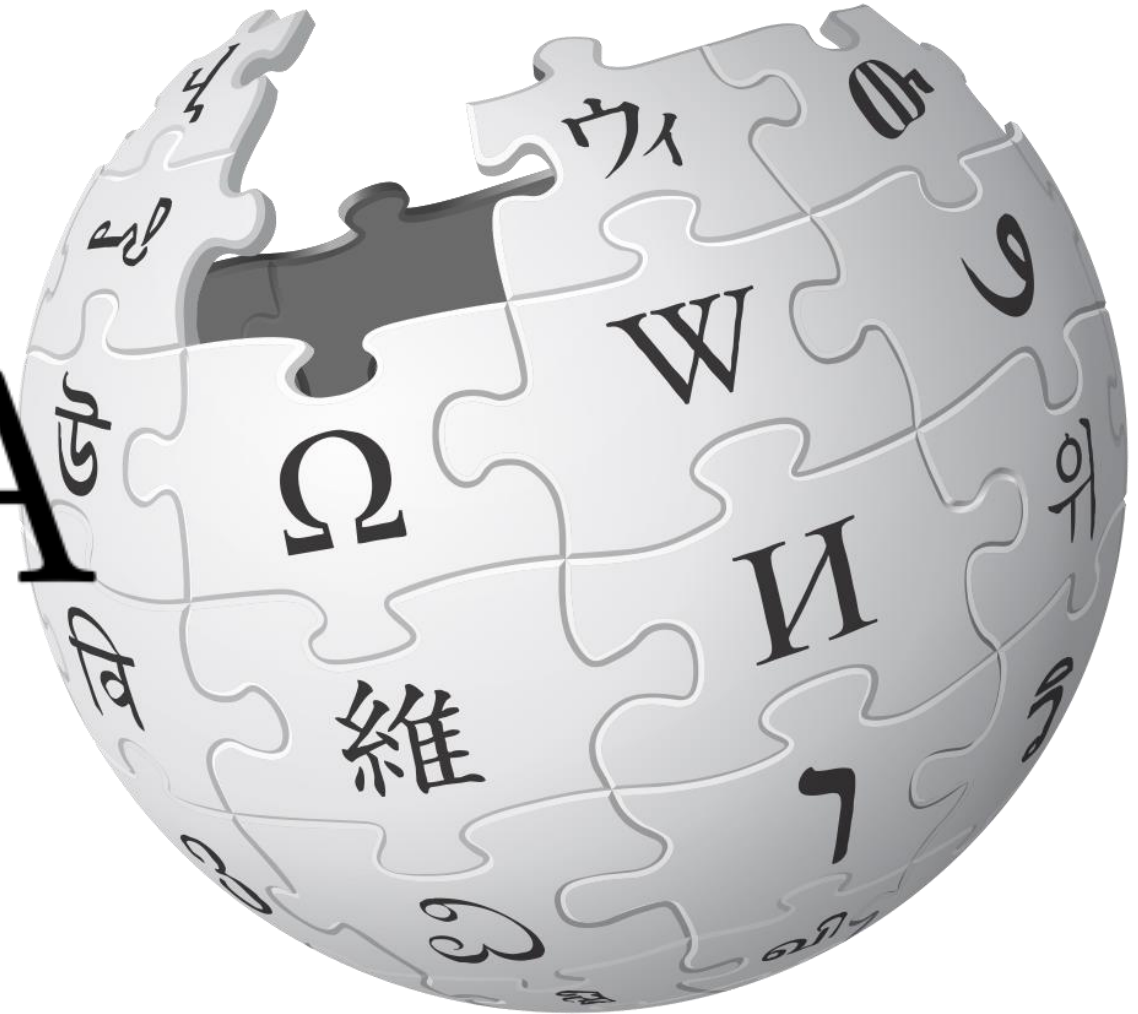
