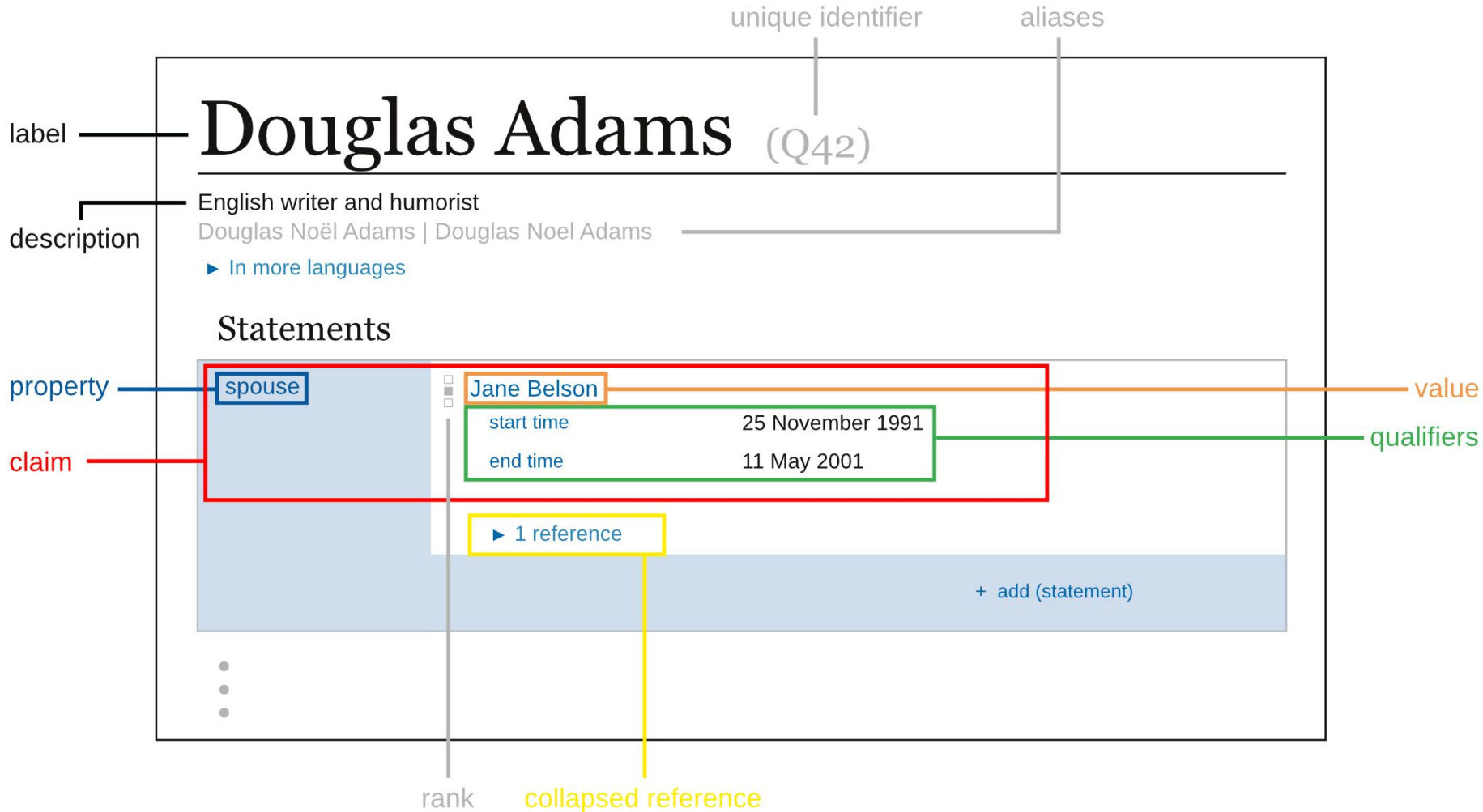

Usage Statistic of Content Languages for Websites



