MEMORANDUM FOR: JAPANESE GOVERNMENT

SUBJECT: Alternate Routing of Japan-China Radiotelegraph Traffic

1. Reference is made to Memoranda for the Japanese Government as follows:

a. File AG 312.4 (16 Feb 46) CCS, SCAPIN 742, dated 16 February 1946, subject: Handling of Chinese Government Radiograms Between Tokyo and China via San Francisco, California.


b. File AG 311.23 (13 Sep 47) CCS, SCAPIN 1777, dated 13 September 1947, subject: Radiotelegraph Service to China, Korea and Okinawa, as amended.

2. SCAPIN 742 is hereby rescinded. Effective immediately all classes of messages authorized between Japan and China via Manila may be routed via San Francisco, when expeditious handling of messages warrants such diversion.

3. The rates and division of revenue for messages between Japan and China, via Manila, as set forth in SCAPIN 1777 as amended, will apply equally to messages between Japan and China routed via San Francisco.

4. Direct communication between Civil Communications Section, General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers and the Ministry of Communications concerning matters within the scope of this memorandum is authorized.