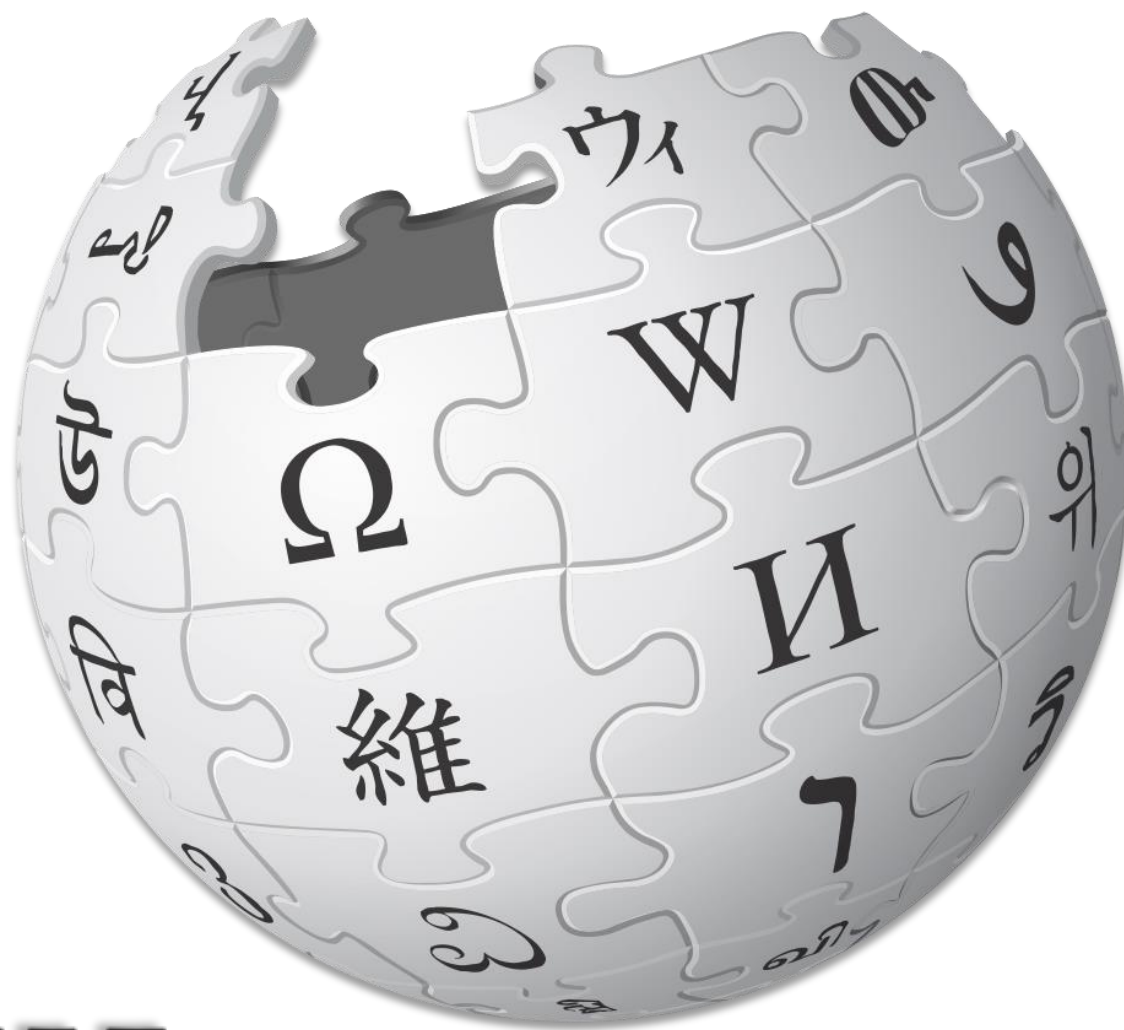

