

Europe | Expected Extreme Temperatures

Situation overview

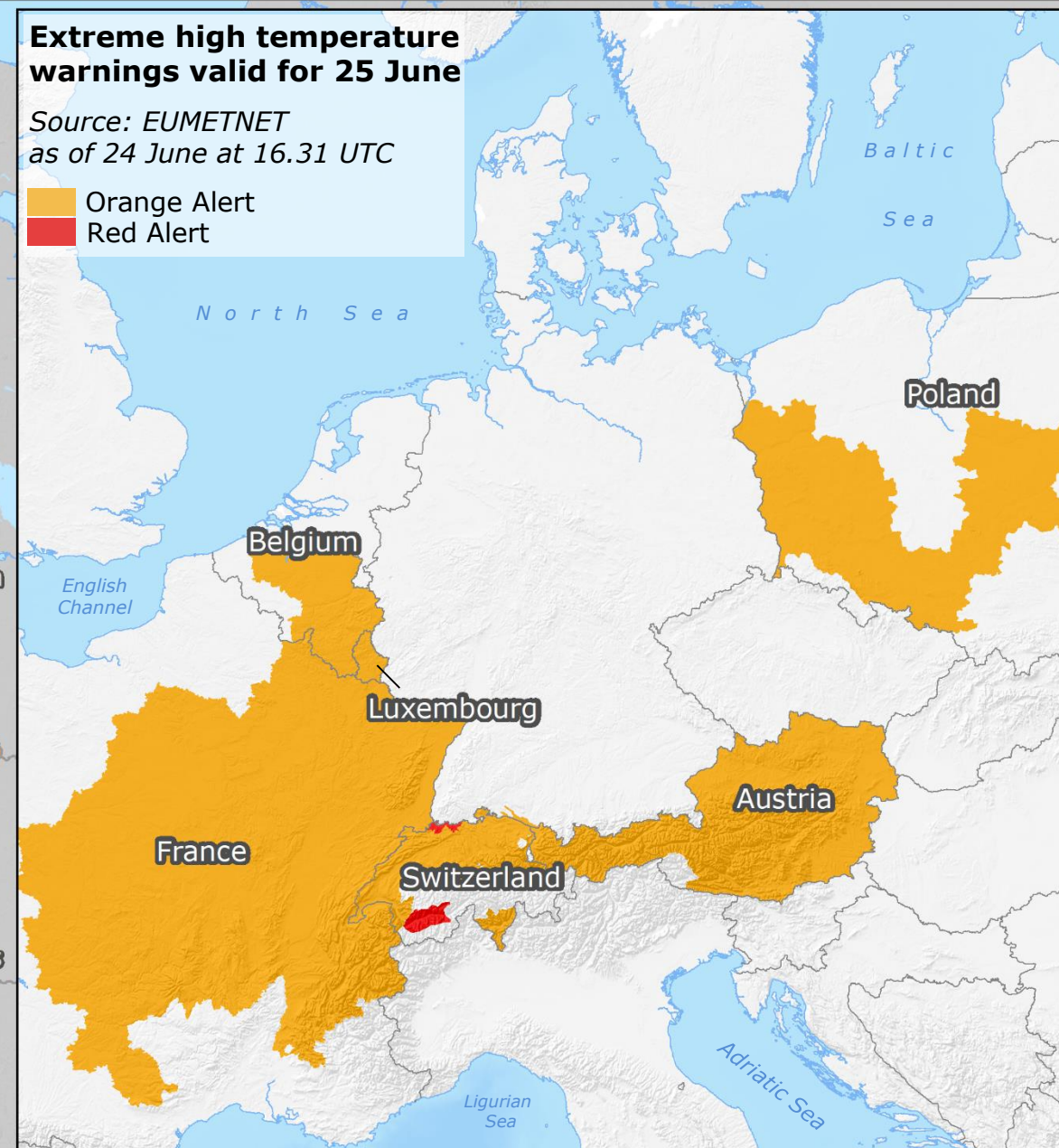
- Warm air masses from Africa will cause a distinct heatwave to many parts of Europe during next days with intensifying heat conditions gradually to be felt and built up by 25 June.
- Spain is to be hit by the first wave of such intense heat conditions. This heat wave will then gradually spread into France, Germany, Switzerland, Italy, Belgium and the Czech Republic.
- By 27 June at noon hours, the heatwave is expected to reach a first peak. Temperature forecast of the heatwave highlights many areas with values above 36°C, locally increasing beyond 40°C.
- Such heat conditions are expected to prevail until end of June/beginning of July with emphasis over Spain and southern France.