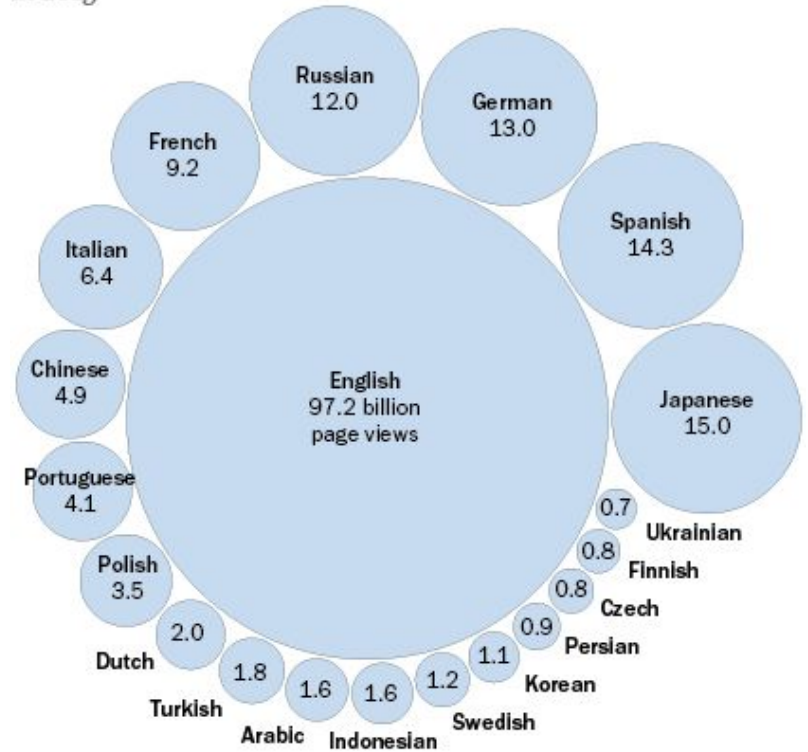

Leading language versions of Wikipedia, by billions of page views in 2015