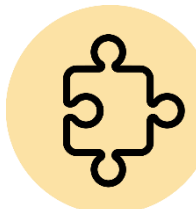




Wikipedia is an encyclopedia

WIKIPEDIA

began with its first edit on 15 January 2001

- ✓ In August 2002, shortly after Jimmy Wales announced that he would never run commercial advertisements on Wikipedia, the URL of Wikipedia was changed from wikipedia.com to wikipedia.org (see: .com and .org).
- ✓ On 20 June 2003, the Wikimedia Foundation was founded.
- ✓ Communications committee was formed in January 2006 to handle media inquiries and emails received for the foundation and Wikipedia
- ✓ On 10 January 2006, Wikipedia became a registered trademark of Wikimedia Foundation



FUNDRAISING WIKIPEDIA

Every year, Wikipedia runs a fundraising campaign to support its operations.

One of the first fundraisers was held from 18 February 2005 to 1 March 2005, raising US\$94,000, which was US\$19,000 more than expected.

On 6 January 2006, the Q4 2005 fundraiser concluded, raising a total of just over US\$390,000

The 2007 fundraising campaign raised US\$1.5 million from 44,188 donations

The 2008 fundraising campaign gained Wikipedia more than US\$6 million

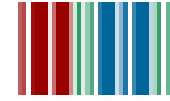
The 2010 campaign was launched on 13 November 2010, The campaign raised US\$16 million

The 2011 campaign raised US\$20 million from more than one million donors

The 2012 campaign raised US\$25 million from around 1.2 million donors

- ✓ Ensure information is high quality by increasing the percentage of material reviewed to be of high or very high quality by 25 percent
- ✓ Encourage readers to become contributors by increasing the number of total editors per month who made >5 edits to 200,000
- ✓ Support healthy diversity in the editing community by doubling the percentage of female editors to 25 percent and increase the percentage of Global South editors to 37 percent

