TRANSFER ORDER AGAINST A PERSON INTERNED UNDER  
DEFENCE OF THE REALM REGULATION 14 B.

---

Whereas on the 17th day of May, 1918, I made an Order under Regulation 14 B. of the Defence of the Realm Regulations directing that Daniel McCarthy should be interned in Frongoch Camp;

NOW I HEREBY ORDER that the said DANIEL McCARTHY shall be interned in His Majesty's Prison at Durham and shall there be subject to all the regulations applying to persons therein interned and shall remain there until further orders.

ORDER UNDER REGULATION 14 B.  
OF THE DEFENCE OF THE REALM REGULATIONS.

-----

WHEREAS..... *Daniel M. McCarthy* .....  
is a person within an area in respect of which the operation of ~~xxxx~~  
Section One of the Defence of the Realm (Amendment) Act, 1915, is for  
the time being suspended.

AND WHEREAS on the recommendation of a Competent Military Author-  
ity appointed under the Defence of the Realm Regulations, it appears  
to me that for securing the public safety and the Defence of the  
Realm it is expedient that the said.. *Daniel M. McCarthy* ..  
..... should, in view of the  
fact that he is a person suspected of acting, having acted, or being  
about to act in a manner prejudicial to the public safety and the  
Defence of the Realm, be subjected to such obligations and restrict-  
ions as are hereinafter mentioned:

I HEREBY ORDER that the said *Daniel M. McCarthy* .....  
shall be interned in *Frongoch* .....  
and shall be subject to all the rules and conditions applicable to  
persons there interned and remain there until further orders.

If within seven days from the date on which this Order is served  
on the said *Daniel M. McCarthy* .....  
he shall submit to me any representations against the provisions of  
this Order, such representations will be referred to the Advisory  
Committee appointed for the purpose of advising me with respect to  
internment and deportation of aliens and presided over by a Judge of  
the High Court, and will be duly considered by the Committee. If I  
am satisfied by the report of the said Committee that this Order may  
be revoked or varied without injury to the public safety or the  
defence of the Realm, I will revoke or vary this Order by a further  
Order in writing under my hand. Failing such revocation or variat-  
ion this Order shall remain in force.

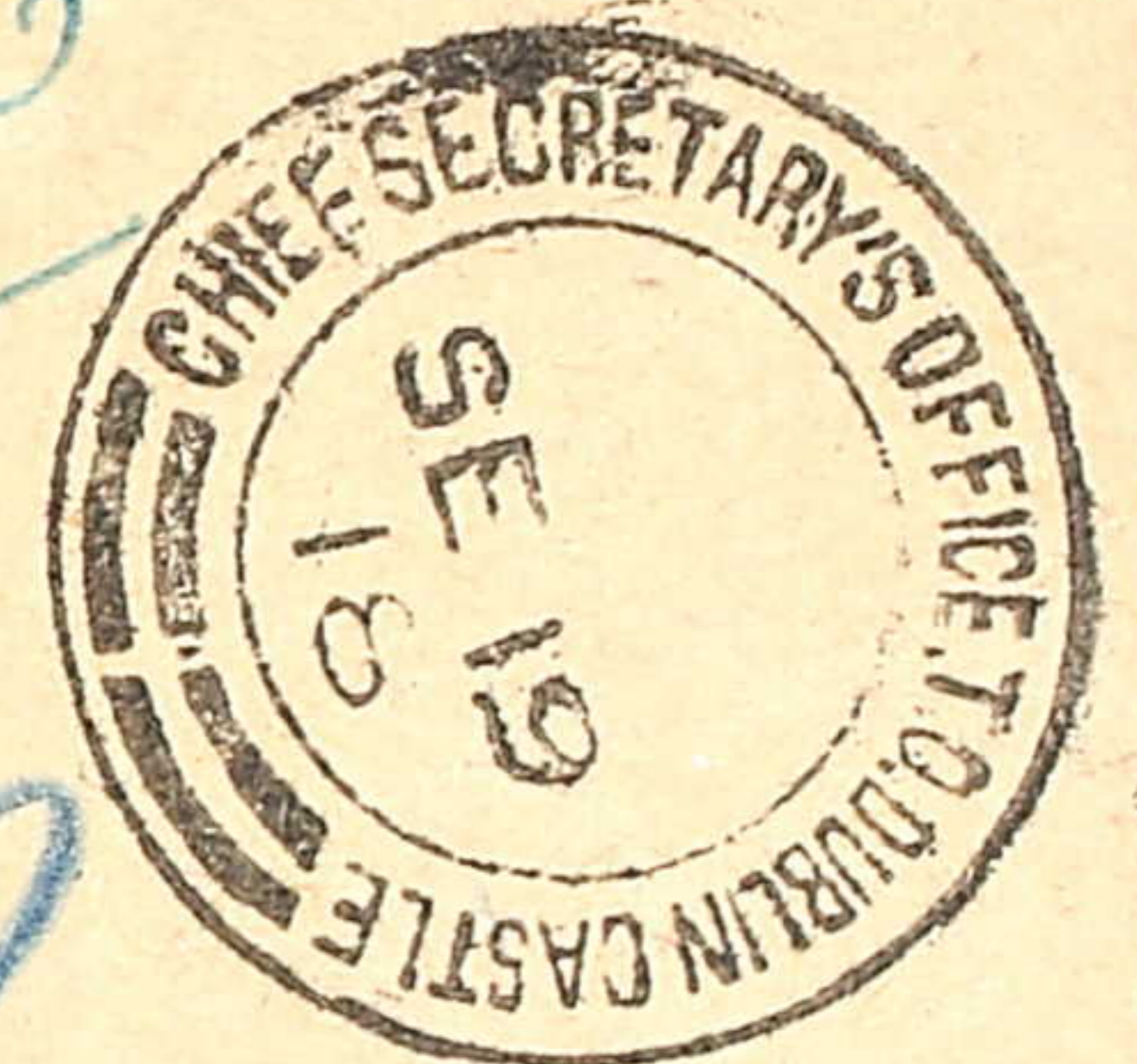