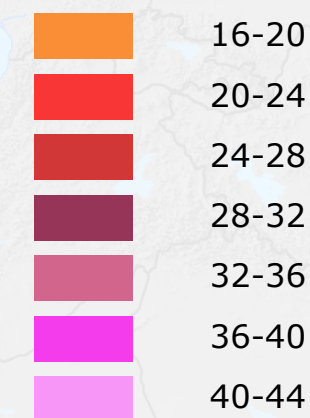
Extreme high temperature warnings valid for 25 June

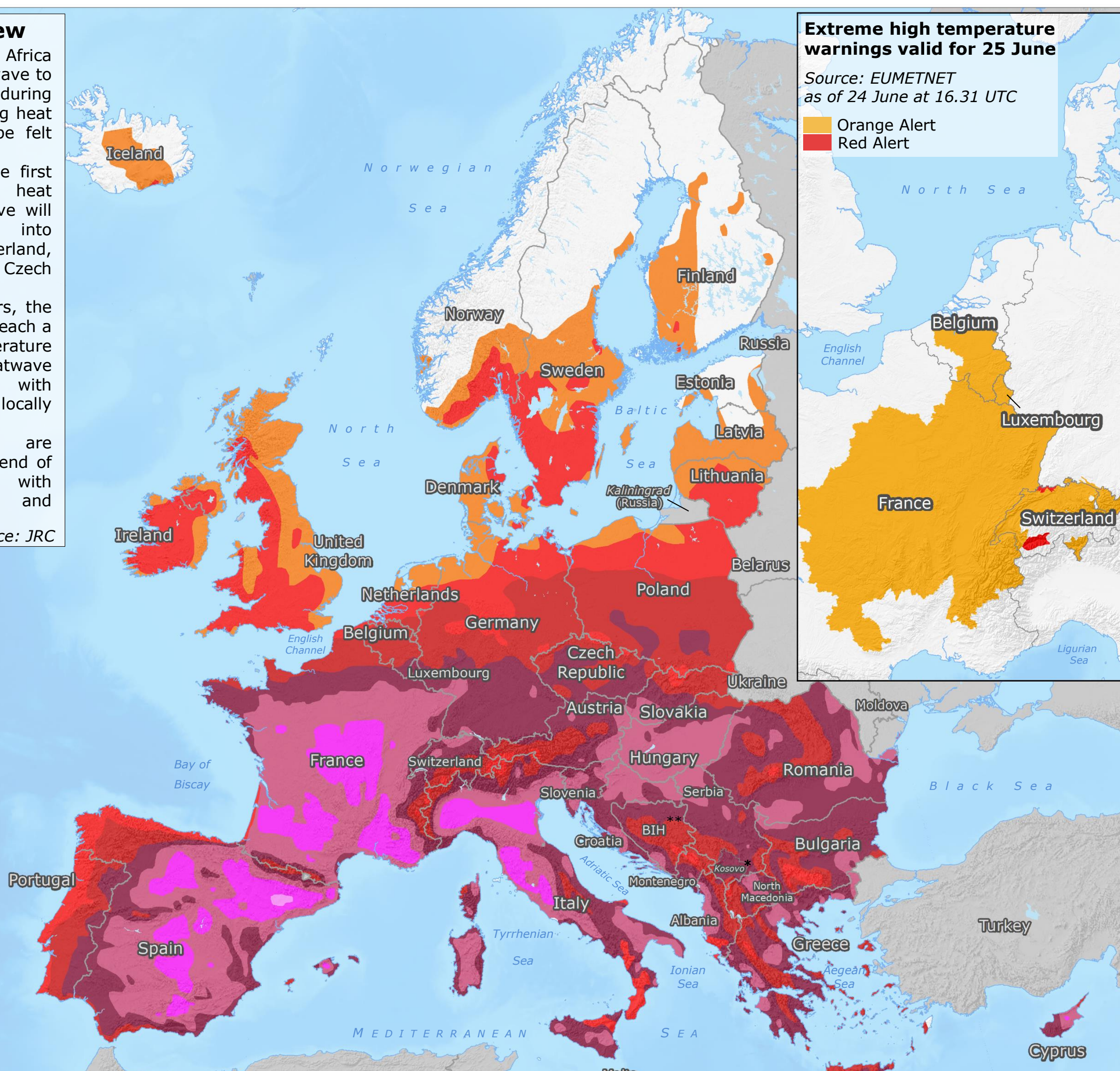