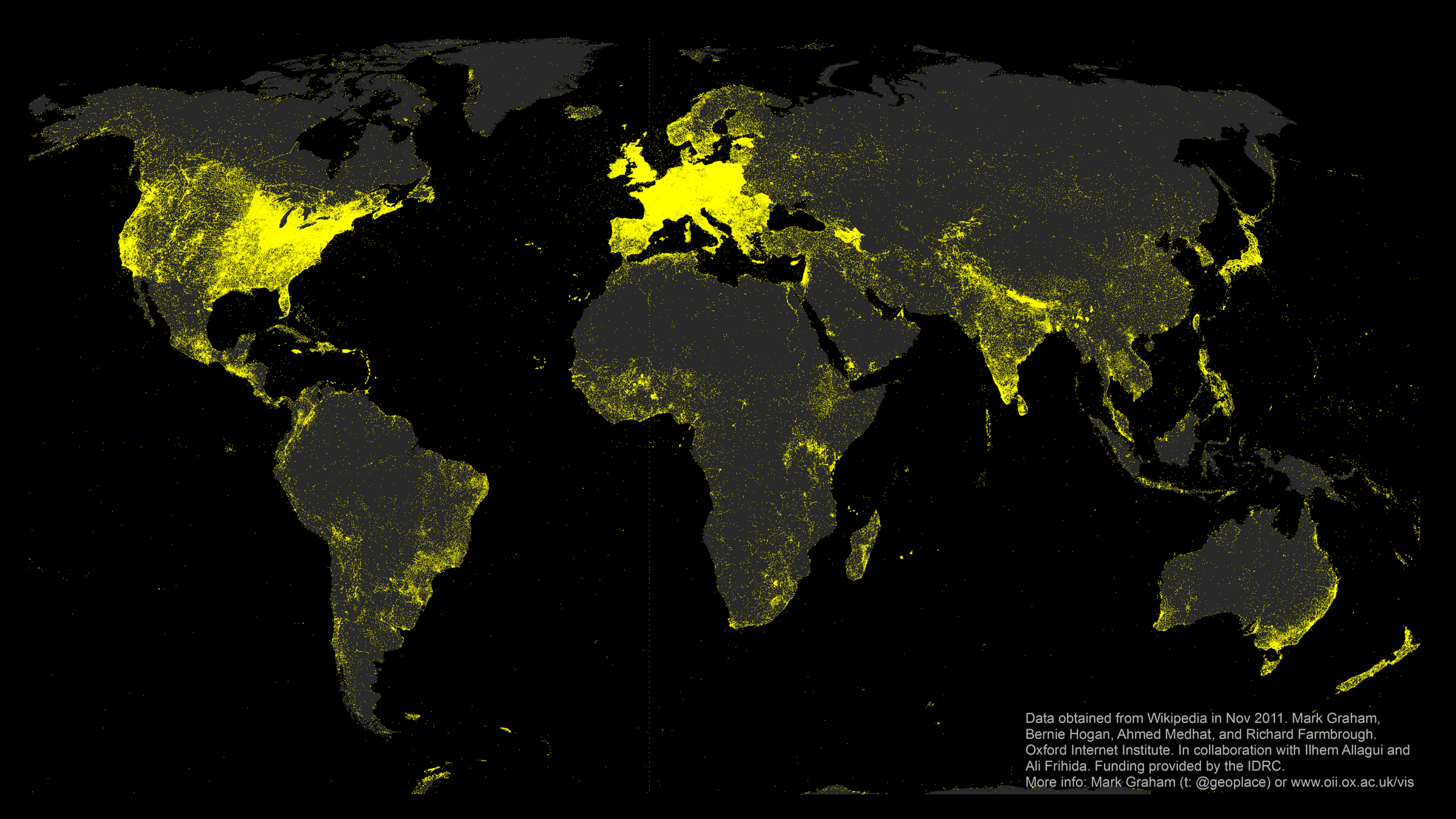


Self-reported "occasional" or "regular" contributors to Wikipedia (n=43,793)



