

4) Necessity for movement and use of machinery and equipments.

A) Our company was established in March, 1945, with a purpose of manufacturing of munitions, however, as a result the war was over while its preparation, in September 1945, we started, instead, to manufacture agricultural implements and wooden machine tools for the Osaka Kiko Company.

In December 1946, we have again turned to the spinning machine makers. Further in December 1948, with the total number of 60 machines and equipments which were purchased from the Osaka Kiko Company and with employees of 120, our company was reorganized under the title of OTORI KIKO CO., LTD. and manufactured Spinning Machinery, as the Sub-Contractors for OSAKA KIKO COMPANY.

For the productive capacity, Six (6) or Nine (9) of Blawing Machinery being manufactured monthly, As far as Blawing Machinery concerns, from President down to the members of the company have extremely sufficient knowledge through which the company in desire to contribute to the rehabilitation of the Spinning Industry which is one of the greatest export programs.

The operating plant exist only in Tottori at present, but, expansion by means of the new plant in Osaka, to meet the increasing demand is now being planned.

B) In Osaka Plant, following to the ban for limitation on spindle numbers has been released and the demand, accordingly, have remarkably increased, the company have projected to borrow a part of TOYOSAKI PLANT (None Reparation Plant) of OSAKA KIKO COMPANY wherein the machine tools and equipments which are now herein under application, combined with some others to be installed to manufacture the Opening and Beating Machines.

C) Expected workers in our Osaka Plant will be Forty (40), the Production and of which quantity will be, 15 Beating Machines, and 15 Opening Machines (Including of it's Main plant) and the necessary equipments are as listed under the separate sheet.



5. Additional reparation items needed for the above production:

Addition to the above items, Thirty(30) Machine Tools, and Two(2) Transformers, totaling of Thirty Two(32), now idle in the munition department are desired to be used. The detail description is follows in the separate sheet.

6. Necessity for Conversion:

A). This company has been established in 1915, chiefly with the manufacturing object of spinning machinery which production capacity has gradually enlarged to cover the entire lines of spinning works as, cotton, woolen, hems, silk, rayon and the staple fibers in the years around 1935 or 1936.

At present Four(4) plants are in possession, one in Inagawa, Itami City, Hyogo Prefecture, and three others in Osaka Prefecture.

Since around 1937, along with the machine tools manufacturing have been commenced, the company have ordered to make the war implements and the spinning machinery programs accordingly begun to retrenched gradually, whereby the war was over, leaving a part of spinning machinery manufacturing work in continuation.

B) INAGAWA PLANT was established in 1939 which being our main factory. During the manufacture of machine tools as well as arms, the war was over in 1940.

As a result of an authorized use of the plant was granted by the 94th Military Government, Osaka, on 20th, May 1945. the company has commenced to manufactured the above item four(4)

On 27 August 1946, the Machine Tools Department as well as the Privately owned Arms Manufacturing Department were formally designated as reparation plant. However, at present, of all the 814 designated machines in the Machine tools Dept. are releast to use and 71 Reparation Machines in the Munition Dept. also formally authorized to use, under the four defferent applications. With utility of these equipments combined with the Fifteen Hundred (1,500) workers, spinning machinery are produced, at present, to the capacity of Ten Thousand (10,000) spindled, thus it become one of largest spinning machinery makers in Japan.

In addition to the principal program repairing of the spinning machines or also electric motors and machine tools are manufactured.

C) Owing to the ban, limiting the spindle numbers, have been lifted, the demand of the spinning machines have remarkable increased as listed below and to meet this, the company planned to increase the number of the spindles to THIRTY THOUSAND (30,000) spindles.

The spinning Industry being the most important among other industries and of which contribution, will, together with the export programs, be of the great importance and which rehabilitation is considered to be a pressing program.

We are desirous of contribution to this objective, facilitating our long gained technical experiences as well as the excellent facilities of the Inagawa factory. Besides spinning machinery, other products are also making as before.

D) In order to achieve the above programs, a good many machines now lying idle in the Munition Department are desirous to facilitate.

a) ONE(1) BORING MACHINE and FIVE(5) DRILLING MACHINES.

The Cylinder Bend should, at present, have to be conveyed into other part of section, just due to lack of exclusive machines for this purpose and caused the time as well as hands wasted unnecessarily. By using of above machines for surfacing or drilling for belt bolt holes, these wasteful labors will have to be disappeared.

b) TWELVE (12) MILLING MACHINE

The Milling Machines of 104 in number are now in use but still repaired more machines be increased to attain the capable works.

c) NINE (9) LATHES.

Among all of Two Hundred and Eighty Five (285) Lathes now using, the capable and the same type as above listed with all gear driving device lathe are only Seventy One (71). These 9 Lathes are to be used in connection with other machines which now underaplication and without these, the objects that to be produced must be conveyed into other part of sections, creating unreasonable wasted hands.

d) THREE (3) PLANERS.

The Planers now use are Twenty Eight (28) in all. Along to the demand have been increased, the capacity is felt remarkably shortage especially the difficulties are felt in works of the long pieces.

d) THREE (3) PLANERS (cont'd).