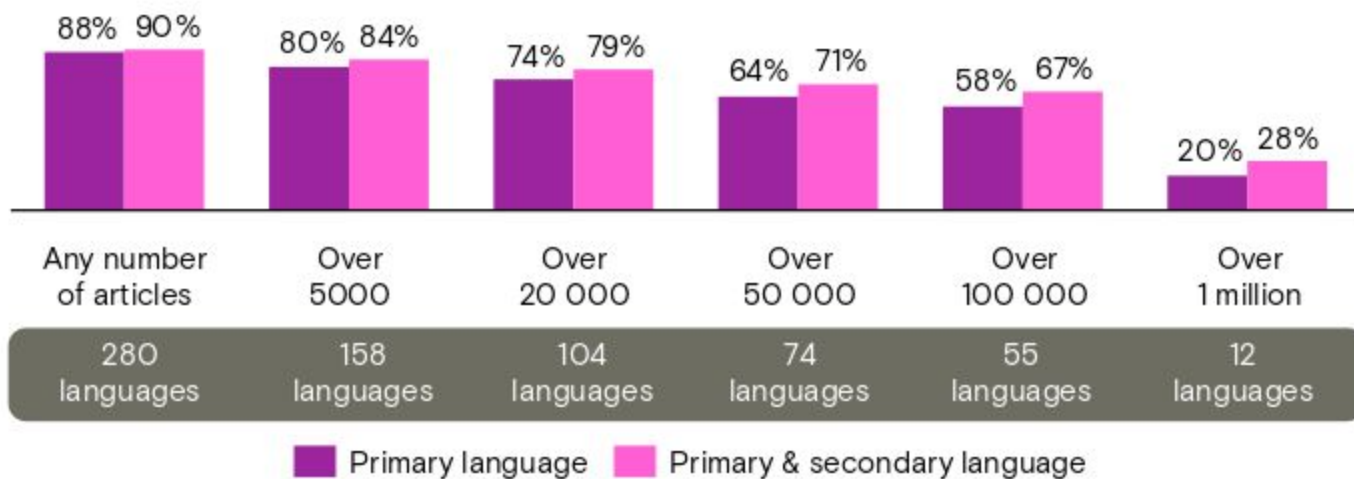

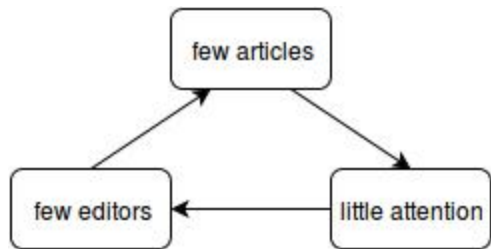

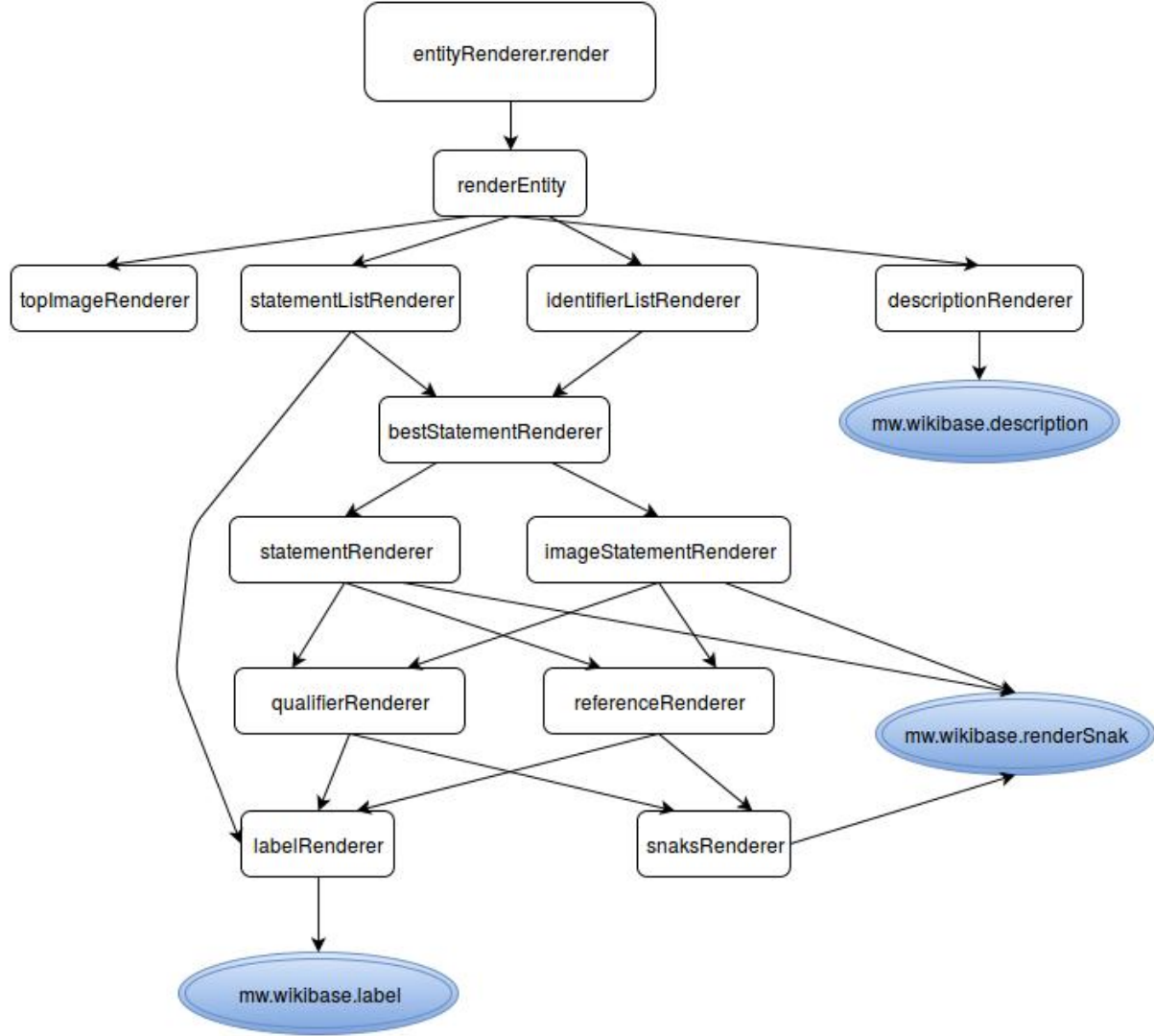