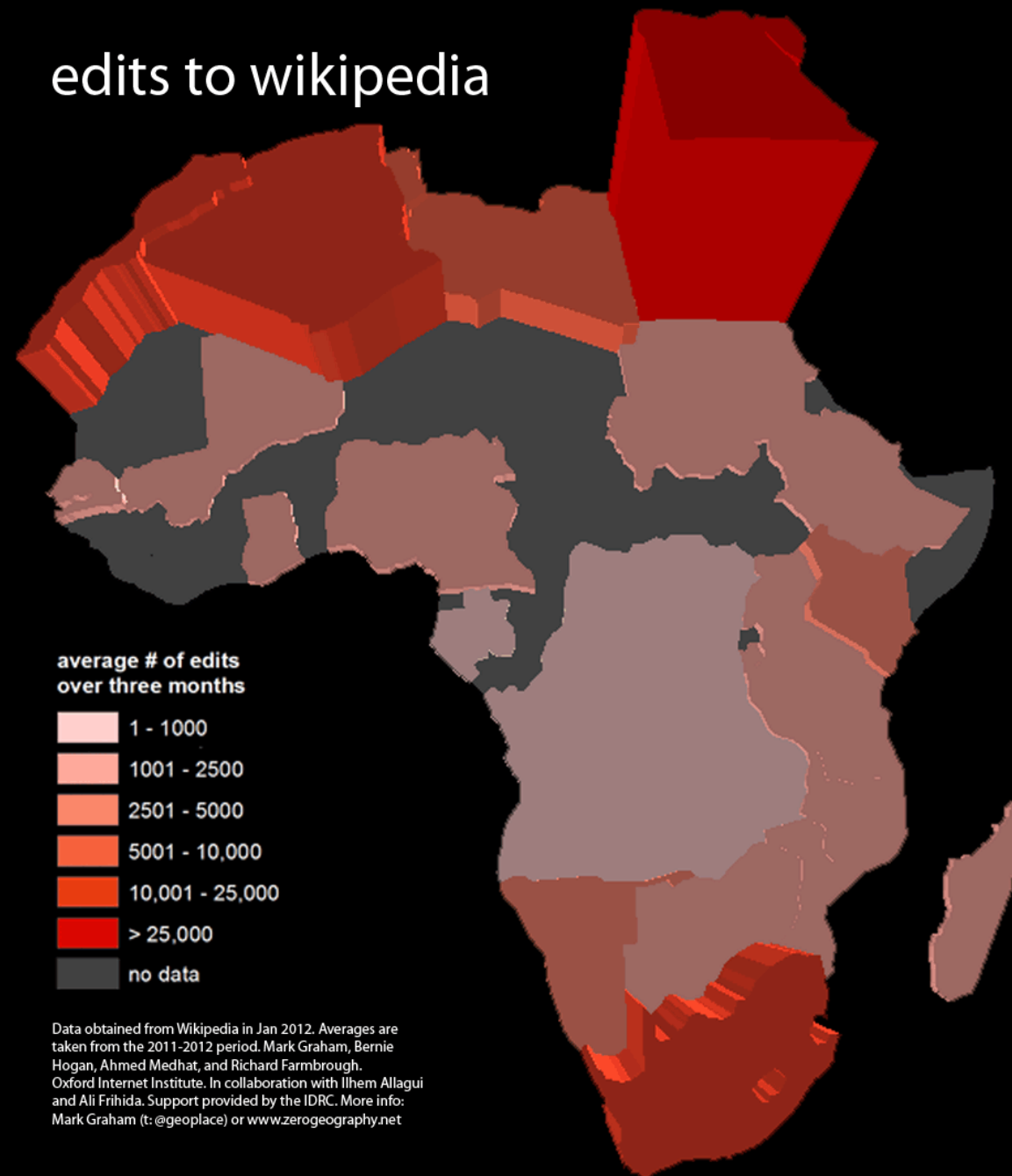

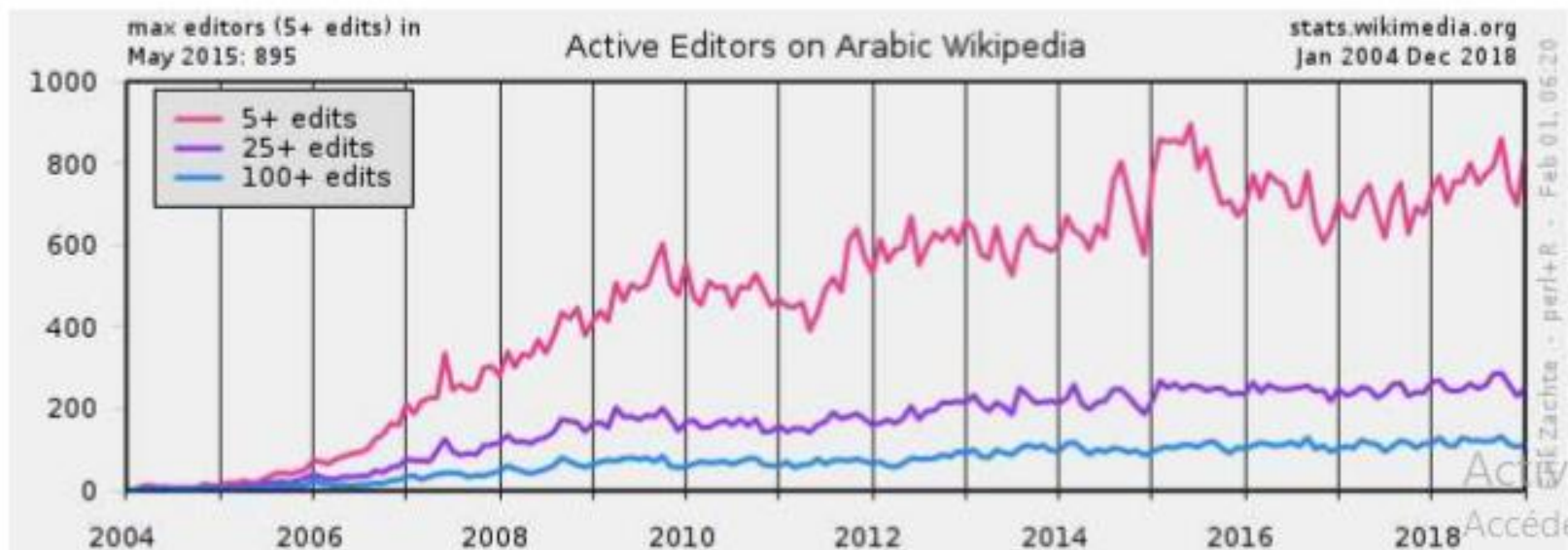

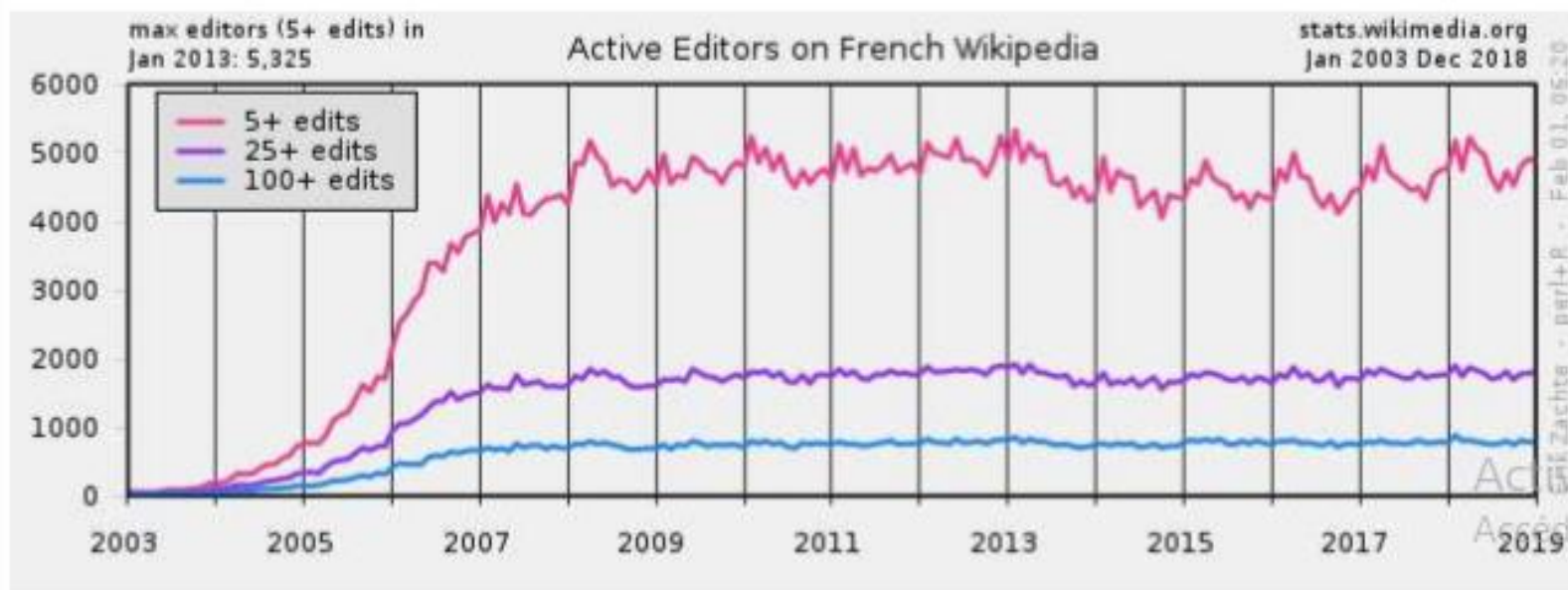

WIKI **loves**
monuments

The first Wiki Loves Monuments competition was held in 2010 in the Netherlands as pilot project. The next year it spread to other countries in Europe and according to the **Guinness Book of Records**, the 2011 edition of the Wiki Loves Monuments broke the world record for the largest photography competition.

The 2016 edition of WLM was supported by **UNESCO** and saw 10,700 contestants from 43 countries who submitted 277,000 photos

Wiki Loves Monuments 2018 in Morocco has been successful. With more than 140 participants uploading more than 500 photos of listed monuments in Morocco. More than 50% of these are quality photos that can be used in different Wikimedia projects.



The aim of the event is to highlight the conservation areas of the participating countries with the goal to encourage people to capture pictures of these sights, and to put them under a free license which can then be re-used not only in Wikipedia but everywhere by everyone.

The first Wiki Loves Earth competition was held in 2013 in Ukraine, and the contest became international in 2014. In 2019, 36 countries participate in the contest.

Wiki Loves Earth in Morocco aims at creating a complete information base about nature protected heritage in the country. Its goal is to gather illustrations for every nature protected object in Morocco.

Tunis, Tunisia — 16th 19th March

The second participation of Wikimedia Morocco User Group saw the participation of two of its board members: Anass Sedrati and Reda Benkhadra. It was an occasion to strengthen the links built a year earlier with our continental fellows, and to discuss common challenges and eventual cooperations. During this edition Anass held a presentation regarding Refugee projects in Wikimedia.