The two(2) machines out of the Three (3) machines now under application for permission, are of the third grade. however, we are desirous of repair them to use.

e) Two (2) TRANSFORMERS.

The Foundry have been limited to use for half accomodation heretofore, but in order to make whole function be available, electric current powers become very shortage respectively, for cranes, fans and electric lights. Thereby we are requested to increase 200 K.V.A. to meet satisfactory works.

B. Maximum production currently authorized is Textile Machines - 120,000 spindles. Repairing of Textile Machines 120,000 spindles. Electric Motors (3-10 HP) 3,600 sets. Machine Tools 300 sets. Lathes 120 sets. Milling Machines 120 sets. Honing Machines 60 sets. (Yearly)

2. The acquisition of material . parts and sub-assemblies as well as the disposition of finished products, and the establishment of sales prices will be in accord with the regulations of the Imperial Japanese Government.

3. Until otherwise directed by this headquarters. a monthly report in English of each item. by name. type and quantity produced by each factory. sub-contractor subsidiary within this factory's control will be delivered to this office by the fifteenth (15) day of the following month.

4. It is understood that this permit for reconversion is issued subject to any and all directives affecting reconversion. ultimate disposition or otherwise. which have been issued or may hereafter be issued by the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers or by this headquarters.

By order of Lieutenant Colonel ATWOOD:

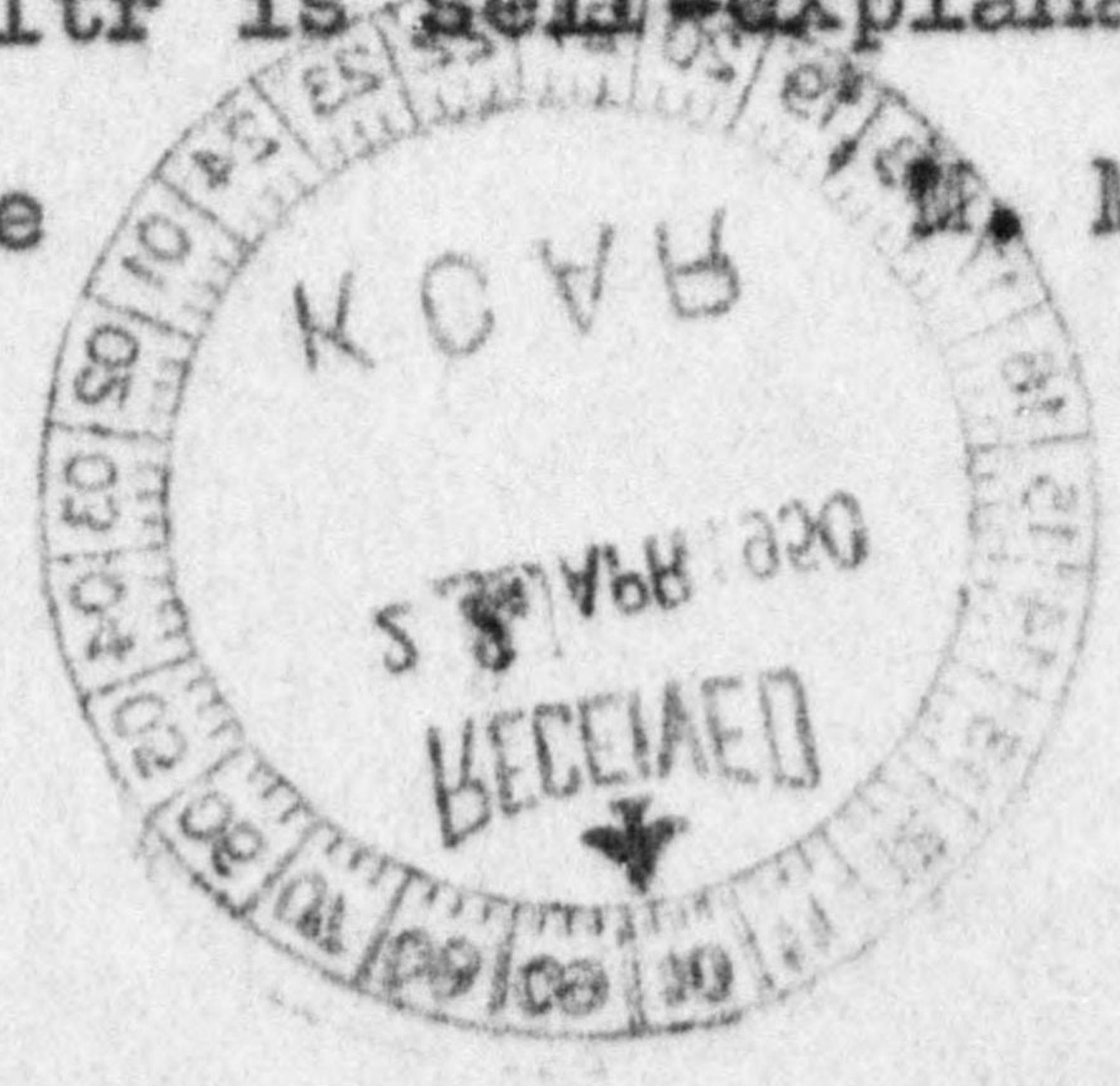