Wikimedia Conference

Berlin, Germany — 20th 22nd April

During the international conference of Wikimedia, two members of the group took part: Abderrahman Ait Ali (Movement Partnerships and Capacity Building tracks) and Anass Sedrati (Movement strategy track). The conference was also used by our members as an occasion to discuss in thematic and regional meetups. It was the first place where the idea of organizing WikiArabia 2019 in Morocco was brought into table.



Oslo Freedom Forum

Oslo, Norway — 28th 30th May

The event hosted a tech lab, where human rights were linked with technology. Along with international Wikimedians, Anass Sedrati represented the Moroccan User Group to ensure representativity of the languages he speaks, and to engage discussions with human rights activists from Africa and the MENA in order to advocate Wikimedia to them.

ORGANIZATION OF EVENTS IN MOROCCO



Workshop with NDI



As part of the International Women's Day, in collaboration with the NGO National Democratic Institute, a workshop was organized on March 7 in Rabat to create and improve the articles on Moroccan women deputies, around fifteen parliamentary assistants and trainees took part in this event.

#WikiGap



On the same day, with the help of the Embassy of Sweden, the #WikiGap initiative of the Ministry for Foreign Affairs was held at the ambassador's residence in Rabat with the participation of several volunteers and local associations working in the

field of women's rights. The workshop aimed to increase gender equality on Wikimedia projects.

HerStory Edit-a-thon



During the 16-day UN Women campaign, two members of the group, Iam Borim and Oussama Laghrissi, led an edit-a-thon at the Higher Institute of Information and Communication of Rabat around the HerStory project which aims to promote fe-

male content on Wikipedia. The students of the institute contributed to enrich the articles on Moroccan women.





The Strategy Salon 2019

The Strategy Salon 2019 organized in Mohammedia was first an occasion to gather members of [Wikimedia MA User Group](#), as it covered travel and accommodation costs for active Wikimedians coming from different regions of the Kingdom. Given this context, the Salon started by presenting the User Group and getting general feedback in relation with the national activities and internal work. After the usual presentations and an introduction of the strategy vision of 2030, the two chosen themes "**Advocacy**" and "**Capacity Building**" were discussed. The first theme "Advocacy" was introduced by Anass before opening the floor to a general group discussion and debate. The same process was followed to discuss Capacity Building. Lunch at a local restaurant happened between the two discussions. It was a good occasion to debrief, network, and to foster the relations with the team, as well as to explain that everyone can work offline, and participate in our common effort to advocate free knowledge in Morocco.





After three successful editions of WikiArabia and following the shared desire of the community to hold another, the fourth edition was organized from 4 to 6 October 2019 in Marrakesh.

The conference had its main theme Wikimedia and the local communities. It focused on fostering cooperation between the various actors of the movement, as well as knowledge sharing, strategic discussions and community building, among others.

ملخص عن المبادرة:

ويكيبيديا العربية هي النسخة العربية من مشروع الموسوعة المفتوحة ويكيبيديا. وصل عدد مقالاتها في أول 2019 حوالي 715 ألف مقالة في مجالات مختلفة من المعرفة بتزايد بنسبة 88% في غضون سنة 2018 لوحدتها. يطالها حالياً كل شهر 35 مليون قارئ بمعدل 5 مقالات لكل منهم. أي شخص يمكنه تعديل المقالات، ويقوم المحررون ذو الخبرة من التحقق من موثوقية المعلومات قبل نشرها. تعتمد ويكيبيديا العربية بكثافة على ويكي بيانات (مستودع شقيق للبيانات مشترك بين جميع اللغات) مما يمكنها من الحصول تلقائياً على أحدث البيانات غير المتعلقة بالمنطقة العربية دون الحاجة إلى ترجمة (لو صدرت مثلاً نتائج إحصاء رسمية للتجمعات السكانية في بوليفيا، فإنها ستظهر في مقالات القرى البوليفية في ويكيبيديا العربية طالما تنقل إلى ويكي بيانات). من التحديات التي تواجهها النسخة العربية صعوبة ترجمة المصطلحات الأجنبية، وعدم تواجد مراجع أولية آنية للترجمات.
